Today is the second of a six-game series and an 18-game season series between the Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and Captains, High-A affiliate of the Guardians. The Nuts are 130-138 all-time vs. Lake County, 59-75 in Eastlake, with a 9-15 record last year (6-6 at home and 3-9 on the road).

Yesterday: Lake County 14, Lansing 1 (7 innings): Esteban González made a phenomenal leaping catch at the wall, and Dean Curley and Jace LaViolette knocked two-run homers to back six strong innings from Rafe Schlesinger, launching the Captains to a rain-shortened series-opening rout. Rodney Green, Jr. thwacked his fourth home run of the season to left-center for Lansing's only run.

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa have the call of the game on milb.streamguys1.com/lansing.

On Deck: The Luggies and Caps play evening affairs on Thursday, Friday and Saturday, wrapping things up with a Sunday matinee before Lansing returns to Michigan's state capital to welcome in reeling archrival West Michigan, losers of 19 of their last 20 games, those poor guys.

LUG-NOTES

Transaction: Outfielder **Pedro Pineda** was reinstated from the Temporary Inactive List, restoring the Lugnuts' roster to 30 active players.

Streak Halted: Shortstop **Ali Camarillo** went 0-for-3 yesterday, the first time in 17 games with Lansing that he had failed to reach base.

Casey at the Bat: Second baseman **Casey Yamauchi** went 1-for-3 yesterday and is now hitting .383 (18-for-47) in May after a .233 (14-for-60) April. Additionally, Yamauchi has drawn seven walks compared to just two strikeouts this month, giving him a .474 OBP. In his last 10 games alone, Yamauchi is batting a sizzling .436 (17-for-39) with a .531 OBP.

History Lesson: Yamauchi first debuted for the Lugnuts in 2023... with three games here at Classic Auto Group Park, going 6-for-9 with two walks and three steals. A year later, he played in four games against the Captains (.158 avg., 3-for-19, two steals), and then hit .233 (14-for-60) with three doubles and a triple in 18 games against Lake County last season. In total, Yamauchi has played 26 games against the Caps, batting 24-for-91, .264.

Milestones: On Thursday, May 14, the Lugnuts won the 2,000th game in franchise history... and three days later, on Sunday, reliever **Jay Dill** became the 999th player in Lansing Lugnuts team history.

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarria**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**) and No. 24 (**Nate Nankil**). Baseball America's recent re-ranking of A's prospects puts Devin Taylor at No. 10, Steven Echavarria at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

Family Ties: Lansing OF **Myles Naylor's** older brother, Bo, played for the Lake County Captains in 2019, batting .243/.313/.421 in 107 games, with 18 doubles, 10 triples and 11 home runs as a 19-year-old. (Myles and Bo's oldest brother, Josh, came up to the Majors through the Marlins' and Padres' systems.)

Impressive Stuff: Right-hander **Nathan Dettmer** took a no-hitter into the seventh inning at South Bend in his Midwest League debut on May 10, settling for 6 1/3 scoreless innings of one-hit ball. In his home debut on Sunday, Dettmer completed seven innings to match his career high. In 13 1/3 innings overall in High-A, Dettmer has allowed one run on seven hits and three walks while striking out 14.

Green Power: On May 12, **Rodney Green, Jr.** launched a 490-foot home run into the second floor of the Outfield Lofts apartments, the longest tracked home run of the 2026 season, Major League or Minor League.

Bolting to the Show: The most recent Lugnut to make his MLB debut is 2024 Lugnuts outfielder **Henry Bolte**, who went 2-for-2 for the A's on May 13 to become the 203rd all-time Lugnut to reach the Major Leagues and the third this season (**Daniel Susac**, **Eduardo Rivera**).

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

MAY 20 IN LUGNUGS HISTORY

2004: With all eyes on him and a Thursday night crowd of 9,823 in attendance, rehabbing Mark Prior made his first appearance since the 2003 National League Championship Series, beginning his road back to the Majors. Prior faced the minimum in three innings, striking out five and issuing one walk – to Drew Macias, who was then caught stealing by catcher Jake Fox. The Lugnuts defeated the Fort Wayne Wizards, 2-1, on two runs in the bottom of the ninth. Brian Dopirak tied the game with a two-out RBI double. Three batters later, Fox drew a walk-off walk to bring in Dopirak. Future Major Leaguer Carlos Marmol picked up the win, allowing one run in six innings and striking out eight.

2019: The Lugnuts stole seven bases against Great Lakes, giving them a league high 62 steals, and rallied back from a four-run seventh inning deficit, but lost 8-7 in ten innings. Current Marlins standout Otto Lopez was called out in the 10th on appeal for not properly tagging up on a flyout, erasing the potential game-tying run.

Collegiate Baseball First Team All-American... pitched for 2019 USA Baseball 16U National Team Development Program.

College: Spent three years at LSU, one year at Auburn... ascended to Game 3 starter as true freshman at LSU in 2022, spent 2023 as reliever and was named SEC Academic Honor Roll (sport administration), majority reliever in 2024 (tossing 1 1/3 scoreless IP vs. Tennessee in SEC championship game)... transferred to AU for senior season and was named Second Team All-SEC (first Auburn player to earn All-SEC since 2018) and ABCA First Team All-Southeast Region... led Auburn in wins (7) and strikeouts (95), the most strikeouts for a Tiger since 2019... played with older brother Andrew at Auburn; Andrew had been at Birmingham-Southern for four years, forced to transfer when they shut their baseball program; he transferred in to Auburn for 2025 and blasting a home run in his only plate appearance of the year.
