NOTES

TONG TERRIFIC: Mets No. 10 prospect RHP **Jonah Tong** was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week last week. Tong threw six no-hit innings with no walks and nine strikeouts in his Double-A debut against Somerset on Thursday at Mirabito Stadium. The 21-year-old retired the first 17 batters and the only baserunner reached on an error with two outs in the sixth inning. He became the third Rumble Ponies pitcher to win the award this season, joining Joander Suarez (April 28-May 5) and Brandon Sproat (July 29-August 4). Tong is slated to start on Wednesday at Portland.

LAST TIME DUT: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the Somerset Patriots, 2-1, in their home finale at Mirabito Stadium on Sunday. Jonathan Pintaro got the win and threw six shutout frames with seven strikeouts, while allowing just two hits and one walk. Somerset won five of seven games in the series. Rowdey Jordan and Jaylen Palmer hit RBI singles in the first inning. Wilkin Ramos earned his ninth save with two shutout frames.

JP SMOUVE: Jaylen Palmer hit an RBI single in the first inning on Sunday against Somerset, which extended his on-base streak to nine games. In seven games since the calendar flipped to September, Palmer his slashing .333/.385/.750/1.135 with two home runs, a walk-off home run, four doubles, seven runs batted in, two runs scored, and two walks. Palmer homered twice in the series against Somerset last week and is one home run shy of tying his career high with 13 from 2023. Over his last 24 games since August 6, Palmer is hitting .274 with an .889 OPS, 23 hits, five home runs, nine doubles, 14 runs batted in, and 11 runs scored. Palmer has been an extra base hit machine with 33 extra base hits (12 home runs and 21 doubles) out of his 57 total hits (58%) in 77 games this year.

CLIFFORD THE BING RED DDG: Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 79 overall prospect **Ryan Clifford** is now tied for the fourth-most home runs in the Eastern League with 16. He also ranks third in Minor League Baseball with 90 walks, across High-A Brooklyn (32) and Double-A Binghamton (58). Clifford has reached base safely in 19 of his last 22 games since August 15 and is slashing .278/.395/.431/.826 with 20 hits, three home runs, two doubles, nine runs batted in, seven runs scored, and 13 walks in that span. The 21-year-old ranks top 15 in the Eastern League in HR (T-4th most), BB, (T-8th), OPS (11th), SLG (12th), and OBP (13th).

JACKSON JACKS: Infielder Jeremiah Jackson homered twice against Somerset last week was tied for the most home runs in the Eastern League. Jackson is now tied for the second-most home runs in the EL with 18, one shy of Hartford's Zach Kokoska (19). Jackson is tied with Jud Fabian (BOW) and Chris Meyers (ERI). Jackson also ranks tied for eighth in the EL with 58 runs batted in. Jackson snapped a six-game on-base streak and four-game hit streak on Sunday. The 24-year-old leads the team with 15 multi-RBI games and is third with 22 multi-hit games.

SPDILER ALERT: Binghamton returns to Hadlock Field to face Portland, where it went 5-1 in May. Portland comes into tonight 1.5 games ahead of Somerset for first place in the Northeast Division with six games left to play.



-Reid Brignac (pronounced Brin-yac) is coming off leading the Rumble Ponies to the postseason last season, for the first time since 2017. In 2023, under Brignac's tutelage, the Ponies went on a second-half surge, going 39-27 overall and 17-5 over their last 22 games. Brignac's team swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to lead the Ponies to the ELCS before falling to Erie.

In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a Binghamton franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca). Brignac also was the Mets' representative on the Arizona Fall League coaching staff after that season, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas.

-Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School.

YEAR WITH BNG: 2nd YEAR WITH NYM: 3rd -AJ Sager was named the 2023 New York Mets Minor League Staff Member of the Year for his efforts last year. Sager's pitching staff in 2023 set a Binghamton franchise record with 15 shutouts and took home five Eastern League honors, highlighted by Mike Vasil winning Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for May and Dom Hamel being named EL Pitcher of the Month for September. Sager's staff also ranked first among the 30 Double-A clubs in strike rate and walks issued, and second in opponent on-base percentage. On September 7 at Hartford, right-hander Joander Suarez threw the eighth no-hitter in franchise history, facing the minimum 21 batters over seven innings.

-Sager previously spent 20 years coaching in the Detroit Tigers organization and pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five saves and a 5.36 ERA. Sager was originally drafted by the Padres in the 10th round of the 1988 MLB Draft, out of the University of Toledo.


