Against the I-Cubs: Ortiz has made two career starts against Louisville, including his Triple-A debut on Sept. 2, 2022. He fanned seven batters and allowed just one run on three hits in 4.2 innings on April 6 at Louisville.

Last Outing: Ortiz's last outing came on July 23 at lowa, where he allowed five runs on seven hits in 4.0 innings.
