LAST GAME

A massive comeback bid from the Baysox came up just short, as they fell to the Erie SeaWolves 12-10 on Thursday night. Bowie trailed 6-0 through four innings, before Jud Fabian's three-run home run got the Baysox on the board. Entering the eighth, the SeaWolves' lead was stretched to 12-3, before the Baysox plated five runs in the top of the eighth. Maxwell Costes and Max Wagner each drove in a run with a single, before Fabian drove in his fourth of the night with a bases loaded walk, before a two-run single from John Rhodes capped off the inning. Three-straight hits loaded the bases for Bowie again in the ninth, plating two on a Dylan Beavers single and Max Wagner fielder's choice, but the Baysox could not push closer, as they saw their five-game winning streak come to a close.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Erie SeaWolves enter tonight with an overall record of 64-52 on the season. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, the SeaWolves are 27-21 in the second half, already first half champions in the Southwest division. Erie has excelled in 2023, sitting second in the Eastern League in team average (.247) and home runs (146) at the plate, while holding the third-highest fielding percentage (.980), and the second-best ERA (3.83) amongst a starting staff. The SeaWolves' roster includes seven of the top 30 prospects in the Tigers' system, per MLB Pipeline, including IF Jace Jung (No. 4 DET/No. 71 OVR), RHP Ty Madden (No. 6 DET), RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 7 DET), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 12 DET), OF Justice Bigbie (No. 21 DET) IF Danny Serretti (No. 25 DET), and RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 28 DET).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Brant Hurter is tonight's projected starter for Erie. The No. 12 prospect in the Tigers' system, per MLB Pipeline, Hurter's 3.87 ERA ranks fourth-best in the Eastern League among qualifiers, while his 116 strikeouts lead the Erie staff and sit as fifth-most in the league. Hurter is coming off five frames of two-run ball last Saturday in Akron. Against Bowie this season, Hurter has had mixed results. Overall, the southpaw has gone 1-2 with a 4.50 ERA through four starts against the Baysox. He allowed a season-high six earned runs in Bowie back on 5/7. Most recently against the Baysox, Hurter tossed four shutout frames on 6/11. A seventh round pick of the Tigers in 2021 out of Georgia Tech, Hurter features a low-90s sinker, low-to-mid-80s slider, and a changeup.

HAPPY HOLLIDAY

Top prospect Jackson Holliday has reached safely in 24 of his first 27 games at the Double-A level. He's posted the fifth-highest batting average (.333) and second-highest on-base percentage (.425) in the Eastern League (min. 100 PA) since his Double-A debut on 7/14. Holliday's overall on-base percentage of .455 across the three levels he's played in 2023 is second in all of Minor League Baseball, while his nine triples are also the second-highest total across the minor leagues. Holliday is the ninth player to play for the Baysox prior to his 20th birthday and the first 19-year-old to make his debut with Bowie since Manny Machado and Dylan Bundy in 2012.

LET HIM COOK

IF/OF Billy Cook has done it all for Bowie in 2023. Cook leads all qualified active Baysox players in games played (102), home runs (18), RBI (65), slugging (.451), OPS (.773), and stolen bases (26). After a 5-for-12 start this week, Cook is now hitting .357 against Erie this season, with a team-high three home runs, seven extra-base hits, and 14 RBI against the SeaWolves.

ONE RUN REBOUND

The Baysox are 14-3 in their last 17 one-run games, dating back to 6/22. Bowie is 24-14 overall in games decided by one run in 2023 - the third-most one-run victories in Minor League Baseball, while playing in the fifth-most one-run games. Last season, the Baysox were just 21-29 in such games, giving them the most one-run losses in Minor League Baseball in 2022, along with the second-lowest winning percentage in the Eastern League in such games. 11 of the last 18 Baysox wins this season have been by a single run.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers joins Bowie from High-A Aberdeen after one of the best performances across Minor League Baseball in the month of July. The No. 9 prospect in the O's system, per MLB Pipeline, hit .397 last month - second-highest in Minor League Baseball among players with at least 60 plate appearances, while his 1.185 OPS was fourth-best and led the Orioles' minor league system. Beavers also led the Baltimore farm with his .494 on-base percentage in the month of July. He's picked up right where he left off with Bowie in the month of August, hitting .360 with the Baysox - the fourth-best average in the Eastern League (min. 90 PA) this month. Beavers has collected 10 multi-hit games in his first 18 at the Double-A level.

CAREER NOTES

- 2022: Pitched to a 0.96 ERA in the month of June, allowing just three runs across 28 innings, while striking out 32 compared to just 10 walks. Also held opponents to .188 average in the month of June.
- Went four or more scoreless innings seven times on the season.
- Started two postseason contests for the IronBirds, allowing a single run over nine innings, including going four scoreless frames in the South Atlantic League Championship Series.
- Pitched two seasons at UC Irvine, where he posted a 4.03 career ERA in 19 appearances (18 starts) across 96 innings.
- Transferred to UC Irvine in 2020 after spending two seasons at Ohlone College, pitching 26 games (22 starts) with an ERA of 2.19, striking out 133 batters and walking just 33 in 119 innings.
- Pitched sparingly at California High School in San Ramon and entered college with a mid-80s fastball before truly developing his game at Ohlone.
- Oldest of six siblings.

NOTES BY START*

- 4/8 Double-A debut. Pitched in tandem to Cade Povich's start. Third pitch thrown went for a double, and an error that should have ended the inning allowed the runner to score. Across a 1-2-3 inning in the next frame, was struck by a line drive on the forearm before assisting on the out at first. Left the game.
- 4/29 Second game of a doubleheader, only baserunner allowed was a double with two outs in the first. 22 pitches in the first, just 12 in the second.
- 5/6 Walked two batters in the first, but a caught stealing kept inning scoreless. Allowed a solo home run to lead off the second.
- 5/12 Relieved Garrett Stallings with Bowie up 2-0. Allowed double to first batter, and two-run home run to fourth. Walked first two batters in next inning and allowed go-ahead single.
- 5/18 Thanks to a double play, faced the minimum in the first two innings, and struck out the side in the second. Allowed the first four batters to reach in the third inning, allowing five total hits and two walks in the frame before being pulled.
- 5/24 Pitched in relief of Garrett Stallings. Walked the first batter he saw, then retired next six to open a scoreless outing.
- 6/4 Relieved Garrett Stallings. Struck out the first two batters, but then allowed a home run, loaded the bases, and then a grand slam before being lifted.
- 6/10 Allowed a solo home run in the third inning. Three base error and sacrifice fly led to a second run and a short fourth inning.
- 6/16 Relieved Stallings. Allowed just two baserunners, and only one to second base.
- 6/22 Allowed back-to-back doubles to start the game, but worked scoreless the rest of the way, facing just two over the minimum.
- 6/29 Walked two batters in the first inning, allowed a two-out home run in the second, and a leadoff homer in the third. Allowed a third home run in the fourth.
- 7/4 Only baserunners allowed were in the third inning. Leadoff walk, infield single, and three-run home run. Was in line to win until Bowie allowed seven runs in the eighth.
