NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- After an 0-4 start to the year, the Chasers went 12-5 between April 1 and 21, then went 3-11 from April 22 to May 8 ... Omaha won 10 of 15 from May 9 to 24 but have gone 3-10 in the last 13 games since May 25.
- Omaha had a winning April, with a 13-12 record on the month ... with a 13-14 record in May, the Storm Chasers were one win away from having a winning record in back-to-back months for the first time since July and August 2024.
- Omaha has been under .500 following 37 of their last 38 games (since April 24) and the Storm Chasers have spent just 18 days at or above .500.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Storm Chasers have 17 comeback wins this season, tied for the 5th-most in the International League and tied 8th at the Triple-A level.
- Prior to Friday, Omaha's previous 10 wins (from May 13 to June 4) had all been comeback wins (games the team won despite trailing at some point in the game) ... Friday's 11-2 win was the first game the Storm Chasers won without trailing at any point since a 9-0 win on May 10 @ Indianapolis ... Friday was also the first time the Chasers won by more than 2 runs since an 11-3 win on May 21 @ St. Paul.
- On the flip side, Omaha has lost 19 games in which the team led, tied 2nd-most in the league and tied 4th-most in Triple-A ... the Storm Chasers have led at some point in 7 of their last 11 losses, including for the first 8.5 innings on Sunday and by 7 runs for nearly half of that game.
- In the last 28 games (since May 9), Omaha is 13-15 ... they have trailed at some point in 10 of 13 wins and led at some point in 9 of 15 losses, meaning 19 of Omaha's last 28 games have been a comeback win for one of the two teams.

WHAT HAPPENS IN OMAHA...

- This week, the Storm Chasers welcome the Pacific Coast League's Las Vegas Aviators to Werner Park for the first interleague series in the ballpark's history.
- These games mark the first visit to Werner Park by a PCL team since Omaha joined the International League in 2021 ... the last PCL team to play at Werner Park was the Round Rock Express, from August 30 to September 2, 2019.
- This week also marks the first time Las Vegas has played in Omaha since August 10-13, 2019 - during the Aviators' first season affiliated with the Athletics - when Las Vegas took 3 of 4, with Omaha's lone win coming on a **Kelvin Gutiérrez** walk-off single in the 10th inning on August 11 for a 4-3 victory.
- Las Vegas joined the PCL in 1983 and played alongside Omaha in the league from 1998 through 2019 ... this week marks the Aviators' 7th visit to Werner Park ... from 2005 to 2019, the clubs met in one 4-game series per season, alternating home ballparks annually ... while Omaha has not played a regular season game in Las Vegas since 2017, the Chasers did participate in the 2024 Triple-A National Championship Game at Las Vegas Ballpark.
- This is the second straight year the Storm Chasers have participated in Triple-A interleague play and the first of two interleague series on the schedule this season ... Omaha lost 5 of 6 at Salt Lake from May 20-25 last year ... the Chasers return to Salt Lake City July 21-26.

CATCH ME IF YOU CAN

- Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by a quartet of baserunning threats.
- Omaha's 84.1% success rate (69-for-82) ranks 3rd in the IL and 5th in Triple-A ... however, the team has the 11th-most steals in the 20-team IL.
- John Rave** leads Omaha in steals (15) ... **Gavin Cross** has 12 steals in as many tries, the 2nd-most steals in the IL without being caught ... **Kameron Misner** has swiped 11 bags, while **Drew Waters** and **Peyton Wilson** have 6 steals each.

STREAK HEAT

- One of the longest active hitting streaks in the International League is from an Omaha hitter, with the offense also featuring the league's reigning Player of the Week.
- Abraham Toro** enters today on a 12-game hitting streak, the 2nd-longest active streak in the IL and tied for Omaha's longest of the year ... since May 24, he's hitting .404 (19-for-47) with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 8 RBI and a 1.004 OPS ... he's also reached base in 16 straight games, since May 20.
- Kameron Misner** was named the IL's Player of the Week for the week of June 1-7, as he went 10-for-24 (.417 average) at the plate in Columbus ... he had 3 doubles and 5 home runs for a Minor League-leading 28 total bases, with 10 RBI and 8 runs scored ... he led Triple-A last week with a 1.167 slugging percentage and 1.648 OPS.

TODAY'S START

- Ben Sears is making his **8th start** with the Storm Chasers this year, his **16th game with Omaha** and his **18th overall appearance** in 2026.
- Playing his **5th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- This will be his 3rd outing against an Athletics affiliate ... he pitched twice against the High-A Lansing Lugnuts when he was with the Quad Cities River Bandits in August 2024.

SEARS' STUFF

- CONSISTENCY IS KEY:** While Sears has only worked 5 scoreless appearances in his 18 games between Double-A and Triple-A this season, he has allowed multiple runs just 5 times and has gone 2.0+ innings in 12 games (67%).
- STARTER SWITCH:** Entering this season, Sears hadn't started a game since he opened a bullpen game for the University of Houston on May 24, 2022 ... Sears was a starter throughout his career before moving to the bullpen and serving as Houston's closer in 2022 ... this year, he has opened 7 bullpen games for the Storm Chasers; he ranks 4th on the team in starts and he has only thrown 17.0 innings in those starts.

LAST OUTING: SATURDAY, JUNE 6 @ COLUMBUS

- Made his 7th start in a bullpen game for the Storm Chasers, his 2nd of the week and 3rd in his last 4 outings ... after a 1-hour, 55-minute rain delay prior to first pitch, Sears worked around a leadoff walk for a scoreless 1st inning ... allowed a double and RBI single for a run in the 2nd ... did not come out for the 3rd.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 5 Cactus League games for the Royals, striking out 5 in 3.1 innings ... assigned to Northwest Arkansas (AA) to begin the season
- Pitched in 2 games for the Naturals, posting a 5.40 ERA (2 ER in 3.1 IP) before his promotion to Omaha on April 10.
- In his 7 opener starts, Sears has worked a 4.76 ERA (9 ER in 17.0 IP), with Omaha going 3-4 in those games ... Sears' 17.0 innings in games he's started are the fewest among 123 Triple-A pitchers that have made at least 7 starts this year ... in 8 relief appearances, Sears has a 5.02 ERA (8 ER in 14.1 IP).

CAREER NOTES

- Spent most of the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA), but also spent a portion of the summer with Omaha ... opened the year with the Naturals and threw 2.0+ scoreless innings 5 times over his first 19 appearances before making his Triple-A debut with the Storm Chasers on June 28.
- Pitched in 9 games for Omaha between June 28 and August 4, allowing 5 ER in 14.0 IP (3.21 ERA) before returning to NWA to finish the season with the Naturals ... combined to post a 4.33 ERA (25 ER in 62.1 IP) in 41 games between Double-A and Triple-A.
- Earned 5 saves with NWA, including 3 in a 6-outing span from August 14 to 29 ... pitched to a 2.63 ERA (4 ER in 13.2 IP) with 11 strikeouts in August.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+) ... made 44 relief appearances with a 3.28 ERA (21 ER in 57.2 IP) and 15 saves ... led all Royals Minor Leaguers in saves, ranking 4th in Minor League Baseball.
- Spent most of the 2023 season with Columbia (A) but made his High-A debut in August ... opened the year with the Fireflies and made 31 relief appearances with a 3.21 ERA (22 ER in 61.2 IP) before his promotion to Quad Cities ... finished the season with the River Bandits and appeared in 5 games.
- Made his professional debut in 2022 with the ACL Royals (R) after the Royals selected him in the 14th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of Houston ... made just 1 appearance in the ACL before he was promoted to Single-A, with a 3.29 ERA in 7 relief appearances for the Fireflies.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- Pitched 2 seasons at the University of Houston (2021-22) after beginning his collegiate career with 2 years at the Community College of Rhode Island (2019-20) ... led the American Conference in saves his senior season (12) and led the Cougars in ERA (3.11).
- Graduated from East Providence High School in 2018, where he was named the Gatorade Player of the Year as a Senior after posting an 8-2 record with a 1.07 ERA ... also lettered in basketball at East Providence and was the team captain as a senior.
