- Dunedin avenged its 12-inning loss on Thursday with an 11-inning victory on Friday, 10-8 at Palm Beach.
- Yhoangel Aponte's two-out, two-strike, two-RBI double in the top of the 11th stood as the difference. The knock was Aponte's first hit of the series.
- The Blue Jays squandered a 6-0 7th inning lead, as Palm Beach rallied for seven runs between the seventh and eighth innings. The Cardinals scored five runs on just one hit in the bottom of the eighth to take an 7-6 lead.
- Fernando Perez pitched six shutout innings before allowing two runs in the seventh inning with two outs.
- Bo Bonds delivered his second save of the week by leaving the bases loaded in the bottom of the 11th inning.
- Manuel Beltre went 5-6 in the contest, marking the first five-hit game of the season by a Blue Jay (more below).
- Dunedin's 16 hits are a season-high.

#### **EXTRA SATISFYING**

Dunedin's 11 inning win last night improves the team's extra innings mark to 3-4. The victory is the Blue Jays' first extra-innings win away from TD Ballpark this season.

#### **BATTLING BLUE JAYS**

Last night's victory marked just the third time this season (3-22) the team has overcome an eighth inning deficit to seal a comeback win. It was the first Dunedin win this season in which the team allowed eight or more runs.

#### **FANTASTIC FIVE HITS**

Manuel Beltre's 5-6 outing at the plate last night is the first five-hit game by a Dunedin Blue Jay this season, and just the fifth in the Florida State League this year. It's Dunedin's first five hit game since Jeffrey Wehler's on July 1, 2023. With his five hits last night, Beltre is an outstanding 10-19 this week vs Palm Beach.

#### **BELTRE GETS ON BASE**

With his five-hit performance last night, Manuel Beltre extended his on-base streak to 21 games - the longest by a D-Jay this season, beating Jean Joseph's 19-game streak. The stretch is tied for the longest active streak in the Florida State League. Across the streak, Beltre is hitting .330 with a .887 OPS.

#### HITS ON HITS ON HITS

The Blue Jays' 16 hits last night set a new season-high. Six of those hits went for extra-bases - including five doubles from five different players - to tie another season-high.

#### **TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT**

All four of this week's games have been decided by two or fewer runs. Dunedin has played 20 one-run games this season, going 9-11 in those contests. 39 of the Blue Jays 55 games this season (71%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 19-20 record in those games.

#### PALMEGIANI PARTY

Damiano Palmegiani, the Blue Jays No. 14 prospect, joined the Blue Jays on a rehab assignment from AAA-Buffalo last week. The slugger's two long balls this week are Dunedin's only homers of the series. Palmegiani played 56 games with Dunedin in 2022, hitting .256 with 11 homers before his promotion to A+ Vancouver. Palmegiani belted 23 homers in 2023 between AA-New Hampshire and AAA-Buffalo.

#### **JAYS JUICE**

The Blue Jays are tied for second in the Florida State League with 41 home runs, trailing Daytona by two for the league lead. However, Dunedin has been held to just two homers this week in four contests - both from Damiano Palmegiani.

#### **REHAB CITY. USA**

With Kekai Rios starting a rehab assignment with the Blue Jays last night, Dunedin has hosted 10 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. MLB rehabbers Alek Manoah and Erik Swanson both pitched on April 7 against Lakeland.

#### A CAVEMAN COULD DO IT

Nolan Perry is set to make his sixth start with the Blue Jays this evening. The righthander hasn't surrendered an earned run since his first start, on 5/4 vs Tampa. Perry was drafted out of Carlsbad HS (NM) in 2022 after winning New Mexico's Gatorade Player of the Year award and a state championship. Carlsbad's team mascot is the Cavemen.
