Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the fourth in a six-game series at the Lake County Captains, High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, the fourth of 18 meetings between the two clubs this year. Last year, the Nuts finished 9-15 vs. the Captains, going 2-9 in Eastlake and 7-8 at home. Lansing has won two of the first three games in the current series.

On the Air: Logan Potosky and Tyler Danburg deliver the call via Bally Live and MiLB TV, while Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa are on StreamGuys.

Yesterday: Captains 6, Lugnuts 5. Brayan Buelvas homered for a third straight game, but Nate Furman answered with a go-ahead grand slam, and Zane Morehouse struck out Buelvas and Henry Bolte with the bases loaded in the ninth inning to end the Captains' five-game losing streak.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a 6:35 p.m. start followed by a 1:00 series finale on Sunday. Then the Lugnuts return to Michigan's state capital for a 12-game, 13-day homestand against the Dayton Dragons and South Bend Cubs.

LUG•NOTES

Just Down the Road: While the High-AA's and Guardians' affiliates are facing off in Eastlake, the MLB A's and Guardians open a three-game series tonight at Progressive Field.

Transaction: Entering this series, the Lugnuts received infielder Elvis Rijo from Extended Spring Training. The Nuts had added fellow infielder Jose Escorche over the weekend, replacing T.J. Schofield-Sam. When he sees action, Rijo will become the 938th all-time Lugnut. He is one of 11 international free agents on the active roster.

Streaking: Will Simpson went 1-for-4 last night, extending his on-base streak to 11 games to open the season.

Powering On: The Lugs had hit only two home runs in their first nine games before knocking six homers in the first three games of this series – including a home run by Brayan Buelvas in each of the three games.

League Leaderboard: Brayan Buelvas is tied for 2nd in the Midwest League in home runs (3), tied for 3rd in runs scored (11) and tied for 6th in walks (9); Will Simpson is 1st in walks (12), tied for 4th in on-base percentage (.500), tied for 4th in RBIs (10) and 9th in OPS (1.015); James González is 2nd in ERA (0.79), 2n in WHIP (0.71), 6th in opponent batting average (.175) and tied for 8th in innings (11 1/3); Mitch Myers is 5th in opponent average (.171), 6th in WHIP (0.83) and 9th in ERA (1.86); Jose Dicochea is tied for 6th in strikeouts (15).

A Grand Start: On April 3, first baseman Will Simpson crushed a grand slam (as well as a solo shot) in an 18-0 victory over Michigan State in the Crosstown Showdown. Ten days later, Simpson launched a grand slam off the Great Lakes Loons in an 8-5 loss.

EMU to The Show: 2021 Lansing super utilityman Max Schuemann made his Major League debut a week ago last Friday as a pinch-runner for the A's, scoring the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th on an RBI single from Lawrence Butler (2021-22 Lugnut), as the A's walked off the Nationals, 2-1. Schuemann is the 185th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the first this year.

Prospecting: The Nuts' Opening Day roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 12) and first baseman Will Simpson (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2010: Catcher A.J. Jimenez went 4-for-5 with three doubles, two runs scored and two RBIs, and the Lugnuts battered Bowling Green with 18 hits in a 9-3 victory at Cooley Law School Stadium, finishing a three-game sweep. This was the Hot Rods' first ever visit to Lansing, in their first season in the Midwest League since moving up from the South Atlantic League with Lake County before the year.

2015: In an unusual shutout – and a brilliant relief appearance – Justin Shafer relieved Sean Reid-Foley (2 2/3 innings) and blanked the Dayton Dragons for the final 6 1/3 innings in a 4-0 win at Cooley Law School Stadium. Shafer struck out Gavin LaValley to escape a bases-loaded jam in the third inning and was never seriously threatened afterward, allowing four singles and whiffing five.

In a Nutshell: Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts... he has spent all but one MiLB inning (of 93 total professional innings) with the Lugnuts.

Entering Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect.

Inked: Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Michigan Wolverine Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Mercer slugger Colby Thomas in the third round).

WVU to the Pros: First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps featured two WVU teammates in 2021 draftees Jackson Wolf (4th round) and Ryan Bergert (6th round); pitched against Bergert on May 26, 2023, and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last WVU player taken in the first round was Alek Manoah by Toronto in 2019, who in 2022 joined John Means as the only Mountaineers to be named MLB All-Stars... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

Glory Days: Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

Off to College: Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named pre-season All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

Hometown Hero: Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were part of the Jays' system... cousin is Jason Michaels, who played 11 years (2001-2011) in MLB.

Prospecting: Until midseason 2023, MLB Pipeline had ranked Watters the No. 26 prospect in the A's organization and the A's No. 12 pitching prospect... his grades: Fastball 60, Curve 60, Changeup 45, Control 45, Overall 40... his scouting report: "Watters is a strong presence on the mound at 6-foot-4. His fastball was up to 99 mph during his junior year and touched triple digits in his time as a reliever. He also possesses a plus pitch in his power curve, missing plenty of bats as a true 12-to-6 that sits in the mid-80s. There's also a mid-80s changeup in there, though it's less polished compared to his other two offerings. Command will need to improve for Watters to have a chance to start at the next level. While the stuff was high-octane in college, he usually had little idea of how to locate it. Given his track record as a reliever, there's a strong chance he ends up back in the bullpen, where he can rear back and overpower hitters with two plus pitches."

In a Nutshell: Last name in English means “glove” (as in baseball glove)... after allowing two home runs to Dayton in 2024 debut, relieving Jacob Watters, impressed in 4-IP start vs. Great Lakes, allowing only one hit – a Luis Rodriguez windblown home run... did not pitch on a Friday at all in 2023 (1 GS on Monday, 6 G/4 GS on Tuesday, 3 G/2 GS on Wednesday, 1 G on Thursday, 3 G/2 GS on Saturday, 11 G/9 GS on Sunday)... was far better in 2023 as a starter (4.14 ERA, .239 avg. in 91 1/3 IP) than as a reliever (10.80 ERA, .300 avg., 18 1/3 IP).

Home Cooking: Also from Santo Domingo (“La Capital”): Juan Soto, Manny Ramirez, Albert Pujols, Placido Polanco, Carlos Pena, David Ortiz, Starling Marte, Alfredo Griffin, Cesar Cedeño, Adrian Beltre, Jose Bautista.

Minor League Path: Signed at age 18 in 2019 and immediately began his professional career that season with the Dominican Summer League A’s... following the pandemic, opened in the 2021 Arizona Complex League before receiving three appearances with Stockton... received emergency start in Midland in 2022, allowing six runs in 1 1/3 innings... spent all of 2023 with the Ports, leading Stockton in starts (18), innings (109 2/3), hits allowed (107), runs allowed (73) and walks (53)... limited RHH to .208 avg./ .663 OPS compared to .295/ .843 for LHH.... CS/ATT: 6/11.

Twice Honored: Named the California League Pitcher of the Week on May 29-June 4 after tossing 7-inning, 1-hit gem vs. Modesto... named Pitcher of the Week again June 12-18 after tossing 7-inning, 2-hit gem at Lake Elsinore... from June 4-18, fired three consecutive seven-inning quality starts, allowing one total run on eight hits, seven walks, with 17 strikeouts.
