2025 Media Notes – August 10th vs Hub City (Rangers)

South Atlantic League Champions: 2006, 2009, 2010

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Jersey Shore BlueClaws (23-17/48-55) vs Hub City Spartanburgers (22-19/53-53)

Series: Game 6 of 6 (Jersey Shore leads season series 5-0 of 6)

Last Game Recap...Hub City scored three times in the top of the 10th inning and topped the BlueClaws 8-5 on Saturday night at ShoreTown Ballpark, ending the BlueClaws win streak at seven games...Devin Saltiban and Diego Gonzalez both homered for the BlueClaws...The Spartanburgers took the lead on a bases loaded walk issued by Titan Kennedy-Hayes...It was the first extra-innings loss by the BlueClaws this season (they are the last team in the minors to lose in extras this year).

The Claws Are Hot...The BlueClaws (4-1 this week) are 15-4 since the All-Star break (though they have lost a half-game to Greensboro in that time) and took five of six from Brooklyn last week after a 6-2 homestand against Hudson Valley (2-0) and Wilmington (4-2)...Jersey Shore enters the day 7.5 games behind first place Greensboro – they have been as many as 8.5 games out in the second half (as recently as July 26th when they were 13-15).

Comeback Claws...The BlueClaws have trailed 2-0 in two of their three wins over Hub City this week, and trailed by two in two of their five wins last week in Brooklyn...In their 15 wins since the break, they have trailed in seven of them (biggest deficit was 3-0 down in a 5-4 win over Wilmington on July 24th).

Pitching Wins...Since the All-Star Break ended on July 18th (a stretch in which the BlueClaws are 15-4), the BlueClaws have a team ERA of just 2.77 (52 ER in 169 innings) including a starting pitcher ERA of 2.18 in that stretch (21 ER in 86.1 innings).

Aloha Means Goodbye...Devin Saltiban hit his 5th home run of the year on Saturday, his third since the All-Star break...He also homered on both July 23rd and 24th, his first two since returning...He had been on the IL since May 8th, was activated on July 18th (14-72, 4 2Bs, 3 HRs, 6 RBIs since return)...He hit 17 home runs with Clearwater last year...Saltiban was 8-17 with a home run in his first four May games before his injury...He has played centerfield since returning, the position he played most in high school but hadn't played as a professional until his rehab assignment with the FCL Phillies...The 20 year old from Hilo, Hawaii was the Phillies 3rd round pick in 2023.

Go Go Diego...Diego Gonzalez had two hits including a three run home run on Saturday, his first home run with the BlueClaws and eighth of his career (he hit one with Clearwater in May)...Gonzalez is 4-14 since Wednesday, when he assumed the starting shortstop role following Bryan Rincon's injury...He hit .145 with Clearwater before joining the BlueClaws on July 22nd, going on the Development List...He was activated on July 31st.

Take the A[O] Train...Avery Owusu-Asiedu's walk-off single on Thursday was his second game winning hit of the week after he had a two run triple in the eighth inning on Tuesday that gave the BlueClaws a 5-4 win over Hub City (both hits were off RHP Anthony Susac)...He had three hits on Friday, his third three-hit game with Jersey Shore...Owusu-Asiedu joined the BlueClaws on June 24th from Clearwater, hit .313 in July and is 29-99 (.293) since July 1st...He hit .268 with Clearwater adding five home runs and has two with Jersey Shore...He was a ninth round pick in 2023 from Southern Illinois.

They're Going...The BlueClaws have nine steals in the first five games of this series and they are now 42-44 since the All-Star Break...Bryan Rincon (placed on 60-day IL on Thursday) has 13 in that stretch to lead the team while Avery Owusu-Asiedu has seven...The BlueClaws stole 18 bases (nine by Rincon) last week in Brooklyn.

Of the Month...RHP Alex McFarlane was named Phillies Minor League Pitcher of the Month for July...The right-hander made four starts last month and gave up four runs in 17 innings with 23 strikeouts and seven walks, and he has allowed four earned runs in 22 innings with 32 strikeouts in his last five starts overall...Since July 24th, he has allowed four runs in 26 innings with 35 strikeouts...He was a 4th round pick in 2022 from the University of Miami.

Northern Burlington to the Jersey Shore...RHP Ryan Dromboski joined the BlueClaws on August 7th and gave up two runs in 3.2 innings of his debut on Saturday...Born in Hamilton, New Jersey, he starred at Northern Burlington Regional High School, just 37 miles from ShoreTown Ballpark, and then pitched at the University of Pennsylvania, where he was the Ivy League Pitcher of the Year in 2023...Dromboski began the year with Clearwater, where he was 7-5 with a 2.63 ERA, adding 53 strikeouts in 19 innings...He grew up a Phillies fan.

Off the Duck...John Spikerman (2-16, 4 walks, 2 RBIs) got his first two BlueClaws hits in the win on Friday...The Phillies 3rd round pick last year (University of Oklahoma), he joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater where he had three home runs in 28 games while hitting .238...Spikerman added 12 stolen bases with the Threshers...He hit .367 last year with Oklahoma and helped the Sooners reach the College World Series in 2022 as a freshman...He is the highest-drafted player from last year's draft class to reach the BlueClaws...Spikerman is the #15 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline.

Hawaii Part Two...Kodey Shojinaga (2-9, RBI double) becomes the second Hawaiian on the BlueClaws (Devin Saltiban), coming from Clearwater where he was hitting .229 with a home run and 33 RBIs...He threw out 31% of opposing base-stealers with the Threshers...He was a 6th round pick last year from the University of Kansas...Shojinaga is a native of Honolulu.

The Kiwi...Nikau Pouaka-Gregg (1-4) joins the BlueClaws from Clearwater, where he was hitting .216 with a home run and 12 RBIs...A native of Christchurch, New Zealand, he burst onto the scene in 2022 hitting .301 with three home runs in the Florida Complex League but missed 2023 with a torn ACL...He has played in the Australian Baseball League with the Adelaide Giants and will not turn 21 until September 13th...He is the second BlueClaw from New Zealand, joining RHP Kyle Glogoski (2019-22) and one of only two currently in Minor League Baseball.

Shake and Bake...Andrew Baker struck out six over two scoreless innings on Saturday...He entered July with one career save, a 2023 save with Reading...Since the start of July, he has six saves (in seven chances), three back of Saul Teran for the team lead...Since the start of July, he has allowed four runs in 15.1 innings with 21 strikeouts and four walks (three runs came in Aberdeen on July 12th, a three-run home run by Thomas Sosa).

Fitting in Just Fine...Aroon Escobar had two hits on Tuesday, two more on August 2nd, and drove in the game winning runs with a 2-run single in the 7th inning on July 31st, breaking a 3-3 tie to give the BlueClaws a 5-3 win...He drove in three runs in the win on July 18th against Hudson Valley...Escobar is the #4 prospect in the Phillies system per MLB Pipeline, and joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater on July 8th...Escobar was hitting .285 with 11 home runs, 42 RBIs, and 10 stolen bases with the Threshers...At the time of his promotion, Escobar was 6th in the FSL in average, T1st (with teammate Eduardo Tait) in home runs, 5th in RBIs, 1st in hits (78), and 1st in runs (52). Hit .360 with five home runs and a 1.088 OPS in April, winning Phillies Minor League Player of the Month.

Lights Out Saul...Saul Teran (two saves this week – Tuesday and Friday) is the first BlueClaw with nine saves since they became a High-A affiliate in 2021 (three players had eight including Jonathan Hughes and Aidan Anderson in 2022)...He has allowed three runs in 16.2 innings with Jersey Shore, adding 15 strikeouts and his nine saves lead the team...He gave up two earned runs in 18 innings, adding 31 strikeouts and three walks with Clearwater before originally joining the BlueClaws on June 2nd...Teran, 23, signed with the Phillies in 2021.

Extra, Extra...Extra innings? No problem! After their win on August 3rd in Brooklyn, the BlueClaws are 7-1 in extra innings this season...They were the last team in the minors without an extra innings loss, until they fell 8-5 in 10 on August 9th against Hub City.

Big Innings...The BlueClaws have allowed four-plus runs in an inning 30 times this season, the last time on July 23rd vs Wilmington (Asheville has allowed 36 such innings), in 27 different games over which they are 2-26...Their second win was on 6/7 at Bowling Green (allowed four runs in the seventh and won in 10)...Their other win in a game in which they allowed four runs in an inning was game two of the 4/12 double-header against Aberdeen, an 8-7 come-from-behind win (Eduardo Lopez go-ahead home run in the 5th of the seven inning game)...16 of the 30 innings have included multiple walks.

From the Draft...The BlueClaws quickly went from having one member of the 2024 draft class (7th round pick, OF Joel Drago) to having five, adding four members of that class on August 5th – OF John Spikerman (3rd round, Oklahoma), C Kodey Shojinaga (6th round, Kansas), RHP Titan Kennedy-Hayes (11th round, Austin Peay State), and LHP Kevin Warunek (18th round, Longwood).

Balk This Way...The BlueClaws balked (Erubiel Armenta) on July 26th, their MiLB-leading 37th of the year (one more than Asheville)...They are in balking distance of the 48 set by Lynchburg in 2023, the most in minors since at least 2005...Jersey Shore has balked in nine runs this year, tied with Asheville for the most in the minors... The BlueClaws had a club record five balks on 5/9 vs Aberdeen, and four each on 6/27 and 6/29 at Brooklyn...This year, only three teams have issued at least four balks in a game, the BlueClaws three times, and Aberdeen on 5/1 at Brooklyn (4)...The BlueClaws single-season record was 20 (last year).

New to the Phillies...The BlueClaws roster includes three players that were acquired by the Phillies in the off-season: RHP Gabriel Barbosa (Minor League Rule-5 Draft from the Yankees), RHP Aaron Combs (from the White Sox for LHP Tyler Gilbert), RHP Josh Hejka (from the Mets in February for cash considerations)...C Luis Caicuto was a Minor League Rule-5 pick from the Diamondbacks in December of 2023...The Phillies were the only team to use six picks in the 2024 Minor League Rule-5 Draft (three of which have been released with Jersey Shore – OF Elio Prado, RHP Augusto Calderon, OF Eduardo Lopez).

Comebacks...The BlueClaws erased a 4-0 deficit on May 10th to come back and top Aberdeen 9-8, matching their largest comeback win of the season...Their win on 4/17 at Greensboro was their first of the season in which they trailed after the 8th inning – they had five such wins last year (last one was 7/21/24 at Brooklyn when they tied the game in the 9th inning on an RBI double from Felix Reyes and scored three times in the 10th)...Meanwhile, the BlueClaws lost a 7-0 lead on 4/18 at Greensboro, their largest blown lead since also losing a 7-0 at Greensboro, on 5/31/15, and the fourth time since 2011 (4/19/12 at Hagerstown and 4/22/11 at Asheville) they have lost a seven run lead...The BlueClaws gave up two in the ninth to fall on 5/3 at Hudson Valley, a game they led in the ninth after a Jordan Viars tie-breaking home run put them up 4-3 earlier in the inning.

The Deadline – Tait Traded...With Eduardo Tait’s trade to Minnesota, this is the fifth straight season the BlueClaws have had a player traded as part of a deadline deal. 2025 – Eduardo Tait to Minnesota (Jhoan Duran)...2024 – George Klassen to the Angels (Carlos Estevez) and William Bergolla to the White Sox (Tanner Banks)...2023 – Hao-Yu Lee to Detroit (Michael Lorenzen)...2022 – Ben Brown to the Cubs (David Robertson), Brown had been promoted to Reading one day before the trade but his last appearance was with the BlueClaws...2021 – Tyler Burch to Baltimore (Freddy Galvis) and Kevin Gowdy to Texas (Kyle Gibson).

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have two walk-off wins this year – an 8/7 win over Hub City on a 9th inning single from Avery Owusu-Asiedu and a 5/6 win over Aberdeen on a home run by Kehden Hettiger...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 –July 23rd vs Abedeem (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen.

Snapped at Four...The BlueClaws entered 2025 with four straight winning halves (a streak that has been snapped), both halves in 2023 and 2024, all four halves managed by Greg Brodzinski...The BlueClaws had 10 straight winning halves from 2006 through 2010, all 10 halves in that five year stretch, a streak snapped when they went 33-35 in the first half of the 2011 season.

New to ShoreTown...Of the 31 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 13 are making their BlueClaws debuts this season...Of the remaining 18, 14 were with the BlueClaws at the end of the 2024 season (the remaining four were with Reading: RHP Andrew Baker, RHP Tommy McCollum, C Jordan Dissin, IF Zach Arnold)...Baker, McCollum, and Dissin have all been promoted to Reading, though Baker has since returned.

Just Grand...Bryan Rincon’s grand slam on 5/20 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin’s on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...127 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show*...Otto Kemp made his Phillies debut on 6/7 and Mick Abel made his Phillies debut on 5/18, the first two to debut this year...Two debuted last year (Ben Brown debuted with the Cubs and Sam Aldegheri debuted with the Angels)...Aldegheri, who was with the BlueClaws from Opening Day 2024 through July 6th, joins Orion Kerkerling (2023) as the only players to ever play for the BlueClaws and in the big leagues in the same year (non-rehab).

Just Win Baby...The BlueClaws are the only team in the South Atlantic League and High-A to win more than 70 games in both 2023 (73-58) and 2024 (74-58).

Bull Back for a Third...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2025 after leading the BlueClaws to a 73-58 mark in 2023 (and a postseason berth) and a 74-58 mark in 2024...He is the first manager to lead the BlueClaws in three seasons (Pi Forbes in 2004-05, Steve Roadcap in 2007-08, Mickey Morandini in 2012-13, Shawn Williams in 2015-16 and Marty Malloy in 2017-18 are the five managers to manage the BlueClaws for two seasons)...Brodzinski was a coach with Lehigh Valley in 2022 and on the Phillies staff in 2020 and 2021...He is a graduate of Bishop Eustace Prep in Pennsauken, New Jersey.

On the Staff...Ryan Buchter joins the BlueClaws as the pitching coach after spending the last two seasons with Lehigh Valley...Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey...Matt Snyder is the hitting coach in his first year in the organization – he was the Assistant Hitting Coordinator for the Marlins last year and in their organization as a coach since 2020...Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws as the Bench Coach...2021-22 BlueClaws C Herbert Iser makes his coaching debut as the Development Coach...Iser played in the Phillies system from 2019 through 2023 and played collegiately at Dallas Baptist.
