### BIG HITS ELUDE JUMBO SHRIMP IN 6-4 LOSS

Jacksonville stranded 13 runners in Wednesday's 6-4 defeat to Nashville. The Sounds earned a wire-to-wire win, plating three in the first inning to take control. After **Griffin Conine's** sacrifice fly in the second got the Jumbo Shrimp on the board, **Joey Wiemer** bashed a two-run home run in the third to widen the gap to 5-1. Conine added an RBI single in the fourth and the teams traded sacrifice flies in the fifth. **Jerar Encarnacion's** RBI double in the seventh drew Jacksonville within 6-4, but the Jumbo Shrimp could get no closer in the loss.

### THE EAGLE HAS LANDED IS STRANDED

Jacksonville has stranded 24 runners on-base in 18 offensive innings thus far in their series in Nashville, going just 5-for-23 with runners in scoring position during these two games and exacerbating a huge issue of late for the club. Over the last 23 games, the Jumbo Shrimp have stranded 166 runners, an average of 7.2 per game, mainly by hitting a woeful 38-for-186 (.204) with runners in scoring position. Jacksonville has had multiple hits with runners in scoring position in just 10 of these 23 games, with more than two hits over these situations in only six affairs of this stretch.

### ODDS & ENDS ON 2023

After five straight losing seasons from 2015-2019, Jacksonville earned consecutive winning campaigns in 2021 and 2022. However, with four games remaining in the 2023 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are sitting at a 69-76 (.476) record, unable to record its third straight winning season. The Jumbo Shrimp also finished the 2023 home slate with a 35-39 (.473) record. The last time Jacksonville suffered a losing home record was in 2018, when they went 27-41 (.397).

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

From Opening Day through August 15, 61 of Jacksonville's 114 games (53.5 percent) were decided by three runs or fewer. However, in the 31 games since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have played 22 affairs (71.0 percent) determined by no more than three runs. Over these last 31 games, Jacksonville has posted a 9-13 (.409) record in these narrowly decided affairs. In comparison, through August 15, the Shrimp were 30-31 (.492) in contests decided by three runs or fewer.

### 'PEN PALS

Over the last month-plus, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 37 games the club has played since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 67 runs, 56 earned, on 119 hits (8.0 H/9) in 134.2 innings for a 3.74 ERA. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp relief corps has combined to strike out 155 batters (10.4 K/9) against 85 walks (5.7 BB/9).

### BROKEN BATS

Since beginning a series with Charlotte on August 29, the Jumbo Shrimp offense has been mired in a massive slump. Jacksonville has scored three runs or fewer in 14 of their last 20 games, with the club mustering a meager .209/.309/.298/.607 batting line as a team. Not coincidentally, the Jumbo Shrimp's 60 runs (3.0 per game) rank last in Triple-A during this span. Despite getting outscored 78-60, Jacksonville has posted a 9-11 record during this stretch. Eight of those nine victories have been decided by three runs or fewer.

### ROAD RAGE

From 2015-19, Jacksonville failed to post a winning record on the road in any campaign from, going a combined 137-210 (.395). However, upon joining the Triple-A level in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp's road fortunes rapidly improved. In 2021 and 2022, the club posted a combined mark of 81-58 (.583) on the road. However, in 2023, Jacksonville has registered a 34-37 (.479) mark away from 121 Financial Ballpark. Interestingly, while the club has posted nearly identical OPS' at home (.749) vs. on the road (.752) in 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp have pitched much better at home. At home, Jacksonville has allowed the eighth-fewest runs (365) in the IL with a 4.56 ERA. On the road, the club has ceded the third-most runs (434) in the league with a 5.76 ERA.

### SHRIMP BITES

Marlins right-handers **Sandy Alcantara** and **Huascar Brazobán** will join the Jumbo Shrimp today on rehab assignments. Alcantara, who won the 2022 NL Cy Young Award unanimously, is 7-12 with a 4.14 ERA in 28 starts this season (184.2 IP, 176 H, 48 BB, 151 K, 3.2 bWAR, 2.8 fWAR)... Jacksonville's 10 walks drawn on Wednesday matched their fifth-most in a game this season.

### ABOUT SANDY

-The unanimous winner of the 2022 National League Cy Young Award and a two-time All-Star, Alcantara posted the second-lowest ERA in the NL (2.28) with MLB highs for innings (228.2) and complete games (six) -- both marking the most in the majors in six years. It marked the first time in AL/NL history that a pitcher threw more complete games than every club that season. Despite his MLB-low 14.20 pitches per inning, the righty was the first pitcher in franchise history to record consecutive 200-strikeout seasons. Because of all this, Alcantara accumulated the most WAR -- via FanGraphs and Baseball-Reference -- of any Cy Young Award finalists. Alcantara is also the first Marlin to earn the Cy Young Award.

-Alcantara is the third Dominican-born pitcher to win a Cy Young Award overall (Bartolo Colon in 2005 and Pedro Martinez in 2000, 1999 and '97). Martinez, Alcantara's childhood hero, made the announcement.

-One of 11 children, Alcantara was sent by his parents when he was 11 years old to live with an older sister in the Dominican Republic capital, Santo Domingo, where he could both study for school and attend baseball practice. He dropped out of school in eighth grade to concentrate on a baseball career.

-At the age of 8, Sandy Alcantara decided to become a pitcher full time. Though the Little Leaguer enjoyed showing off his arm in the outfield of La Luisa Blanca in Monte Plata, Dominican Republic, he had never been a particularly good hitter. So Alcantara remained on the mound, throwing the ball toward home plate around 35 mph.

-In July 2013, at age 17, Alcantara signed with the St. Louis Cardinals as an international free agent. He was traded along with outfielder Magneuris Sierra, right-hander Zac Gallen and left-hander Daniel Castano to the Miami Marlins December 14, 2017 for outfielder Marcell Ozuna.

-Alcantara owns Marlins franchise records of most innings pitched by a rookie, and most innings pitched and strikeouts by a Dominican-born player. On November 28, 2021, the Marlins signed Alcantara to a contract extension worth \$56 million over five years (plus an option for the 2027 season), breaking the record for the largest contract for a pitcher under team control with less than four years service time, originally set by Carlos Martinez.

### 2023 SEASON

-Alcantara was initially diagnosed with a right forearm flexor strain and was placed on the 15-day injured list on Sept. 6 after feeling discomfort during his Sept. 3 start at Washington. That diagnosis was later changed to a sprained ulnar collateral ligament (UCL) in his right throwing elbow.
