**SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES**

**ONE, TWO, THREE, FOUR:** OF Jackson Chourio tallied one of the best nights of his young career on Tuesday by going 4-6 with a single, two doubles, a home run and four RBI... Chourio became the first Shuckers player to tally four hits in a game this year and the sixth to tally three extra-base hits in a game... Chourio, who's the youngest player in Double-A, raised his OPS from .713 to .751 with the performance... Over his last two games, he's 7-11 with six RBI... He enters today in the top-five among Southern League batters in RBI (3rd, 40), hits (3rd, 60), total bases (4th, 99) and stolen bases (T5th, 17).

**BLASTING OFF:** After not hitting a home run over the final five games at Trustmark Park against the M-Braves last week, the Shuckers opened the series with three home runs on Tuesday, the most in a game by Biloxi since they smashed three on June 1 against Pensacola... The Shuckers have scored runs in bunches at Riverwalk Stadium, combining for 25 over their last two games at the ballpark... OF **Zavier Warren**, OF **Jackson Chourio** and C/INF **Wes Clarke** combined for the three home runs.

**THE RACE TO 52:** With two more stolen bases on Tuesday, INF **Tyler Black** became the third Shuckers player in franchise history (since 2015) to record at least 35 stolen bases in a season, becoming the first to do so since OF **Corey Ray** in 2018... In eight games during June, Black has 11 stolen bases, including multiple in four of his last five games, and one in six straight... His 35 stolen bases lead the Southern League and Double-A, and he's the only player in Double-A with at least 30.

**A ONE-MAN RECORD BREAKING MACHINE:** After a single in the second inning on Tuesday, INF Tyler Black has now reached base in 33 straight games for Biloxi, the longest in franchise history (since 2015) and the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball... Black has also reached base in 48 of 49 games with Biloxi in 2023... Over the 33-game streak, Black has a .417 on-base percentage and has drawn 31 walks, collected 28 hits and tallied 29 stolen bases.

**SOMETHING ABOUT THE BISCUITS:** With a solo home on Tuesday, C/INF **Wes Clarke** tallied his team-leading ninth extra-base hit against the Montgomery Biscuits in 2023... Against the Biscuits in 2023, Clarke is hitting .361 (13-26) with six doubles, three home runs, and a 1.197 OPS... At Riverwalk Stadium in Montgomery, Clarke is 10-20 (.500) with four doubles and two home runs.

**TODAY'S STARTER // LHP RUSSELL SMITH (0-1, 5.79):** LHP Russell Smith is set to make his first Double-A start, and his first start since April 23, 2023 with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers against the Quad Cities River Bandits... Smith, who was promoted to Biloxi on May 23, made 16 starts in Appleton over two years... In his last appearance, Smith tossed 2.2 scoreless innings against the M-Braves on just 32 pitches.
