NORTHWEST ARKANSAS POWERS THEIR WAY TO WIN IN OPENER OVER FRISCO:

The Frisco RoughRiders came from behind twice to topple the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 12-9 on Wednesday night from Arvest Ballpark. After coming back from down five runs to take the lead earlier in the game, Frisco (3-2) trailed 9-8 in the ninth before **Alejandro Osuna** hammered a go-ahead, three-run home run off of Northwest Arkansas (4-1) reliever Ryan Hendrix (0-1) to put the Riders up 11-9. **Josh Hatcher** then added to his monster game with an RBI single to push the lead to 12-9. Hatcher finished 4-for-6 with a home run, a double, two RBIs and a run scored. **Robby Ahlstrom** then entered and struck out the side for his first save of the year. **Peyton Gray** (1-0) earned his first Riders win with two perfect innings out of the bullpen, including three strikeouts. To begin the game, the Naturals pounced on Riders starter **Josh Stephan** in the first inning for five runs, including three doubles in the frame. Frisco came back with three runs of their own in the top of the third on two infield RBI singles from **Abimelec Ortiz** and **Luis Mieses** and a **Keyber Rodriguez** sacrifice fly, cutting the deficit to 5-3. Jordan Groshans then hit a solo homer in the bottom of the inning to increase the lead to 6-3. In the top of the fifth, Hatcher hit a solo shot and Mieses bashed a three-run, go-ahead homer to put the Riders in front 7-6, but Northwest Arkansas scored three runs in the bottom of the inning to retake the lead 9-7. **Ian Moller** brought the Riders a run closer in the seventh with his first home run of the year, a solo long ball, setting up Osuna's heroics. Alongside Mieses and Hatcher, **Frainyer Chavez** also had a multi-hit affair, going 2-for-3 with two walks and two runs scored.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

The Frisco bullpen has been a bright spot for the Riders in the beginning of the season. While the pitching staff has had a 4.70 ERA overall (4th-best in the Texas League), the bullpen pitchers have been even better. If you remove **Ben Anderson's** long relief as a normal starting pitcher, Frisco's bullpen pitchers have combined to allow just four earned runs over 21.0 innings (1.71 ERA). On Wednesday, the Riders struck out the last six batters of the game, combined between **Peyton Gray** and **Robby Ahlstrom**.

VERSUS THE NATURALS:

A season ago, the RoughRiders went 7-5 against Northwest Arkansas. **Maximo Acosta** dominated on the offensive side (.421/.532/.658/1.190 over 10G), but **Abimelec Ortiz** and **Josh Hatcher** were the two best returners against the Naturals. Ortiz hit three home runs in 11 games while slashing .341/.449/.610/1.059 while Hatcher collected 17 hits in 10 games, including a five-hit game, to hit .405 with a 1.039 OPS against the Royals affiliate. With his home run in each of the first two games of the series, Hatcher is now hitting .391 (25-for-64)/.443/.609/1.052 in his career against the Naturals across 15 games with three home runs and 13 RBIs.

HATCHIN' HITTIN':

Josh Hatcher was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season. He was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better. To start 2025, he is hitting .556 (10-for-18)/.556/.944/1.500 with a double, two home runs, five RBIs, a stolen base and five runs scored over his first four games. Since 2005, he is tied for the franchise record for the most hits through the first five team games with **Liam Hicks** in 2024 (10), but has done it in four games.

ABIME-LECTRIC ORTIZ:

Abimelec Ortiz ended the year on fire for the RoughRiders. In his last 48 games, Ortiz hit .321/.413/.592/1.005 with nine doubles, 13 home runs, 38 RBIs, 37 runs scored and 28 walks. After July 10th, in those 48 games, he is fourth in average (.321), first in OPS (1.005), tied for first in RBIs (38) and first in home runs (13). During that span, he paced all of Double-A in OPS as well. In his last 29 games, he batted .364 (40-for-110)/.470/.710/1.170 with five doubles, 10 home runs, 30 RBIs, 21 walks, 24 strikeouts and 27 runs scored. Entering into June 23rd's game, he was hitting .179 with a .550 OPS. After, he hit .307 with a .954 OPS, raising his batting average to .243 and a .760 OPS. Ortiz has two multi-hit games with the RoughRiders to start the season.

WE'RE GOING PROSPECTING:

The RoughRiders have nine players in MLB Pipeline's Rangers Top 30 Prospects rankings to start 2025. **Sebastian Walcott** (No. 1) headlines the bunch and is the only member of the top 100 as well (No. 17). On the mound, **Winston Santos** (No. 5), **Kohl Drake** (No. 13), **Mitch Bratt** (No. 21) and **Josh Stephan** (No. 22) all slot into the starting rotation while **Skyler Hales** (No. 25) will work from the bullpen. On offense, outfielder **Alejandro Osuna** (No. 8) and first baseman/outfielder **Abimelec Ortiz** (No. 14) round out the nine players.

FAMILIAR FACES IN FRISCO:

The RoughRiders welcome a remarkable 23 returning players in 2025 and had just two players on the roster (infielder **Cam Cauley** and catcher **Ian Moller**) that made their Double-A debuts this year.

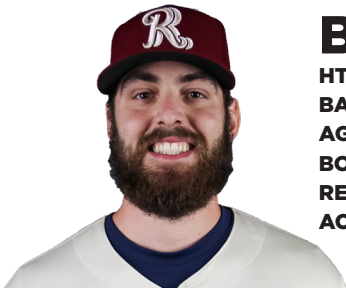

ABOUT BEN

-Played high school baseball at Shenendehowa (N.Y.) High School and was drafted by Toronto in the 26th round of the 2016 June draft following his senior yr, but did not sign. He was a catcher and a pitcher in high school. He was a 1st Team All-State Catcher, but was drafted as a pitcher.

-Went to the University of Binghamton for three seasons (same field he won a NYS Class AA Championship at in HS). At BU, he went 13-7 with a 2.62 ERA over three years. In final year, went 9-4 with a 2.76 ERA over 15 starts while striking out 108 in 88.0 innings to 27 walks.

-Twin brother, Ian, was selected by Atlanta in the 1st round (3rd overall) of the 2016 June draft and played a key role on the Braves' 2021 World Series championship team. Ben attended the Braves' 2020 postseason games played at Globe Life Field.

-Father, Bob, played baseball at Siena.

2025 SEASON

-In his first outing of the 2025 season, worked out of the bullpen in long relief, allowing four runs over 3.2 innings to Corpus Christi.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation, though he made his Double-A debut in relief on Opening Day (4/5) with a scoreless inning, striking out three side.

-Made best start of the season against Amarillo on April 24th, throwing six innings, allowing just two earned (two-run home run in the first inning by Tim Tawa).

-Struck out career-best eight at Amarillo in game two of the doubleheader on May 16th.

2023 SEASON

-Opened the season on the Injured List while recovering from "Tommy John" surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Returned to Hickory (A+) and went 5-3, 3.51 ERA (16 ER/41.0 IP) over 9 starts before experiencing discomfort in his right elbow during outing on 6/9 at Bowling Green. He underwent season-ending "Tommy John" ligament replacement surgery on 6/15/22
