CARTER HOMERS TWICE TO LEAD ROUGHRIDERS TO VICTORY:

The Frisco RoughRiders used two big innings and two **Evan Carter** home runs to drop the San Antonio Missions 7-1 on Wednesday night from Nelson W. Wolff Municipal Stadium. The Riders (2-3) jumped out in front in the second inning when **Scott Kapers** ripped an RBI single, scoring Trevor Hauver, to make it 1-0. The next batter, Carter, then lashed a three-run home run to left to balloon the lead to 4-0. Efrain Contreras (0-2) took the loss for the Missions (2-3) in his start, allowing two runs over his 1.2 innings with five walks. In the fourth, the Riders added three more runs. Chris Seise plated two with an infield two-run single for his first career Double-A hit before Carter slammed his second home run of the game, a two-run homer, to push the lead to 7-0. The Missions scored their lone run of the night in the bottom of the fourth inning off of Frisco starter Jack Leiter on an RBI single from Evan Mendoza. Leiter went 4.1 innings, allowing one run on four hits while striking out seven and walking four. In the bullpen, **Grant Wolfram** (1-0) earned the win for Frisco with 0.2 innings and **Antoine Kelly** (1.2 innings), **Alex Speas** (1.1) and **Justin Slaten** (1.0) combined for scoreless work to finish the game.

WHERE HAS ALL THE OFFENSE GONE?:

While it is very early in the Texas League, offense is down league wide through the first five games of the season. So far this season, the league is hitting .231 with an average of 0.7 home runs per game and 4.7 runs per game per team. In 2022, the Texas League hit .260, averaging 1.2 home runs and 5.5 runs per game per team. As the weather warms, the offense is sure to increase. Through this point in 2022, the numbers were high (.267 average, 0.9 home runs, 8.1 runs per game).

After another series victory in San Antonio their last time out against the Missions, the Riders dominated the Padres affiliate over their last two seasons. Last season, they went 15-9 against San Antonio and 10-2 at Nelson Wolff Stadium, but dating back to 2021, Frisco is 29-15 against the Padres affiliate. The Riders also swept the Missions in the 2022 South Division Champioship Series, winning one game at home and one in San Antonio. Dating back to mid-June of 2018, the Riders are 41-23 against San Antonio in their last 64 regular season games.

I LIKE BIG WINS AND I CANNOT LIE:

The RoughRiders two wins this season have come by eight runs and six runs, respectively, while their three losses have come by a combined eight runs. That gives Frisco a +6 run differential through five games, which is the best in the Texas League Southern Division despite being one game back of both Amarillo (3-2 record, -2 run differential) and Midland (3-2, +5). The combined 14 run margin of victory is the largest through the team's first two wins of a season in franchise history.

EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Through five games, Evan Carter has reached in every game this season, batting .333 (6-for-18)/.478/.667/1.145 with two home runs, five walks, eight RBIs and two stolen bases. On Wednesday, Carter crushed a three-run home run and a solo homer for his second two-home run game of his Minor League career. The No. 3 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Between Frisco and Hickory, Carter hit .295/.397/.489/.886 with 21 doubles, 10 triples, 12 home runs, 73 RBIs, 86 runs and 28 stolen bases in 106 games. He finished tied for fourth in all of Minor League Baseball in triples and was one of 11 players in the minors with double digit doubles, triples and home runs over the course of the season.

MEET THE NEW SKIPPER:

A new year welcomes a new face at the helm of the RoughRiders. **Carlos Cardoza** gets the bump up from High-A Hickory in 2023 and he brings a history of winning with him. The Puerto Rico native piloted the Crawdads to a 66-65 record last season and has amassed a 312-207 (.601) total over his six seasons as a skipper. With Down East, he took the Wood Ducks to the Low-A East Championship Series before falling to Charleston. Prior to his time in Down East, he managed the Arizona League Rangers (2019), winning the AZL Championship, and Dominican Summer League Rangers (2016-2019), twice reaching the championship series. Hired on by the Rangers in 2015, Cardoza was the head coach at his alma mater, Decatur High School, in Georgia for two years. As a player, Cárdoza spent two seasons at Georgia State University and two years at Armstrong Atlantic State, where he was a gold glove second baseman and All-Peach Belt Conference selection.

LOOK AT ALL THAT TALENT:

This year's squad features nine of the top 30 prospects in the Rangers organization. Texas' No. 2 overall prospect **Evan Carter** highlights the bunch that includes four of the top five prospects in Carter, No. 3 RHP **Owen White**, No. 4 INF **Luisangel Acuña** and No. 5 RHP **Jack Leiter**. Outside of the top five, OF **Dustin Harris** slots in at No. 8 in his return to Frisco from last season after missing the last month with a wrist injury. The last four prospects are No. 12 RHP **Tekoah Roby**, No. 16 INF **Thomas Saggese**, No. 20 RHP **Marc** Church and No. 24 LHP Antoine Kelly. Out of the nine, eight are returning players with Roby being the only newcomer to the Frisco roster.

2023 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.

-Opened the 2023 season with three shutout innings against Amarillo on April 7th. He was working his way back up from a neck injury that kept him out for a couple weeks during Spring Training.

2022 SEASON

- -Entered the season as the No. 8 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com.
- -Over his last three starts in Hickory, before being promoted to Frisco, White went 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4ER/19.0IP) while striking out 30 and just walking three over 19.0 innings.
- -Recorded five quality starts over his 10 total starts, including a 7.0 innings, 1 ER, 11 K start on June 11th
- -With Hickory, owned a 45.8 percent groundball rate, 10th in the South Atlantic League. Also had a 16.4 percent swinging strike rate (3rd in SAL) and a 33.3 percent strikeout rate (4th).
- -Was dominant in Double-A debut on June 25th, allowing one runs until an inherited run came across over his 5.1 innings in Arkansas.
- -Threw 5.1 hitless innings with seven strikeouts on July 1st against CC, winning Texas League Pitcher of the Week. Left game with left ankle injury, but was able to make next scheduled start. Riders lost no-hitter in 7th inning when **Seth Nordlin** allowed single, but Frisco won 5-0.

2021 SEASON

-Was Low-A Down East's Opening Day starer before punching the ground after an error and breaking his hand on May 4th. He returned to the Wood Ducks on August 10th.

-From The Athletic: "As soon as I did that, CY (general manager Chris Young) called me and basically said the Rangers have my back and they knew that it wasn't out of like hatred or trying to hurt myself," White explained on Monday. "It was more going out and competing and my emotions got the best of me at that moment in time. It's not like I came in the dugout and punched something at a locker, it was just — emotions got the best of me, I did what I did, and now I had to pay the consequence. But ..." White paused and nodded before giving a wry smile. "I promised them that I would never do it again."

-After making just nine outings on the season, he won Arizona Fall League "Pitcher of the Year", going 5-0 with a 1.91 ERA and 29 strikeouts over a league-best 28.1 innings.
