TODAY'S GAME: The Curve continue up a six-game set with Akron for their final matchups of the year, Altoona is 8-11 vs. the 'Ducks.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona swipped the series opener from Akron on the strength of a 5-run 6th inning to take a 7-5 win. Nick Gonza**les** picked up 3 hits, including 2 doubles, and **Henry Davis** added 2 hits in his return from the IL.

24: Last night Matt Gorski, who is rated as Pittsburgh's 22nd-best prospect according to MLB Pipeline, connected for his 24th home run of the season while on rehab with Low-A Bradenton, tying Aaron Shackelford for the organizational lead in that department. The last time the Pirates had two minor leaguers hit at least 14 home runs in a season was 2007 when Steve Pearce hit 31 while Jonel Pacheco finished second (27).

BLAKEY: Catcher Blake Sabol was promoted to Triple-A Indianapolis following Altoona's series at Bowie. Sabol finishes his time with the Curve on an 11-game hit streak during which he batted .395 (17-for-43) with 5 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 7 RBI and a 1.124 OPS. Following play on Sunday, August 28, Sabol ranked 3rd in the EL in BA (.281), 6th in SLG % (.486) and 8th in OPS (.833).

HAMMERIN' HANK IS BACK: Catcher Henry Davis has returned to Altoona's active roster after a 7-week stint on the IL. Davis, the No.1 overall selection in the 2021 draft out of Lousiville, last appeared for Altoona on Saturday, July 2. In a four-game rehab assign ment at Low-A Bradenton, Davis batted 3-for-9 with 1 HR and 2 RBI and he picked up 2 hits in his return to the lineup on August 30.

ACTIVE 1'S: For the first time in franchise history, Altoona has 4 First Round draft picks on the active roster at the same time with Connor Scott (13th overall, 2018 by Miami), Quinn Priester (19th overall, 2019), Nick Gonzales (7th overall, 2020) and Henry Davis (1st overall, 2021) active for Altoona

BIG TREE HIT BALL HARD: Infielder Jared Triolo was playing some of his best baseball on both sides of the ball until his trip to the IL on Tuesday, August 30 with a left knee injury. Triolo is amid a 16-game on-base streak (8/9 - Present) in which he's batting: 354/.419/.646/1.065 with 5 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 7 RBI and 3-3 SB. Triolo scored a run in 8 straight games (8/14 - 8/25), the longest active streak in the Eastern League. In his last 54 games (6/21 - Present), Triolo has a .402 on-base percentage with 26 extra base hits. He's reached base safely in 21-of-22 games in August.

K-MAN: Right-hander Luis Ortiz has 126 strikeouts on the season; becoming the first Curve pitcher with 100 strikeouts in a season since Taylor Hearn in 2018. Ortiz struck out 10 Bowie Baysox on Friday, August 26, the first 10+ strikeout performance for the Curve since Roansy Contreras struck out 10 on 6/15/21 at Erie. Should Ortiz stay on turn in the rotation, he would have 4 more starts in the regular season; he needs just 16 strikeouts to match the team's franchise record for strikeouts in a season (lan Snell, 2004: 142).

NICKY G IS BACK: After missing 10 weeks of the season with a right foot injury, Infielder Nick Gonzales has reached base safely in each of his first 12 games since his activation batting: .292/.426/.479 (14-for-48) with 6 2B, 1 HR, 9 RBI, 10 BB since his return.

ENDY'S TIME: Prior to Altoona's series with Binghamton, the Pirates promoted the No. 5 prospect in the system according to MLB. com, C Endy Rodriguez. Rodrigurez picked up at least one hit in 14-of-16 games with the Curve and driven in 17 runs. He had a hit in 12 straight games to begin his Curve career, a stretch that ended on August 26 at Bowie.

STOLEN HEARTS: The Curve have stolen 144 bases on the season, on pace to break the franchise record of 159 (2014) with 19 games to play. Altoona has 3 players, Jared Triolo (24), Liover Peguero (23) and Andres Alvarez (20), with 20 stolen bases for the second time in franchise history: first since 2014 when Keon Broxton and Alen Hanson each had 25 and Drew Maggi stole 37 bases.

THE RUBBERDUCKIES: Managed by Rouglas Odor, Akron enters the series on the fringe of the second half division playoff race. Their roster features several top Guardians prospects despite the promotions of INF Bryan Rocchio and OF George Valera to Triple-A. RHP Gavin Williams (#3), RHP Tanner Bibee (#8), INF Angel Martinez (#12), OF Jhonkensy Noel (#17), INF Jose Tena (#18), RHP Tanner Burns (#19), C Bryan Lavastida (#26) and LHP Doug Nikhazy (#28) highlight the current 'Ducks roster.

THE FIRST ONTO THE POND: Righty Tanner Bibee takes the ball on Wednesday night. Bibee made his Double-A debut against the Curve with 5.0 scoreless innings on July 7 at Canal Park. With the Ducks he's gone 3-1 with a 1.45 ERA (8 ER / 49.2 IP) with 52 K's and just 8 BB. Drafted in the 5th round in 2021 out of Cal State-Fullerton, Bibee went 2-1 with a 2.59 ERA in 12 starts at High-A Lake County to start the season. He struck out 86 batters in 59.0 innings pitched. Bibee enters today as the No. 8 prospect in the Guardians system. Despite growing up in Misson Viejo, California, Bibee appears to be a Dallas Cowboys fan which is unfortunate because you'd think he would pick a football team to root for that occassionally wins playoff games (like the 49ers or Rams).

2007 - Dewon Brazelton throws a complete-game, three-hit shutout in Erie, winning 6-0 (game was suspended from 8/19 and completed on 8/31); Matt Peterson sets the franchise's new single-season saves record vith 28th save during 3-0 win at Erie. Recorded 29th the next day.

2013 - Jason Grilli pitches a scoreless first inning on MLB rehab assignment, becoming the ninth MLB player to appear on rehab in 2013, the most in a single season in Curve history.
