NEWS & NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: CHIEFS 3, KERNELS 2

The Chiefs completed their sweep of Cedar Rapids on Sunday... The Kernels grabbed the game's first lead in the second inning after Jose Salas' sacrifice fly to make it 1-0...Peoria answered in the fourth inning, scoring three runs on two hits and three walks off Ivran Romero, who eventually suffered the loss...Anyelo Encarnación walked in a run, Chase Heath hit a sac fly and Cameron Nickens had an RBI single...Peoria starter Nate Dohm allowed just the one run on four hits over his three innings, walking none and striking out three...Patrick Galle and Trey Pooser escaped two-out, bases-load-ed jams in the fifth and sixth, respectively...In the eighth, Graham Brown's RBI double made it a one-run game off Dylan Driessen...With a 3-2 lead in the home ninth, Rubén Menes faced two runners in scoring position with nobody out, but escaped the jam to earn his second save.

BREAK OUT THE BROOMS

The Chiefs took their second six-game sweep of the season on Sunday at Cedar Rapids, becoming the first visiting team to sweep the Kernels in a six-game series at Veterans Memorial Stadium since Minor League Baseball adopted the current six-game series format in 2021. It marks Peoria's fifth six-game sweep all-time. The Chiefs outscored the Kernels 45-25 in the set and posted an .839 OPS with 10 HRs. The Chiefs have won back-to-back sets for the first time since taking four of seven at Wisconsin May 26-31 and sweeping Beloit June 2-7.

WINNING WAYS

- The Chiefs own an above .500 record for the first time since they were 32-31 on June 14, three games before the end of the first half. Peoria has won 10 of its last 12 games and have climbed to third in the MWL West, 3.5 games back of first-place Beloit.

- Peoria's six-game win streak is their third six-game win streak of the season. A seventh consecutive win would mark the Chiefs longest win streak since Peoria won eight consecutive games from July 29-August 6, 2023.

ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES

The Chiefs, in conjunction with the Cardinals, announced 14 transactions prior to Tuesday's game:

- RHP Tanner Franklin, RHP Yhoiker Fajardo, OF Tai Peete and INF Jack Gurevitch were promoted to AA Springfield. The quartet made up Peoria's four of the Chiefs five top-30 Cardinals prospects per MLB Pipeline. Franklin allowed just 4 ER in his final four starts (1.83 ERA), while Fajardo ranked 2nd in the MWL with 108 strikeouts. Gurevitch's 17 HRs with the Chiefs set a new club High-A record. Since the All-Star Break, Peete batted .365 with a 1.248 OPS, popping 5 HRs. He hit for his second cycle of the season on Saturday at Cedar Rapids.

- The Chiefs added seven players from A-Palm Beach: LHP Cade Crossland, LHP Brandon Clarke, RHP Zeke Wood, RHP Nelfy Ynfante, INF Ryan Weingartner, UTL Brayden Smith and OF Yordalin Pena. Pena set Palm Beach's Single-A HR record with 15 before his promotion. Crossland and Clarke are top-30 Cardinals prospects and are slated to join the starting rotation this week.

- RHP Dominic Freeberger and OF Cameron Nickens were released. Anyelo Encarnación placed on the Dev. list.

BOMBS AWAY

Peoria's 141 home runs lead the Midwest League and have set a new franchise record. Their .456 slugging percentage also leads the circuit. The Chiefs have gone deep 26 times in the last two series, the most in High-A in that span. The Chiefs .892 OPS since July 21 is the best in the Midwest League, while their 83 runs are second-most (SB).

COMFORTABLE WHEN IT'S CLOSE

The Chiefs have won their last five one-run games, including three one-run victories last week at Cedar Rapids. Peoria is 27-23 in games decided by three or fewer runs this season.

STARTING STRONG

Peoria's rotation owns the second-best ERA (Greenville - BOS) in High-A since July 19 at 3.11 (19 ER in 55 IP).

CLEAN NINTH

With Sunday's clean ninth inning from Rubén Menes, the Chiefs' 1.71 ninth-inning ERA leads all of High-A and ranks third in affiliated baseball, behind the San Diego Padres (0.85) and AA-Rocket City (1.49). Peoria pitchers allowed just one earned run in the ninth inning in July (two weeks ago).

SCOUTING REPORT

- Works with five pitch mix: FB (up to 99), CV (low mid 80s), SL (upper 80s, up to 90), CH (upper 80s), 2-SM

Baseball America - Cardinals No. 17 prospect: "The 6-foot-5 Odle has good size and a simple, repeatable operation that stays connected through release. He only generates moderate extension, delivering the ball from a higher three quarters arm slot. ... Odle's four-seam fastball sits 96-98 mph touching 99 mph with above-average ride and good plane to the plate. His curveball is his primary secondary pitch with heavy two-plane movement..." Added to top-30 in May

MLB Pipeline - Cardinals No. 11 prospect: "Odle benefited from overeager Single-A hitters early this season and quickly ran into control issues in his move to High-A, where opponents were more disciplined against all pitch types. He can rush his delivery a bit, leading to a loss of fastball command up and to the arm side, but in general, there should be enough control to keep the starting dream alive. His combination of heat and breakers would absolutely play in shorter stints if a bullpen move eventually comes."

SEASON NOTES

LAST TIME OUT: Dealt five shutout innings - his third start with 5+ innings and no runs with the Chiefs - on 7/28 at CR.

RACKING UP MILEAGE: Has set a career high in innings pitched with 71... Prior career high was 51.2, set last season.

THAT'S A LOT OF K'S: Has posted a 12.93 K/9 rate in 71 IP this season. Is one of just six pitchers in MiLB with a 12+ K/9 rate, and an ERA of 3.00 or better in 65+ innings pitched... Has struck out six or more in 12 of 18 appearances... 33% strikeout rate between A+ and A (MLB avg is 22%).

DOMINANT AT DOZER: Has allowed 2 ER in 20.2 IP (0.87) in four starts at Dozer Park... Has pitched to a 6.75 ERA in 17.1 IP in five road starts...

ABOUT JACOB

ORIGIN STORY: Drafted by Cardinals in 14th round of 2023 draft out of Orange Coast CC... Opened career at UC-Irvine in 2022 but did not pitch. Transferred to OCC for 2023, made 13 appearances for the Pirates, pitching 14.1 relief innings to a 6.91 ERA... Points to former big leaguers Jamie Moyer, Heath Bell and Mike Sweeney as major influences; played on teams with all three of their sons

JACOB, MEET TOMMY: Underwent Tommy John surgery and missed all of 2024 season after brief pro debut in 2023... Returned in May 2025.

WHAT HE'S SAYING: "[Before surgery] I never really took care of myself. I never lifted. I never really did any arm care. I (would) just kind of get up there and throw. But then coming back last year taught me a lot of what I need to do to feel good and ready and to maintain arm health."

BACK IN HIGH SCHOOL: Attended St. Augustine High School in San Diego... Alma mater of former Chief and current Blue Jays hitting coach David Popkins, plus 5 big leaguers...

COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO ESPINOZA

MANAGER

Roberto Espinoza, 37, returns to Peoria for his second season guiding the Chiefs and his 13th season coaching with the Cardinals organization. He is the lone returner from the team's 2025 coaching staff. Espinoza's career in baseball began as a catcher, as the Cardinals signed the Palo Aragua, Venezuela as an international free agent in 2006. Espinoza played five Minor League seasons, including parts of three seasons with the Quad Cities River Bandits. Espinoza began his coaching career in 2013 as the hitting coach for the Appalachian League's Johnson City Cardinals. The former backstop is no stranger to the big leagues, having served as a bullpen catcher for St. Louis in 2014 and as a coach during the stretch run of the 2020 season. Espinoza managed Johnson City from 2017 through 2019, winning the Appy League Championship in his final season. He spent the next four seasons (2021-24) managing the FCL Cardinals. He collected his 200th managerial victory on May 18, 2025 with Peoria's 7-1 win over Cedar Rapids.

MIKE HABAS

HITTING COACH

Mike Habas (HAH-biss), an experienced MiLB hitting coach, will spend his first season in the Cardinals organization with the Peoria Chiefs. Habas joins the Cardinals after spending the last two seasons with the Fredericksburg Nationals, helping guide the FredNats to the 2024 Carolina League title. The Chicago native began coaching in the professional ranks with the Gary SouthShore RailCats (2017-18) before spending four seasons with the Brewers (2019-2023). Habas played college baseball at South Suburban College, Moraine Valley College and North Greenville University.
