FRIDAY NIGHT CROWDOWN: Brewers no. 25-rated prospect Coleman Crow will make his sixth start of the season with Nashville and his eighth Triple-A start when he takes the ball for the Sounds Friday night. Crow has gone 4-1 in his six appearances with Nashville this season and is tied for third in Milwaukee's farm system with his four wins. In two Major League starts this year, Crow has worked 10.1 IP and allowed three earned runs on seven hits with seven strikeouts and a walk without a decision.

BASE MAGNET: Brewers no. 4 rated prospect Cooper Pratt extended his on-base streak to 13 consecutive games in Thursday night's loss against the Bulls, going 0-for-2 and was hit by pitch to reach base in the top of the fifth. The 13 consecutive games currently marks the longest-active streak for the Sounds and is tied for 16th for the longest-active on-base streak in the International League. Pratt's single-season career-high sits at 36 consecutive games, during the 2024 season with Single-A Carolina and marked the longest on-base streak by a Mudcat for the entire season, 13 more than Tayden Hall (23).

ON THE MEND: Major League Rehabber Quinn Priester made his fourth start with the Sounds this season in Thursday's loss against the Bulls. Priester had a stellar first two innings to the game as he tossed a 1-2-3 opening frame. Things began to unravel in the bottom of the third, allowing four runs to score before his night was over. Thursday's start marked the 18th time that Priester has allowed five or more earned runs since 2019. Priester continues to rehab from injury and make it back to Milwaukee where he has not appeared in a regular season game since September 26 during the 2025 season. The 25-year-old ended the 2025 year posting a stellar 13-3 record with a 3.32 ERA in 29 appearances (24 starts) for the Brewers.

BOUND TO HAPPEN: The Sounds were shutout for the second time this season with a 6-0 loss on Thursday night. The first shutout loss came against the Gwinnett Stripers back on April 8 with a 5-0 loss. It was the fourth time Nashville has been shutout by the Bulls since 2021, including getting shutout in the 2022 International League Championship 13-0. Thursday's loss marked the Sounds 156th shutout loss since 2005, with 12 of them coming in the 2017 season as a single-season high.

WHAT THAT THANG BADD00: Major League Rehabber Akil Baddoo crushed his first two career Sounds home runs with a pair of solo shots on Wednesday night. He belted a leadoff home run on the second pitch of the game and Nashville's second leadoff home run this season after Jett Williams did it on April 18 vs. Worcester. He added his second in the top of the fifth inning to break a 2-2 tie and the first of Nashville's eight unanswered runs en route to the win. It was the fifth multi-HR game of his career and first since August 23, 2025, with Toledo on the road on the Rochester. All five multi-HR games have come since making his Triple-A debut in 2021 and four of the five have been while on the road. His first inning blast was the ninth leadoff home run of his professional career and first since April 18, 2025, at Indianapolis. For his minor league career, Baddoo now has 30 career home runs when hitting in the one spot of the batting order with a career .258 AVG and 62 doubles, 21 triples, and 103 RBI. The 11-year veteran hit a single-season career-high 16 homers last year in 110 games between Triple-A Toledo and Low-A Lakeland. The 2025 season was his third straight with double-digit home runs.

HOW FAR???: Eddys Leonard's 445 foot no-doubter on Wednesday was the farthest home run hit by a Nashville player this season. His home run is tied for the 26th longest HR in Triple-A this season (T-16th in the International League). It was the third longest tracked home run of his professional career, and three feet shorter than the 448 foot home run he hit at Durham on May 11 of last year with Gwinnett. Leonard leads the team with eight home runs and has the fifth-most HR in the Brewers farm system in 2026. He currently ranks eighth in SLG (.594) and ninth in OPS (1.006) in Triple-A while his 21 XBH are tied for the 10th most. He also ranks top 10 in the International League in doubles (T-4th, 12), total bases (T-8th, 85), RBI (T-7th, 33), and AVG (9th, .329).
