BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN: The Sacramento River Cats won tonight's game, 7-3, ending their three-game home losing streak...they River Cats are now 28-7 when scoring at least one home run...they are also now 17-11 at home, 11-10 against left-handed starters, 19-11 when committing no errors and 9-12 when their opponent... John Michael Bertrand was the starter but did not factor into the decision...allowed two runs on six hits with no walks and three strikeouts in 5.0 innings...marked his second outing season where he did not give up a walk... Spencer Bivens pitched his first game of relief since April 26 and earned the win, his third of the season and first since April 10...allowed one run on two hits, with no walks and three strikeouts in 3.0 innings of work...Turner Hill (2-for-3) knocked his second home run of the season, a three-run, 389-foot shot to right center field...the ball had an exit velocity of 106.1mph, Hill's sixth-hardest hit ball of the season...389 feet was the exact same distance as his first longball on May 27...marked his 10th multi-hit game with Sacramento.

► Osleivis Basabe went 2-for-4 with an RBI double in the eighth...was activated today from the 7-day IL... knocked an RBI single in the sixth to give the River Cats a 3-2 lead...has reached base safely in 20-straight games, T-4th-longest in the PCL...he is batting .297 (22-for-74) with seven doubles, three home runs, 14 RBI, eight walks, four stolen bases, a .514 slugging percentage and an .890 OPS in that span since May 1...was his ninth multi-hit game.

► Will Brennan went 3-for-4, his third three-plus-hit game of the season and first since April 10...rejoined the River Cats after being optioned four the fourth time from San Francisco...he has hit safely in all but two games with the River Cats, batting .347 (33-for-95) with five doubles, one triple, one home run, 17 RBI, four walks, one stolen base, a .375 on-base percentage and an .828 OPS in 23 games with Sacramento this season.

WHEN IT RAINS, IT POURS: The River Cats lost last night's game, 1-5, their first time this season with three-straight losses at home (dating back to May 24 vs. SUG)...recorded four doubles, marking the 22nd time this season they have had at least four extra-base-hits...they are now 19-2 in game where they have four-or-more extra-baggers...after scoring a homer in 16 of their 17 games from May 6-28, they have now not recorded a longball in four of their last five games since May 29...they are also now 6-17 in games where they do not record a home run...Matt Wilkinson was the starter and was dealt the loss...made his Triple-A debut after being promoted from Double-A Richmond on June 2...allowed one runs on one hit, with four walks and two strikeouts in 1.1 innings of work...marked the second shortest outing of his career and the first time he gave up a bases-loaded walk both since June 3, 2025 with the Lake County Captains.

► Nate Furman went 2-for-4, the 12th multi-hit game of his career...knocked two doubles, the first time hitting two doubles in a game in his career...was second multi-extra-base-hit game of the season (also, May 28 at Reno, one double and one home run)...extended his hitting streak to 11 games, T-4th longest in the PCL... he is batting .360 (18-for-50) with nine runs, five doubles, one triple, two home runs, 10 RBI, two walks, three stolen bases, a .620 slugging percentage and a .990 OPS in that span since May 22.

WHAT UP I'M JARED: Jared Oliva began his major league rehab assignment on May 30...joined the River Cats on rehab after being placed on the 10-day IL on April 15, and transferred to the 60-day IL on April 29 due to a left wrist hamate fracture...on May 31, he went 1-for-3 with a leadoff double in the first...was the 14th leadoff extra-base-hit of his career, and first since he hit a leadoff homer on May 3, 2019 with Double-A Altoona...marked his first back-to-back games with an extra-base-hit since August 24 and 26 last season.

► In five games with Sacramento this season, he is batting .313 (5-for-16) with two doubles, one RBI, three stolen bases, a .438 slugging percentage and an .732 OPS.

KEEP YOUR WHITS ABOUT YOU: Southpaw Joe Whitman is set to take the mound tonight against Tacoma for his Triple-A debut...was promoted to the River Cats on June 2...last pitched May 30 at Akron where he did not factor into the decision of Richmond's 3-10 defeat...allowed three runs on six hits, with no walks and a Double-A career-high nine strikeouts in 6.0 quality innings.

► Was drafted by the Giants in the 2C Round of the 2023 Draft as the 69th overall pick.
► Went 5-1 in 10 starts with the Double-A Richmond Flying Squirrels this season...posted a 3.22 ERA (50.1 IP, 18 ER) with two home runs, 13 walks, 65 strikeouts and a .198 opponent batting average.
► Was named the MiLB Pitcher of the Month for the Double-A Eastern League for the month of May...Whitman went 3-0 with a 0.96 ERA in five starts with the Flying Squirrels.

AN HONOR AND A PRIVILEGE: This morning, Minor League Baseball announced the Player and Pitcher of the Month Award winners for May:

► Carson Whisenhunt earned the honor for the Triple-A Pacific Coast League. Whisenhunt went 2-0 with a 2.81 ERA in six starts in the month of May, as he allowed 10 earned runs on 28 hits and 11 walks over 32.0 innings. He led the league in strikeouts (32) and hits allowed per nine innings (7.88) and was second in ERA (2.81) and WHIP (1.22). He was one of two pitchers in the league with over 18.0 innings of work that did not surrender a home run.

► Joe Whitman earned the honor for the Double-A Eastern League. Whitman went 3-0 with a 0.96 ERA in five starts with the Flying Squirrels as he allowed three earned runs on 14 hits and five walks while striking out 37 over 28.0 innings. He led the league in ERA (0.96), strikeouts (37), WHIP (0.68), average against (.146), hits allowed per nine innings (4.5) and strikeouts per nine innings (11.89). He began the month with a 23.0 inning scoreless streak before being tagged with three runs in his final start of the month.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE: LHP Carson Whisenhunt #18 (4-2, 3.72)

- Last pitched on May 31 at Reno where he did not factor into the decision of Sacramento's 13-11 victory...allowed five runs on seven hits, with three walks (1 IBB) and six strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work.
- Through 12 appearances this season (11 starts), Carson has posted a 3.72 ERA (58.0 IP, 24 ER) with 25 walks, 62 strikeouts and a .237 opponent batting average.
