**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the opener in a six-game series with the Fort Wayne TinCaps, High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. The Nuts are coming off winning four of six games at home against Lake County and have won seven of their last nine games, including three straight road games dating back to May 10-12 at Great Lakes. Fort Wayne, meanwhile, enters on a five-game winning streak; this is the second week of a TinCaps two-week homestand.

**On the Air:** Today's game is available on MiLB TV with **John Nolan**, or tune in via StreamGuys with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** on the call.

**Last Game, Sunday: Captains 13, Lugnuts 9 (10 innings).** The Nuts built a 9-5 lead behind home runs from **Henry Bolte** and **Brayan Buevas**, but Lake County rallied to tie the game with two runs in the ninth, then tacked on four runs in the tenth to salvage a second victory in the series. The game took three hours and 20 minutes to play, following a three-hour, 50-minute Saturday night epic. Lugnuts center fielder Bolte finished a single shy of the cycle.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts play the TinCaps through Sunday, then return home for a six-game series against the Peoria Chiefs from May 28-June 2.

### LUG•NOTES

**Prospecting:** The Nuts' roster includes four MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Henry Bolte** (No. 10), first baseman **Will Simpson** (No. 27) and southpaw **Will Johnston** (No. 30). In Eric Longenhagen's Top 32 A's prospects for Fangraphs, he gives a nod to Morales at No. 3, Simpson at No. 28 and Johnston at No. 32. Keith Law placed Morales at No. 7 and Bolte at No. 17, giving a nod to Morales as his sleeper prospect of the organization.

**Scar at the Helm:** Lansing will be managed this series by **Steve Scarsone**, replacing second-year manager **Craig Conklin** during Conklin's prescheduled week-long break. Scarsone was drafted by the Phillies in the second round in 1986 from Santa Ana College, rising through the ranks to play seven years and 350 games in the Majors with Philly, Baltimore, San Francisco, St. Louis and Kansas City. He managed in the Midwest League with South Bend in 2001 and Kane County in 2009. Scarsone's current title within the A's system is Minor League Outfield and Base Running Coordinator, a position he has held since 2020. He also served as interim manager last season, skipping the Lugnuts to a six-game split at Quad Cities, July 25-30.

**Pride of Palo Alto:** 20-year-old **Henry Bolte**, the youngest player on the team, was named the Midwest League Player of the Week and a member of Minor League Baseball's Prospect Team of the Week after going 10-for-22 (.455/.586/1.000) with four doubles, one triple, two homers, six walks, nine runs scored, seven runs batted in, and four steals against Lake County. Bolte leads all of Minor League Baseball with 20 runs scored this month; he ranks 1st in High-A with 36 runs scored overall and is 2nd in High-A in total bases (75) and extra-base hits (19).

**Return to Glory:** Closer **Colton Johnson**, who missed all of the 2022 and 2023 seasons due to injury, leads the Midwest League with 15 appearances and is tied for 3rd with five saves.

**Team Effort:** Lansing's offense tops the Midwest League in hits (339), runs (221), OPS (.756), triples (17), walks (193) and total bases (528). The Nuts are 2nd in doubles (71), batting average (.257) and slugging percentage (.400).

**The Prospect From Prospect (KY):** **Cameron Masterman**, currently working on his Master's degree at Louisville, comes in riding a team-high 18-game on-base streak. Masterman extended the streak with a single, double and walk Sunday.

**Welcome Back:** **Euribiel "Rubi" Angeles**, a member of the 2021 Fort Wayne TinCaps, returns to Parkview Field with a red hot bat. After opening the season 1-for-22, the 22-year-old shortstop is 41-for-118, a .347 clip. He is tied for 4th in hits (42), 2nd in RBIs (33, 22 in May alone) and ranks 1st in triples (4). He enters tonight's game on a team-high eight-game hitting streak.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2004:** With all eyes on him and a Thursday night crowd of 9,823 in attendance, rehabbing Mark Prior made his first appearance since the 2003 National League Championship Series, beginning his road back to the Majors. Prior faced the minimum in three innings, striking out five and issuing one walk – to Drew Macias, who was then caught stealing by catcher Jake Fox to end the second inning. The Lugnuts defeated the Fort Wayne Wizards, 2-1, on two runs in the bottom of the ninth. Brian Dopirak tied the game with a two-out RBI double. Three batters later, Fox drew a walk-off walk to bring in Dopirak. Future Major Leaguer Carlos Marmol picked up the win, allowing one run in six innings and striking out eight.

**2017:** The Lugnuts sent ten batters to the plate in a four-run first inning, knocking out South Bend starter Tyson Miller, but the Cubs responded with an 11-run third inning for an 11-7 rain-shortened six-inning victory at Four Winds Field. Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. went 3-for-3 with a walk and three RBIs (one for each hit) in the loss.

**Hometown Hero:** Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams... can often be seen at this time of year wearing his Boston Bruins Patrice Bergeron uniform.

**Jupiter?** How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

**The Bandit Connection:** Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

**The U:** Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

**Professional Debut:** After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

**2023 Retrospective:** Opened the campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win... finished with 18 appearances, 84 1/3 IP.

**In a Nutshell:** One of four undrafted free agents on the Nuts, joining pitchers Dylan Hall and Jack Owen, and outfielder Cameron Masterman... last Iowa player to suit up for Lansing; former Major League lefty Matt Dermody... started the Crosstown Showdown against Michigan State and tossed four scoreless two-hit innings in 18-0 win, April 3.

**Family of Athletes:** Father, Rob, played college baseball at Central College of Iowa, located in his hometown of Pella, as did both of his brothers, Jordan and Blake; his mother, Shannon, played golf in college.

**At Pella High School:** 2016 Iowa Gatorade Player of the Year as a senior... Des Moines Register's All-Iowa Baseball Player of the Year as both a junior and a senior, 2015 and 2016... 2015 Perfect Game Underclass High Honorable Mention... as a senior: 10-1, 0.64 ERA, 123 K, batting .421 with six homers and 12 steals... as a junior: 11-1, 0.56 ERA, 74 IP, 112 K, 10 BB, batting .520 with 14 doubles, nine triples, 13 homers, 57 RBIs, 51 runs, 15 steals... in his high school career, won 28 career games and totaled 337 career strikeouts.

**Onward to Des Moines:** Entered the Big Ten ranked by Baseball America as the No. 8 freshman... two-way player in 2017, hitting .270 in 31 starts as a DH (and three starts as a pitcher hitting for himself)... 2018 Academic All-Big Ten... No. 3 starter in 2019; 2019 Collegiate Baseball Player National Pitcher of the Week (Feb. 18), tossing six no-hit innings with 11 strikeouts; ranked 7th in the Big Ten in ERA (2.72)... No. 2 starter in 2020 before season was halted early due to the pandemic: 2-0, 3.00, 4 GS, 21 IP, 24 K, 5 BB... signed with the Athletics following the shortened five-round draft.

**International Stage:** With Iowa, took part in the 2017 World University Games in Taipei City, winning a silver medal (fell to Japan in the gold medal contest)... part of the first American team to ever advance to the gold medal game as well as the first American team to ever medal, period... team finished 5-2, losing only to Japan... started five games, four at first base, one at pitcher.
