YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Baysox, 5-1. Carter Aldrete gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the fourth with an RBI single but Bowie answered with a run-scoring double by John Rhodes to even the score in the fifth. In the sixth, Will Wilson hit a solo homer to move Richmond back in front. Victor Bericoto brought home a run and Andy Thomas added a two-run double to extend the lead to 5-1. John Michael Bertrand started and threw five innings, allowing one run. Wil Jensen improved to 7-0, throwing a scoreless sixth inning. Parker Dunshee and Tyler Myrick covered the final three innings to finish the game.

TÜDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. Richmond won four-of-five in Bowie from April 25-29 and went 3-4 in a series at Prince George's Stadium from June 13-18. The two teams split the most recent series at The Diamond from July 4-9, with the Flying Squirrels taking the first three and the Baysox winning the last three.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 27-16 in their last 43 games since June 18 They went 2-4 in last week's series at Altoona and are 2-1 in this series against the Baysox. Over the last 48 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 2.98 ERA (61 ER/184.0 IP) and have allowed 13 home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.78 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 385.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 518.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.56 ERA, which is the third-lowest in Double-A and the eighth-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors. In four games dating back to Sunday, the Richmond offense has scored 31 runs (7.8 per game), which is tied with Somerset for the most in the league.

THE BAYSOX went 4-2 in last week's home series against the Sea Dogs after going 1-5 the previous week on the road against the Patriots. Bowie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including SS Jackson Holliday (No. 1), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 9), OF Jud Fabian (No. 14), 3B Max Wagner (No. 15), OF John Rhodes (No. 21), OF Billy Cook (No. 28) and RHP Alex Pham (No. 30). Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes six Baysox players, including Holliday (No. 1), Fabian (No. 10), Pham (No. 17), Wagner (No. 19), Beavers (No. 21) and Rhodes (No. 29). Holliday is also rated as the No. 1 prospect in baseball.

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Hayden Birdsong makes second Double-A start. He made his debut on Saturday in Altoona and worked two scoreless innings before surrendering three runs in the third and one in the fourth. He finished the outing with five strikeouts. On the year, he leads all Giants minor league pitchers in strikeouts (121). Among all MiLB pitchers who have worked at least 80 innings, he is ranked second in strikeout percentage (35.4) and third in K/9 (13.44). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and pitched 12 games (10 starts). With San Jose, he led the California League in strikeouts (70) prior to his promotion to High-A Eugene on June 13. With the Emeralds, he went 2-1 with a 1.55 ERA in his final six starts before being promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 4. During his time with Eugene from June 13-July 30, he led the Northwest League in WHIP (0.92) and ranked second in strikeouts (46). Birdsong was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Eastern Illinois University, where he played two seasons minutes from his hometown. Birdsong is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 10 by MLB.com. For more information on Birdsong, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Carlos Tavera makes his 14th start of the season and his 20th overall appearance this year. He last pitched on Saturday against the Sea Dogs out of the bullpen and picked up a win, allowing three runs over three innings. Tavera has made four appearances against Richmond this season, going 0-2 with a 9.52 ERA (12 ER/11.1 IP). On April 26 in Bowie, he surrendered five runs (three earned) in 2.2 innings out of the bullpen. He made a start in the series opener in Bowie on June 13 and allowed four runs in three innings in a no-decision. He picked up a loss in the finale of that series at Prince George's Stadium on June 18, recording two outs and allowing four runs. He was charged with another loss at The Diamond in a start on July 6, despite allowing one run on two hits over five innings. Tavera is in his first Double-A season. He was selected by the Orioles in the fifth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of UT-Arlington.

STARTING STRONG: In last week's series, Richmond starting pitchers opened the set throwing 20 innings without allowing a run until the third inning on Saturday night. Last Tuesday, Carson Seymour held the Curve scoreless through five innings, allowing one hit with a season-high nine strikeouts. Spencer Bivens threw four scoreless innings, allowing one hit, in his start last Wednesday night. Last Thursday, Wil Jensen allowed two hits over four scoreless innings, his third scoreless outing in three starts this season. John Michael Bertrand threw five scoreless innings in his start last Friday night. Hayden Birdsong made his Double-A debut last Saturday and threw two scoreless innings before allowing three runs in the third. Ryan Murphy allowed two runs in his three innings on Sunday afternoon. To open this week's series, Seymour picked up a win, allowing one run over five innings. On Wednesday, Bivens allowed one run over 3.1 innings. Bertrand surrendered one run over five innings on Thursday, Richmond starters have a 2.15 ERA (9 ER/37.2 IP) in nine games since August 2.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 33 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are leading the Southwest Division Second-Half standings by one game over the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half. The Harrisburg Senators are in third place, two games behind Richmond, and have won four straight games. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (336,808) and average attendance (6,477) this year. They are also 13th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 36 times in his last 15 games since July 25 (18 hits and 18 walks), hitting .362 (17-for-47) with two homers, four doubles, one triple and nine RBIs adding a .529 on-base percentage. On July 30 against the Sea Dogs, he hit a three-run homer and finished the afternoon with four RBIs. He went 4-for-5 with three runs scored last Wednesday night against the Curve. He added two doubles and two RBIs in Sunday's game at Altoona. On Wednesday, he hit a two-run homer and walked twice. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 126 walks, moving ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

BERICOTO BASHING: Over his last eight games since August 2, **Victor Bericoto** is batting .323 (10-for-31) with two doubles, a triple and four RBIs. He has multiple hits in four-of-his-last-eight games, including five hits across Sunday and Tuesday. In Tuesday's series-opener, Bericoto had a Double-A-high three hits, including a double, and drove in a run. On the season, he leads all Giants organization hitters with 18 home runs, including 16 with High-A Eugene and two with Richmond.

FULL MUNGUIA: In his 18 games since returning from the IL, Ismael Munguia is batting .304 (21-for-69) with two doubles, seven walks and nine RBIs. He picked up four hits in his three games in his first series back on the road in Akron from July 21-23. He had nine hits and two walks over six games in the last home series against the Sea Dogs. He hit .227 (5-for-22) in last week's series against the Curve but picked up three walks in the Sunday finale. Munguia was placed on the injured list on May 20 and scientified as hith 20 missing 49 games. reinstated on July 20, missing 49 games.

GLOW SHOW: Over his last 26 games since July 1, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .310 (27-for-87) with four homers, seven doubles, 20 RBIs and nine walks. On July 18 at Akron, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On July 29 against the Sea Dogs, he hit a lead-off double to start the bottom of the ninth in Richmond's comeback win. He is hitting .389 (7-for-18) in his last six games since August 2 with two doubles, three walks and six RBIs

LOGAN'S LIFTOFF: On Tuesday night, **Logan Wyatt** drove a three-run, go-ahead homer. It was his 12th-overall home run of the season, which is the seventh-most in the Giants minor leagues. It was also hit first home run since he went deep three times in a five-game stretch from June 23-30, snapping a 26-game homerless drought. Over a 21-game stretch from July 6-August 5, Wyatt hit .156 (10-for-64) with eight walks and four RBIs. In his last four games, he is batting .357 (5-for-14) with a homer and four RBIs.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28), Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
