### HIGHLIGHTS

**BABY DRIVER:** With his ninth inning RBI-single on Tuesday, 20-year-old Jasson Dominguez has now driven in a run in five consecutive games, which is one game shy of his Eastern Leaguehigh six straight games with an RBI from 7/7-18. During Dominguez's current five-game RBI streak, he is 8-for-20 (.400/.500/.500) with 7 RBI, 2 R, 4 BB, 3 SB and a 1.000 OPS. Dominguez has picked up at least one RBI in 13 of his last 19 games. Since the start of this stretch (7/7), Dominguez's 16 RBIs tied him with teammate Tyler Hardman and Akron foe Angel Martinez for the most in the Eastern League.

**CLEARED FOR TAKEOFF:** On Tuesday, Jasson Dominguez extended his on-base streak to 11 games, which ties his longest streak of the season. During this streak, Dominguez is 14-for-47 (.298/.377/.340) with 9 RBI, 7 R, 6 BB and 4 SB.

**ROSIE IS RED:** Jeisson Rosario has hit safely in his last four games, reaching base nine times over that span, going 6-for-11 with 4 RBI, 6 R, 3 2B and 3 BB. Over his last 23 games dating back to 6/24, Rosario is slashing .313/.421/.488 with 17 R and 13 RBI. Rosario has now reached base in six straight games and 14 of his last 15.

**TOUGH TO TOP:** Tuesday afternoon's 6-1 loss in Akron was Somerset's first loss of 4+ runs since 6/16 vs. ALT, lost 6-2 (24 games ago) and its first loss of 5+ runs since 5/27 @ERI, lost 17-8 (41 games ago). The loss snapped a streak of 12 straight wins for Somerset in games decided by 4+ runs. The Patriots are now 29-9 in games decided by 4+ runs and 29-28 in games decided by three runs or less. The Patriots are also now 24-31 when hitting one home run or less, compared to 34-6 when hitting 2+ home runs.

**2023:** Assigned to the High-A Hudson Valley break camp roster, making his professional debut for the Renegades on April 11 vs. Aberdeen. Went 2-1 with a 2.68 ERA in nine High-A starts before he was promoted to Double-A Somerset on 6/15. At the time of his promotion, Hampton's 77 strikeouts led the Yankees organization and ranked 5th in all of MiLB. Over his final four High-A starts, Hampton posted a 2.31 ERA and struck out 35 batters over a span of 23.1 IP.

**Career Notes:** Selected by the Yankees in the 6th round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Texas Tech as a draft eligible sophomore, signing for a \$497,500 bonus. Pitched to a 4.29 ERA over 15 total appearances including 11 starts his sophomore year, where he ranked third on the team with 72 K in 56.2 IP. Set a career high with 12 strikeouts in his final collegiate outing in the Statesboro Regional versus Notre Dame, matching the program record for most single game strikeouts in a NCAA tournament game. Posted a 3.84 ERA his freshman season in 18 total appearances with 34 K in 44.1 IP.

**Personal Notes:** One of three former Texas Tech Red Raiders on the Patriots, joining Clayton Beeter and TJ Rumfield. Attended Kilgore High School in Kilgore, TX. Finished high school career with 284 strikeouts and a 1.94 ERA in 162 innings pitched, earning First Team All-State and District MVP honors his senior year. Was also awarded 2020 Perfect Game Preseason All-American and First Team All-Region honors. Helped Kilgore reach 2019 State Championship game his junior year.

Dominguez begins his 1st season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 9th overall as a manager and 17th overall coaching in the Yankees organization. He spent the past two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and was assigned to the same post for 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dominguez becomes the 5th manager in Patriots franchise history and the 3rd since becoming the Yankees Double-A affiliate. He succeeds 2022 Eastern League Manager of the Year Dan Fiorito. Dominguez also previously served as the defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). The Panama City, Panama native has managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). From 2012-2015, his teams finished at least 10 games over .500, including reaching the DSL semifinals in 2012 and 2015. An outfielder during his playing days, Dominguez signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent in 2001 and spread four minor league seasons for New York between the DSL and the GCL. 2022: Rosario was claimed on waivers by the Yankees from the Red Sox in the final week of MLB Spring Training in 2022. Rosario was ranked by Baseball America as the "Best Defensive Outfielder" in the Red Sox system. 2017 - 2019: Rosario spent the first three seasons (2017-19) of his career with the Padres organization. In 2018 and 2019, he was ranked by Baseball America as the "Best Athlete" in Padres farm system.

Personal Notes: Initially signed by the Padres as an international free agent on 7/2/16 for \$1.85 million. He was traded
