SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

THE OLD RECORD BOOKS? THEY'RE USELESS: During the Shuckers' 18-1 win over the Birmingham Barons on Thursday, the Shuckers set new single-game franchise records with 18 runs and 22 hits.

- The 18 runs broke the previous franchise record of 16, set on May 29, 2022 against the Montgomery Biscuits... The 18 runs are tied with the Birmingham Barons on June 28, 2023 and the Chattanooga Lookouts on August 18, 2023 for the second-most runs scored in a game in Regions Field history (since 2013).
- Their 22 hits broke the previous record of 20, set on May 13, 2015 at the Jackson Generals and tied on August 2, 2017 against the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp and on July 21, 2021 against the Mississippi Braves.
- The win was also Biloxi's 70th of the year, marking the sixth time in franchise history the Shuckers have reached the mark... It's the first year Biloxi's won at least 70 games since they won 80 in back-to-back years in 2018 and 2019.

NOW THAT'S A WWWWWWWWWWINNING STREAK: With a win on Thursday night, the Shuckers have won 10 straight games, tied for the longest winning streak in the franchise history (since 2015)... The record was originally set at 10 straight wins between July 12-22, 2019 and tied again later in the year from August 5-16, 2019... Over the 10-game win streak, the Shuckers have outscored opponents 76-26 (+50) and have scored at least five runs in eight of the 10 games.

The Shuckers also enter today with a 10-game road winning streak, the longest in franchise history... Since August 15, the start of the Shuckers' series against the M-Braves, Biloxi has won 14 of their last 15 road games.

MULTI-HIT MADNESS: OF Carlos Rodriguez tied his career-high with four hits on Thursday, reaching the mark for the first time since September 5, 2021 against the Beloit Snappers as a member of the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers... Rodriguez enters today with a .295 average, .001 away from the league lead (.296), currently held by Pensacola's 1B Troy Johnston.

lf the season ended today, Rodriguez would own the third-highest single-season average in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015)... The only Shuckers player to finish the season in the top-three for the batting title was 1B Patrick Leonard, who finished runner-up in 2019 after hitting .301.

ONE OF A KIND: OF Jackson Chourio tallied his 40th stolen base of the year on Thursday, becoming the first Double-A player since at least 2005 to record at least 20 home runs and 40 stolen bases in a season... Chourio is also one of three players in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015) to reach 40 stolen bases in a season, joining INF Tyler Black (47, 2023) and **OF Johnny Davis** (52, 2017)... Chourio previously became the first teenager in Double-A and/or Triple-A to record a 20/20 season since **OF Delmon Young** in 2005.

PLAYOFFS? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS: If the season ended today, the Biloxi Shuckers would miss the 2023 Southern League Playoffs... The Shuckers have two paths to make the playoffs for the first time since 2019; win the South Division in the second half OR finish runner-up in the division if the Pensacola Blue Wahoos win the second-half

📚 The Shuckers are a half-game behind the Montgomery Biscuits for the division lead with nine games remaining... The two teams will face each other for the final six games of the year at MGM Park... The Shuckers would face the Blue Wahoos in the South Division Championship Series if they qualify.

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP CHRISTIAN MEJIAS [6-10, 6.85]: RHP Christian Mejias makes his 24th start of the year after he earned his second straight win on September 2 at Tennessee... Over his last two starts, Mejias has allowed four runs in 10.1 innings with six strikeouts... Mejias has pitched into the fifth inning in each of his last three starts.
