Hudson Valley Renegades recorded their 11th consecutive season with an above .500 record (since 2012). During that span, the team has won two league championships (2012 and 2017), seven playoff appearances (12, 14,

 Was a member of the U15 and U18 Swedish National Teams, competing at the 2013 and 2016 European Championship tournaments.
- Father, Tom, and brother, Cristoffer, both played baseball at Division III Hamilton College in Clinton, New York.
- At Northeastern was coached by former MLB infielder Mike Glavine, the brother of Hall of Fame LHP Tom Glavine. Mike played six games in 2003 with the New York Mets and parts of nine seasons in the minor leagues from 1995-2004 with the Cleveland, Atlanta and Mets organizations, as well as a two-year stint with the Somerset Patriots in '01 and '02 when they competed in the independent Atlantic League.
