### JACKSONVILLE WINS FOURTH STRAIGHT

Peyton Burdick cracked two home runs on Wednesday to blast the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp past the Charlotte Knights 3-1 from Truist Field. For the 10th game in a row to start the season, the Jumbo Shrimp (6-4) put the leadoff man on to begin their first at-bats when Xavier Edwards walked against Charlotte (5-6) starter A.J. Alexy (0-2). Jake Mangum then lifted a sacrifice fly to right to put Jacksonville ahead two batters into the contest. Burdick crushed his first homer of the game to lead off the second. His second, a 116.2 mile-per-hour laser beam over the stands in left, came to start the fourth to make it 3-0.

### FIRST THINGS FIRST

For the 10th game in a row to start the season, Jacksonville got their leadoff man on to begin their first at-bats when Xavier Edwards walked in his first at-bat of the top of the first inning from Charlotte starter A.J. Alexy. Of those 10 leadoff baserunners, five have come on swings on the first pitch. Seven of those 10 leadoff baserunners have also come via hits; Brian Miller reached on an error to start the Jumbo Shrimp's contest on April 2 at the Stripers, Edwards walked to start the bottom of the first on Sunday against Durham and Edwards drew a free pass to start Thursday's affair at Charlotte.

### LEADERS, NOT FOLLOWERS

Jacksonville scored in the top of the first inning on Wednesday in Charlotte, the fifth game in a row and ninth time in 10 games the Jumbo Shrimp have struck for at least one tally in their first at-bats. Jacksonville has scored first in seven of its 10 games thus far in 2023, going 6-1 when doing so. The Jumbo Shrimp scored the game's first run 83 times in 2022 (55.7 percent) and had a 62-21 (.747) record when doing so.

### SHRIMP BITES

Jordan Groshans has at least one hit in eight of Jacksonville's first 10 games so far this season, going 10- for-38 (.262/.326/.333/.659) at the plate with two doubles, five RBIs and six runs scored...While his eight-game hitting streak came to a close, Groshans on-base streak continues to 10 straight as he has reached in the last 10 games... Peyton Burdick has two multi-homer games this season.

### CHARLOTTE'S WEB

Since the club's first season back in Triple-A, Jacksonville owns a 30-23 record against the Knights. The two teams played each other to a razor thin margin last year (16-14). Against Charlotte, the Jumbo Shrimp hitters slashed .288/.367/.470 with an .837 OPS (2nd-highest) among 2022 division opponents. The pitching staff owned 4.51 ERA (3rd-lowest) among 2022 division opponents.

### THE ENDS JUSTIFY THE MEANS

Only six teams in the IL (Iowa, Omaha, Norfolk, Syracuse Toldeo and Columbus) have scored more runs than Jacksonville through the season's first ten games. Despite the club's 67 runs scored, the Jumbo Shrimp are tied for 11th in average (.249), 15th in on-base percentage (.336), 12th in slugging percentage (.423) and 12th in OPS (.749). With runners in scoring position, though, Jacksonville's slash line jumps up to .277/.346/.464/.810, figures that rank third, ninth, fourth and fifth, respectively.

### ON THE OTHER SIDE THOUGH...

While the Jumbo Shrimp are ranked eighth in the league in runs scored, they also have ceded the most runs in the IL by a huge margin. Jacksonville has yielded 69 runs, an average of 6.9 per game. Charlotte, is ranked 14th in the 20-team league entering play on Thursday has surrendered 60 tallies (6.0 per game) and are closer to 10th-place than to Jacksonville. The Jumbo Shrimp have issued the fifth-most walks (47) in the circuit, while ranking 15th in batting average against (.268) and 19th in hits allowed (97). The club has surrendered at least five runs in all but three game so far.

### GO C.J., GO C.J., GO C.J., GO

On Jacksonville's slugging offense, perhaps no one has shined more than C.J. Hinojosa. Through six games thus far in 2023, Hinojosa is 11-for-27, slashing a robust .407/.414/.778/1.192 with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, 10 RBIs and four runs scored. The Houston native ranks tied for sixth in the International League in RBIs, fourth in batting average, fifth in slugging and tied for seventh in OPS. He has knocked in at least one run in every game he's played so far this year, with hits in five of his six contests.

-WALTERS STARRED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA. Walter's name is all over the Alabama baseball record books, including tied for first in career starts at Alabama (52), third in career strikeouts (292), fourth in career innings pitched (295.0) and fourth in batters faced for a career (1,292). In addition, he earned SEC Pitcher of the Week on May 21, 2018.
