### INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Reigning International League Pitcher of the Week Thomas Harrington shined again with five-plus perfect innings as the Indianapolis Indians tacked on six runs to defeat the Columbus Clippers on Friday evening at Huntington Park, 6-2. The Indians notched three runs in the first inning after five of the first six batters in the game reached base safely. With one out, Henry Davis roped an RBI double to plate the rehabbing Nick Gonzales. After a walk to Billy Cook, Jack Suwinski drove a line drive that deflected off shortstop Gabriel Arias' glove before he airmailed a throw past the catcher, allowing Nick Yorke and Davis to score. Indianapolis posted two additional runs on a run-scoring fielder's choice by Liover Peguero and RBI double by Yorke in the third and fourth innings against Triston McKenzie. After logging their first hit with one out in the sixth, a single by Bryan Lavastida, the Clippers plated only two runs between the sixth and seventh inning courtesy of an Angel Martinez run-scoring groundout and a solo blast from Chase DeLauter. Indianapolis tallied a run in the sixth on an RBI groundout from Davis.

**PERFECT:** Thomas Harrington, who was named the International League Pitcher of the Week on Monday, stunned for his second Triple-A win last night with 6.0 one-run innings and six strikeouts. After tossing 5.0 perfect frames en route to 7.0 shutout with just two baserunners allowed in his last start on Aug. 17 vs. St. Paul, Harrington again took a perfect game into the sixth inning. He exited with just two baserunners allowed on a pair of base hits in his final frame. Harrington is currently rated as the Pirates No. 5 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and is 2-1 with a 3.09 ERA (8er/23.1ip), 17 strikeouts, a 0.73 WHIP and .171 batting average against (14-for-82) in four starts with Indianapolis since making his Triple-A debut on Aug. 4.

**NICK KNACKS:** Nick Yorke logged his second consecutive multi-hit game last night, going 2-for-3 with a run, double, RBI and pair of walks. It was also his third in four games with multiple hits and at least one RBI. Yorke has reached base safely in 25 of his last 27 games since July 19 and has hit safely in 21 of his last 25. Since beginning a 15-game hitting streak on July 25, he is hitting .356 (32-for-90) with 11 doubles and 17 RBI. In that time, he leads the International League in doubles while ranking among leaders in hits (2nd) and batting average (8th). He is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect by MLB Pipeline after being traded to Pittsburgh from Boston on July 29 in exchange for RHP Quinn Priester and is hitting .368 (28-for-76) with nine doubles, 15 RBI, a .487 slugging percentage and .911 OPS with Indy.

**HANK ON BASE:** Henry Davis went 2-for-5 with two runs, a double and two RBI last night to extend his on-base streak to 11 games since Aug. 9 at Nashville. He has now reached base safely in 26 of 28 games since July 13 with a .325 batting average (37-for-114), 22 runs, 12 extra-base hits, 22 RBI and a .924 OPS. Davis recorded six multi-hit games in a nine-game span from July 20-31 to begin that stretch and had four consecutive multi-hit games again last week vs. St. Paul. Last night was his 19th multi-hit performance in Triple-A this season. In 55 total games with Indianapolis, he is hitting .310 (66-for-213) with 44 runs, 15 doubles, 13 home runs, 41 RBI and a .968 OPS.

**LEADING OFF:** After launching the Indians fifth leadoff home run of the season on Thursday, Nick Gonzales went 2-for-3 with two runs and two walks in the leadoff spot again last night. Gonzales is playing in the third game of his rehab assignment after being placed on the 10-day injured list on July 28 with left groin discomfort. He has gone 4-for-11 while hitting safely in each of his three games with Indy. He began the season on Indy's Opening Day roster and hit .358 (43-for-120) with a .431 on-base percentage and 1.039 OPS in 30 games before being recalled by Pittsburgh on May 10. Through his last game played with Indy on May 8, he ranked among IL leaders in batting average (1st), doubles (1st, 14), runs (1st, 33), hits (T-1st), extra-base hits (T-3rd, 20), OPS (4th), total bases (T-4th, 73), slugging percentage (5th, .608) and OBP (7th).

**MATTSON'S MAGIC:** Isaac Mattson closed out the game for the Indians last night, tossing 1.0 perfect inning with a pair of strikeouts. He has been nothing but efficient during the month of August, logging a 0.79 ERA (1er/11.1ip), 11 strikeouts, 0.97 WHIP and .195 batting average against (8-for-41). The month has continued a dominant streak for the right-hander, who is 3-0 with a 1.50 ERA (4er/24.0ip), 27 strikeouts, 1.04 WHIP and .205 batting average against (18-for-88) in his last 11 outings since July 6. He is also working a four-game win streak dating back to June 16.

**SWIPERS SWIPING:** The Indians have been heading up on the basepaths since the beginning of July, swiping 20-plus runs in each of the last two months after never surpassing that mark in the opening months of the season. With a stolen base last night, the Indians now have 23 stolen bases in 20 August games after swiping 28 in 21 July contests.

**TONIGHT:** The Indianapolis Indians and Columbus Clippers, Triple-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, continue their six-game series tonight at Huntington Park. The Indians are looking to take a series lead after winning their last two games to knot the series. Columbus split its last series with Iowa, 3-3, but raked against Indianapolis at Victory Field with an 8-3 record in 11 games at Victory Field. Continuing the set for the Indians tonight is RHP Aaron Shortridge, who has never faced Columbus over seven career Triple-A outings (six starts). Countering for the Clippers is LHP Ryan Webb (1-0, 0.82), who made his Triple-A debut on Aug. 8 and is coming off an outing of 5.2 one-hit innings last week at Iowa.

**THIS DATE IN 1986:** The Indians outlasted Nashville in a 15-inning, 4-hour and 18-minute marathon at Bush Stadium, 7-6. The Sounds led 5-2 midway through the eighth inning, but the Indians plated three runs in the bottom half to eventually force extras. Both teams were held scoreless until the 15th when the visitors plated one, only to see Indy respond with two in the home half and score the game-winning run on an extra-base hit by Rene Gonzalez. George Wright went yard with a team-high three hits, and Razor Shines went deep as well.
