Record in 2024......8-0 LAST TIME OUT: The Bradenton Marauders nearly shutout the St. Lucie Mets, as they won 4-1 on Wednesday afternoon at Clover Park. Axiel Plaz clubbed

> NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: Since their promotions from the FCL Pirates last week, both INF Jhonny Severino and INF Yordany De Los Santos have held their own. Severino has reached base in all six games while collecting a hit in the last five. De Los Santos has also reached base in all six while recording four RBIs during this stretch.

> CUE LAZY MARY: On Thursday, the Bradenton Marauders continue their lone trip of the season to Clover Park. Last year, Bradenton won five out of the six games in St. Lucie and have won 11-straight overall meetings against the Mets after they won all six at LECOM Park against them in May. The seriefinale victory in that series marked the Marauders' 10th-straight win which set a franchise record. Bradenton also walked-off St. Lucie three times that

> LIKE THE US POSTAL SERVICE: With a tropical storm wreaking havoc across the rest of the Florida State League, the Marauders and Cardinals were the only teams in the FSL to play on Sunday. Entering Tuesday, Bradenton is the only team to not have a game canceled in 2024 and are on pace to play all 132 scheduled games. St. Lucie was the lone other until their games in Fort Myers on Saturday and Sunday were canceled.

> $\textbf{AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS:} \ The \ Marauders \ hold \ three \ of \ the \ top \ eight \ home \ run \ leaders \ in \ the \ Florida \ State \ League, \ with \ \textbf{Esmerlyn Valdez} \ leading \ the \ description \ descr$ way in second with 17 longballs. Axiel Plaz is currently in third with 15 and Shalin Polanco is tied for eighth with 10. Valdez is one just HR shy of tying league leader in Ariel Almonte (Daytona). The 17 HR hit by a Valdez are the second-most by a Marauder since the Florida State League was moved from High-A to Low-A. Rodolfo Nolasco hit 20 bombs last year for Bradenton to lead the way.

> BEST OF THE YEAR: OF Enmauel Terrero season-long eight-game hit streak came to an end on Saturday night against Palm Beach. During the streak, Terrero is slashing .321/.345/.536 with two home runs, four RBIs, one walk, and four runs scored.

> LOST AT SEA: The Marauders snapped their nine-game road losing streak on Tuesday night in Jupiter. It was Bradenton's first win away from LECOM Park since June 27th in Clearwater. Bradenton has lost three straight against Clearwater, Fort Myers, and Tampa. The .260 win percentage on the road is the worst in Minor League Baseball this season. Bradenton dropped their first nine road games to the start the year as well. The .260 win percentage is the urth-worst on record in the Minor League Baseball research portal with the 2014 Modesto Nuts (Single-Á, SEA) owning the worst after they posted a 14-56 (.200) record.

> MINI VACATION: The Bradenton Marauders continue their longest stretch of games away from LECOM Park this week with a six-game series against the St. Lucie Mets. Bradenton dropped five of the six games in Palm Beach before they headed north to battle the St. Lucie Mets.

BOMBS AWAY: Since May 1st, the Bradenton Marauders have clubbed 82 home runs in 82 games which is the most by any team in Single-A. Bradenton led Single-A with 31 longballs in the month of June and were just three shy of tying their franchise record. In July, Bradenton racked up 26 in 22 games with Axiel Plazand Esmerlyn Valdez accounting for 12 of the 26. The 26 home runs were the third-most in Single-A in July, trailing the Inland Empire 66ers who had 29.

PROSPECTS, PROSPECTS: With the graduation of 2023 Marauder Paul Skenes from the prospect ranks, RHP Khristian Curtis entered the Top 30 rankings at No. 30. The Bradenton Marauders now hold 10 of the Pittsburgh Pirates' Top 30 prospects according to MLB Pipeline after the addition of LHP Anthony Solometo last Thursday.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Sunday afternoons loss to the Cardinals marked the Marauders' 37th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 18-19 record in those games. Bradenton has lost their last four one-run games.

Last Time Out: In his first start off the injured list since mid-June, Kennedy struck out four while allowing just one run in three inning. He retired the first six batters of the game before allowing a leadoff double to Ryan Campos in the third. After retiring the next two batters, Brayden Jobert doubled in a run to tie the game.
