"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

FESTA AND ADAMS SHOVE, SAINTS TAKE 2-1 SERIES LEAD: Following 17 days since his last start, David Festa looked as good as new. The Saints starter was electric and Travis Adams was nearly unhittable out of the bullpen as the duo combined for 8.0 innings of 1-run, 3-hit ball and the Saints pitching staff racked up 15 strikeouts to match a season-high in a 10-2 win over Norfolk on Friday night at CHS Field. Festa only allowed two hits in his start, including a double that was lost in the sun by Emmanuel Rodriguez to start the night off the bat of Vimal Machin, who came around to score on a wild pitch. Festa would go on to retire five of the next six batters via the strikeout and finish by racking up seven across 3.2 innings. The Saints hung a five-spot in the second. Three walks and a hit by pitch from Tides starter Kyle Brnovich plated the first run, a bases-loaded free pass by Will Holland, before Matt Wallner cleared the bases with a double down to the right field corner. Wallner would finish 3-for-5 in his second game of MLB rehab. St. Paul added a run manufactured by Holland's speed in the fourth, an infield hit extended to third after a stolen base and an errant throw by the catcher trying to nab him before Holland scampered home on a wild pitch. Jose Miranda and Mike Ford each plated runs with two-out knocks in the seventh.

BLOWING IN THE WIND: Saints pitching have been racking up the swings-and-misses the past two days, combining for 62 whiffs over the previous two days and accounting for two of their top-ten highest swing-and-miss totals in a game this year. In game two on Thursday night, Simeon Woods Richardson gave up one run over six innings while striking out eight and accounting for 19 swings-and-misses, tied for the fourth-most by a Saints pitcher in the pitch-tracking era (2023-pres). David Festa racked up 13 on Friday despite throwing only 54 pitches. Festa had a 52% whiff-rate on his pitches, just the fourth time that a Saints pitcher the last three years has thrown 50+ pitches and gotten a swing-and-miss on 50% or more of the swings taken against them (see below):

DESOLATION ROW: Despite some recent strong pitching performances, the Saints have struggled on the mound recently as they've yielded 50 runs across their last 63.1 innings of baseball going back to the start of their last series in Iowa. Since the start of May, St. Paul pitching has produced a 6.05 ERA (103 ER, 153.1 IP), the 7th-worst mark in Minor League Baseball and 3rd-worst in the International League since the turn of the calendar page. Despite the pitching struggles, the Saints' team OPS of .857 as an offense is the third-highest in MiLB in May, and the 2nd best in Triple-A (Lehigh Valley-.896).

GOING, GOING, GONE: After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the second-fewest in the International League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 46 round-trippers in their last 33 games since April 14, which ties-third in the minors in that stretch, trailing only the Greensboro Grasshoppers (53) & Charlotte Knights (52). St. Paul had left the yard at least once in eight straight games, a season-long streak for the club, until going homerless on Tuesday and Wednesday last week in Iowa. They have left the yard at least once in 14 of their past 18 games.

BALLAD OF A (MUSTACHED) MAN: Since being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Saints utility man Mickey Gasper has hit .328 (20-61) with four doubles, 5 HR, and 12 RBI in 15 games. His OPS of 1.062 in that stretch ranks 12th in the International League (min. 40 AB) while his nine extra-base hits ranks 4th, trailing only Norfolk's Samuel Basallo, Lehigh Valley's Buddy Kennedy & Iowa's Carlos Perez (10 each). The New Hampshire native now has seven homers in 18 games in a Saints uniform this year, more than halfway to his career-high 12 set last season in the Boston organization. Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as the 2nd best hitter in the minors by wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average, a ballpark and league adjusted measure) & fourth in OPS in MiLB:

TWINS REPORT: The Minnesota Twins (28-22) topped the Royals 3-1 yesterday at Target Field behind 5 2/3 one-run innings from Pablo Lopez and homers from Carlos Correa and Ty France. The Twins hold MLB's best record at 15-4 in May. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (23-20) have lost 3-of-4 in San Antonio (SDP) this week after falling 2-1 yesterday. INF Tanner Schobel extended his hit streak to 12 straight games after going 1-4 yesterday. High-A Cedar Rapids (24-17) lost 2-6 at Fort Wayne (SDP) yesterday. Twins No. 4 prospect Kaelen Culppepper has hit safely in 13 straight after going 3-for-3 with two doubles yesterday & ranks top-10 in the MWL in hitting (.325) & OPS (.949) for the kernels. Low-A Fort Myers (19-24) have lost four straight this week in Lakeland (DET).

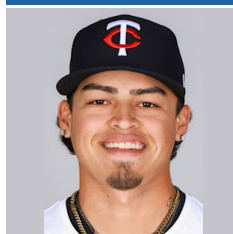

LAST APPEARANCE: Started Thursday in game one of a doubleheader in Iowa and got himself into a bases-loaded jam with a leadoff single and two walks. Struck out Carlos Perez before giving up a bases-clearing double to James Triantos. Pitched around three more walks the rest of the way to match a career-high with five free passes and recorded eight outs. Threw 21 cutters (31%), 15 curveballs (22%), 10 sinkers (15%), 9 sweepers (13%), 8 four-seamers (12%), and 4 changeups (6%). Generated five swings-and-misses. Recorded a strikeout apiece on the changeup and curveball.

YOUNG GUNS: After making St. Paul's Opening Day roster following one appearance with the Saints to end last season, Raya is one of just six pitchers aged 22-years or younger to begin the 2025 season on a Triple-A roster. At 22 years, 7 months, and 21 days as of Opening Day, Raya is more than five years younger than the average pitcher at the Triple-A level this season. A LONG WAIT: A fourth-round pick in 2020, Raya had to wait a while to make his professional debut. After entering the year as a 1st Team Preseason All-American, his senior season at United South High School in Laredo, Texas was limited to just 18.0 innings in which he struck out 36 batters. His final high school outing was a complete-game, one-hit shutout. However due to the COVID-19 shutdown, followed by a right rotator cuff strain, Raya threw his first professional pitch on April 12, 2022, 670 days after hearing the Twins call his name in the Draft.

THAT'S MARK, WITH A K: Raya, who's full legal name is Marco Antonio Raya, goes by Mark, despite not having a "K" in his legal name. He said you'd have to ask his dad as to why --- he's listed as "Marco" everywhere on Major League Baseball's websites.

GOOD GENES: Athletes run in the Raya family. Mark's mother played college tennis, his father played baseball at Nixon, while his sister made it to regionals as a junior and senior at United South HS in hurdles. Raya's brother also holds the Texas A&M International career strikeout record (127) despite only pitching two years for the Dustdevils in Division 2.

LAST APPEARANCE: Fanned a season-high eight across five shutout frames on Sunday in the series finale in Iowa. Struck out four of the first five I-Cubs hitters faced and recorded at least one strikeout in four of five innings on the afternoon. Left all seven baserunners he let on stranded. Threw 28 four-seam fastballs (36%), 19 cutters (24%), 12 changeups (15%), 12 sinkers (15%), 4 sweepers (5%), and 3 curveballs (4%). Induced 18 swings-and-misses, tied with David Festa for the second-most by a Saints pitcher this season (Simeon Woods Richardson's 19 on Thursday are the most). Recorded 3-of-8 punchouts on the four-seamer, 3-of-8 on the cutter, and the other two on the curveball.

ON THE FAST TRACK: In just his second full-season in the minors last year, Morris ascended through three levels of the minor league ladder to finish the year making his first six starts at the Triple-A level. It's not the first time that Morris has accelerated at a faster pace than his peers. He graduated high school at just 16 years old, starting his freshman season of college at just 17. He was born on the cutoff date of September 1 for starting school and his mother chose to start him in kindergarten a year ahead. Not only that, he also skipped second grade as he was being homeschooled in Alaska.

BUILDING UP TRAVEL POINTS: Although he was born in New York City, Morris claims Boulder, Colorado as his hometown. He moved from NYC as a child to Oregon, then to Alaska, and then to Colorado, where he attended Monarch High School in Boulder. He tells people Boulder is where he's from as that's where he lived the longest.

LET'S GET FUNKY: Lacking the prototypical build of a frontline starter, Morris' unusual delivery has been noted as a reason why hitters have such a hard time picking up his pitches. Fangraphs prospect writer Eric Longenhagen noted in [last year's mid-season report](#) that "Morris' delivery is weird. He has a high front side throughout his delivery and creates a slight crossfire angle with stride direction before throwing out of a high arm slot. It's rare for cross-bodied pitchers to also have a north/south arm slot this extreme and it seems to disorient hitters."

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Before transferring to Texas Tech for his senior year, Morris pitched for three years at Division 2 Colorado Mesa University, helping his team reach the DII National Championship Game in 2019 as a freshman (Mesa finished as Runner-up to Tampa that year). Morris was named the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Freshman of the Year for his efforts that season and was a Division 2 2nd-Team All-American in 2021 before transferring to Texas Tech as a redshirt junior.

MAD MORRIS: Morris' mound routine can involve arguing with himself or talking to himself on the mound. "I'm really just analyzing the last pitch, moving on to the next pitch and what it should be," Morris remarked. "Sometimes there are not-so-nice words involved, but really it's 'Trust it. Throw it to the mask' Other times, 'it's good left side, how can we work off of that? What's next, and then next?' There's lots of things going through my head."
