YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Yard Goats, 4-3. Brady Whalen opened a 1-0 lead with an RBI single in the third and Jimmy Glowenke extended the lead to 3-0 with a two-run homer in the fourth inning. The Yard Goats broke the shutout in the sixth with a solo homer by Adael Amador and closed the score to 3-2 with a solo home run by Braxton Fulford. In the ninth, Amador tied the score with a sac fly and Jordan Beck won the game with a two-out, walk-off single. Hayden Birdsong started and threw four hitless innings, striking out four.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. This series marks Richmond's first trip to Hartford since June 22-27, 2021. This series is the only set this year between the two teams.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 34-25 in their last 59 games since June 18, the second-best record in the Eastern League in that span, but have gone 2-5 on this road trip to Portland at Hartford. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.98 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 439.2 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 601.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.80 ERA, which is the third-lowest in Double-A and the 13th-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE YARD GOATS have gone 2-7 in their last nine games since August 19. Their .229 team batting average is 11th in the Eastern League and their 5.40 team ERA is 12th. Hartford's roster includes nine of Baseball America's top-30 Rockies prospects, including SS Adael Amador (No. 1 - No. 21 overall), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 3 - No. 51 overall), 3B Sterlin Thompson (No. 6), OF Jordan Beck (No. 7), C Drew Romo (No. 9), 3B Warming Bernabel (No. 11), SS Julio Carreras (No. 17), LHP Carson Palmquist (No. 13) and OF Bladimir Restituyo (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects list includes seven Hartford players, including Amador (No. 1 - No. 21 overall), Fernandez (No. 2 - No. 53 overall), Thompson (No. 6), Romo (No. 9), Bernabel (No. 10), LHP Joe Rock (No. 16) and Palmquist (No. 21).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Ryan Murphy makes his 24th start of the season. He last pitched on Thursday at Portland and threw a season-high five innings and allowed two runs. Over his last 15 starts since June 4, Murphy has gone 0-6 with a 3.60 ERA (24 ER/55.0 IP) and 59 strikeouts. Lowering his season ERA from 6.15 to 4.57. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect. For more on Murphy, see page two.

FOR HARTFORD: Left-hander Mike Ruff makes his 11th start and his 24th appearance of the season. He last took the mound in a start last Wednesday at Somerset and pitched three scoreless innings. Ruff was selected by the Rockies in the 11th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Florida Atlantic. He spent most of the 2022 season with High-A Spokane, going 6-6 with a 4.25 ERA in 16 starts. He was promoted to Double-A last August and went 1-3 with a 6.75 ERA in seven starts. This year, he began the season in the Yard Goats' starting rotation, going 0-3 with an 8.31 ERA in seven starts through May 21. On the season, he was a 7.96 ERA as a starter and a 4.85 ERA as a reliever.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 17 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are tied for second place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, one game behind the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half, and even with the Bowie Baysox. Harrisburg and Akron five games back in fifth. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

THOMAS TRENDING UP: In last week's series, **Andy Thomas** reached base 10 times in 19 plate appearances. Last Tuesday, he hit a two-run homer and worked a walk in his three plate appearances. On Wednesday, Thomas walked three times and had two hits, including a three-run double in the first inning. On this road trip, Thomas is batting .333 (6-for-18) with a homer, two doubles, six RBIs and five walks. On the year, Thomas is tied for the team lead with 11 home runs and leads Richmond with 58 RBIs.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 59 times in his last 31 games since July 25 (33 hits, 25 walks, 1 HBP), hitting .311 (33-for-106) with six homers, six doubles, two triples and 24 RBIs adding a .438 on-base percentage. In the last home series against the Senators, Matheny hit .412 (7-for-17) with three homers, one double, nine RBIs and three walks. He is hitting .214 (6-for-28) in his seven games on this road trip. In the second game of Sunday's doubleheader, he hit a three-run homer. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 133 walks, ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

BERICOTO BASHING: Victor Bericoto has homered three times in his last five games dating back to Thursday. In his last 11 games since August 16, Bericoto is batting .324 (12-for-37) with three homers, four doubles and eight RBIs. On August 17 against Harrisburg, he hit walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning to cap a four-run comeback, which was tied for the largest ninth-inning comeback win in franchise history. On Thursday at Portland, he homered and drove in two runs on the night. He added another homer on Saturday. He added a game-tying homer in the last inning of Game 2 of Sunday's doubleheader at Portland. On the year, Bericoto leads the Giants system with 22 homers (16 with Eugene and six with Richmond) and also leads the organization with 71 PBIs.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Logan Wyatt has homered twice in his last four games since Saturday. He hit a two-run homer in the ninth inning on Saturday night at Portland. On Sunday afternoon in the second game of a doubleheader, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the seventh to lift Richmond to a 10-8 win over the Sea Dogs. Dating back to August 20, Wyatt is batting .360 (9-for-25) with three homers, three doubles and nine RBIs. His 15 homers between Eugene and Richmond this season are tied for the fifth-most in the Giants organization.

GLOW SHOW: Jimmy Glowenke is has picked up 11 hits and seven RBIs in his last six games dating back to last Wednesday, batting .579 (11-for-19) with three homers, a double and three walks. On Wednesday, he hit a two-run homer and picked up two RBI singles, matching his season high with four RBIs for the game. On the season, Glowenke is batting .319 (30-for-94) in road games, including all six of his Double-A homers. Since July 1, Glowenke is batting .306 (37-for-121) with six homers and 25 RBIs in 37 games

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
