Sacramento River Cats (28-18) vs. Sugar Land Space Cowboys (20-28)

TO THE MOOOOOON: The Sacramento River Cats won last night's game 8-1, giving them a seven-game win streak for the second time this season (also, April 4 (2)-15) and securing at least a split on the series...they are now 15-7 at home, 19-14 in night games, and 6-9 when their opponent scores first...Blade Tidwell was the starter but did not factor into the decision...allowed one run on four hits (1 HR) with two walks and a season-high eight strikeouts...eight fanned batters was his most since August 5, 2025...he struckout eight-or-more batters in four games last season...Trent Harris earned his first win of the season and first since August 3, 2025 at Albuquerque...threw 1.2 hitless innings, allowing one walk and striking out two batters...Christian Koss (2-for-4) recorded his first home run of the season and first since August 5, 2025...the two-run shot traveled 381 feet, the sixth-longest (recorded) home run of his career...also marked his first multi-hit game of the season...Grant McCray went 2-for-3, his 10th multi-hit game of the season...knocked two doubles, his second multi-extra-base hit (also, April 1, two doubles)...he is batting .500 (4-for-8) with three doubles, one RBI, five walks, a .714 on-base percentage and a 1.589 OPS this series.

HOUSTON, YOU'VE GOT A PROBLEM: Sacramento won last night's game 13-1, their largest margin of victory this season...shut out the Space Cowboys until a Cavan Biggio solo homer in the top of the ninth...Sac recorded their second multi-double play game of the season, the only team now without multiple multi-DP games is Tacoma...Carson Whisenhunt was the starter and earned his fourth victory of the season...threw 6.0 scoreless, quality innings, allowing four hits, two walks, and fanning three batters...marked his third quality start this season...his 3.35 ERA and 49 strikeouts lead the PCL...all nine River Cats batters recorded a hit tonight, the fourth time the team has done this feat this season, and third time this month...they also hit a season-high seven extra-base-hits, including a season-high-tying five doubles...all nine River Cats batters also scored a run, the first time doing so this season.

► Drew Cavanaugh (3-for-5) recorded his first career multi-home run game...hit his first blast in the fourth, a 405-foot, three-run shot to center field...his second came in the eighth and was a 421-foot, solo homer to right center field...became the fourth individual River Cat to have a multi-homer game this season...were his second and third home runs at the Triple-A level...marked his second three-hit game of the season (also, April 5 with Richmond).

► Logan Porter went (3-for-5) hit his first home run of the season, becoming the final River Cat on the Opening Day roster to get a longball...was a 410-foot, two-run knock to center field, the third-longest homer of his Triple-A career...also knocked two singles in the fourth, becoming to the first River Cat this season to record multiple hits in a single frame.

WE HAD A BLAST...OR FIVE: River Cats batters recorded a season-high five home runs on Wednesday...marked the first time they have had five longballs in a single game and the first time they have had four individual Cats hit a homer since August 28, 2025 (6 HR, 5 players homered)...two longballs in the second inning marked the fourth time Sac has recorded multiple homers in a single frame this season...was the 36th time in franchise history the team has hit five-plus homers; they are now 33-3 in such games...the last time they lost while hitting five-or-more longballs was June 15, 2024 at Reno.

► Victor Bericoto (2-for-5) hit his fifth home run of the season, a 413-foot, three-run shot to center field, followed by his team-leading sixth home run in the eighth; a 459-foot, solo-shot to center field...459 feet marked the longest homer by a River Cat and seventh-longest in Triple-A this season (longest, 479 feet)...he became the third River Cat to have a multi-homer game (also, Eldridge and Susac).

► Jake Holton (2-for-3) knocked his fourth home run of the season as the leadoff batter in the second...also hit an RBI double in the seventh...was his first multi-extra-base-hit game this season, and first since August 28, 2025 with the Erie SeaWolves (two doubles).

► Nate Furman (2-for-4) hit his third homer of the season just two at-bats after Holton in the second, a 422-foot, solo-shot to right center field...422 feet was the fourth-longest homer hit by a River Cat this season (Bericoto, 459 feet, Eldridge, 434 feet and Bader, 424 feet)...was his first homer since April 25 (2) vs. Albuquerque.

► Buddy Kennedy (1-for-3) recorded his fifth home run of the season, a 378-foot, three-run shot to left field in the fifth.

ALL WE DO IS WIN: The River Cats hold a 10-game winning streak against the Space Cowboys, tied for their third-longest winning streak against an opponent in franchise history...below are the Cats' longest win streaks against each opponent and when they occurred:

BUDDY SYSTEM: Infielder Buddy Kennedy has been phenomenal in his debut with the River Cats this season...has the second-highest batting average among current River Cats players (min. 10 games) at .329, behind Turner Hill's .325...he leads the team and is T-9th in the Pacific Coast League in doubles (12)...his five home runs are most on the team among current River Cats players (Eldridge & Bericoto, 6)...his 49 hits are also most on the team among current River Cats players (Bericoto, 50)...his 27 RBI are second behind Basabe (29)...he leads the team in OBP (.416), SLG (.510) and OPS (.926). See rankings >>>>

► His 14 XBH since April 19 are T-5th-most in PCL and T-11th most in Triple-A...since that date, he is batting .327 (32-for-98) with eight doubles, one triple, five home runs, 19 RBI, 15 walks, a .582 slugging percentage and a 1.013 OPS in 24 games.

CAUGHT IN A WEBB: Right-hander Logan Webb is set to start tonight for Sacramento...joins the River Cats on major league rehab assignment after being placed on the 15-day IL on May 9 (retroactive to May 6) due to right knee bursitis...started eight games with the Giants this season, posting a 5.06 ERA (48.0 IP, 27 ER) with 15 walks, 42 strikeouts and a .275 opponent batting average...Webb appeared in one game with Sacramento on August 12, 2019 vs. Nashville where he allowed one run on seven hits with no walks and seven strikeouts in 7.0 innings of work...was recalled to San Francisco and made his major league debut five days later on August 17, 2019...his second and last appearance with the River Cats was July 1, 2021 at Las Vegas where he allowed one run on one hit, with one walk and one strikeout in 2.0 innings of work.
