Leading Off

The Fightin Phils finish a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, on Sunday. It is the sixth of 18 matchups between the teams this season, and sixth of 12 in Reading. The Fightin Phils won the season-series over Hartford in 2023, going 14-10.

R-Phils.

A Split, But a Series Win

The Fightin Phils fell in game one of Saturday's doubleheader, 5-2, but won game two 5-3. With the win in game two, Reading captured the series victory over Hartford. Casey Martin homered in game one, and Jose Rodriguez's three-run homer in game two proved to be the difference. Ethan Wilson and Bryce Ball also each tripled in the second game on Saturday night.

Trip, Trip, Triples

Reading's two triples last night were the season-high for triples in a game this season. The Fightin Phils are now up to nine triples on the season, which currently ranks second in the Eastern League. In 2023, Reading had 21 triples and they are on pace for 39 this season.

Wilson Lilros Coat

Ethan Wilson is turning in a terrific week against Hartford. This week, Wilson is slashing .467/.579/.733, with a 1.312 OPS. He's added two doubles, one triple, two RBI and scored three runs. In 2023, Wilson hit .388, with five home runs and 17 RBI against Hartford. He won Eastern League Player of the Week in early-May last after a torrid week against the Yard Goats.

News and Notes

Last night, Reading captured its 15th win of the 2024 season. On May 12 of last season, Reading had just 11 wins. They didn't reach 15 wins until May 21st last year. With his save last night, Tommy McCollum improved his team-best ERA to 1.59 and opponents are hitting just .132 against him. McCollum also leads the team with four saves in as many oppurtunities. Tristan Garnett did not allow an earned run in 1.2 innings in game one to lower his ERA to 1.62, which ranks as second best on the team.

Series Winners

With a win in game two Saturday, Reading captured its second-straight series win at home. In 2023, the R-Phils won just two series at home, one a three-game series with Portland last July, and they won 3/5 against the Sea Dogs in September. The last time the Fightin Phils won back-to-back series at home was in August of 2022 (8/2-7 vs Hartford and 8/16-21 vs Portland). With a win today, Reading will win 5/6 games against Hartford for the second-straight series with the Yard Goats, with the last coming the first week of August in 2023.

Rodriguez Rolling

Jose Rodriguez has been heating up as of late. After hitting .176 in April, Rodriguez is hitting .300 in May. In game two on Saturday night, Rodriguez had two hits, two runs and three RBI, all of which came on a big three-run home run. This week, Rodriguez is slashing .333/.350/.722, with a 1.072 OPS. He's added two doubles, one triple, one home run, six RBI and six runs scored. Rodriguez is the lone member of the Reading roster who is on the Phillies 40-man roster, after being acquired from the White Sox on Apr. 5 for cash consideration.

The Goat

Hartford enters today with a 15-14 record, which is third in the Northeast Division. The Yard Gosts continue a two-week road trip after going 2-3 at Binghamton last week. They won the first two games, before dropping the last three, and Sunday was cancelled. After this week, Hartford returns home and welcomes New Hampshire. Last season, Hartford finished with an Eastern League-worst 57-76 record. The Yard Goats roster includes nine of the Rockies top-30 prospects, featuring No. 1 Adael Amador and No. 3 Yanquiel Fernandez. Hartford has now lost six-straight games after winning their previous five.

Goat on the Bump

Righty Connor Van Scoyoc gets the ball this afternoon for Hartford. This season, he's 1-3, with an 9.15 ERA (20.2 IP, 27 H, 16 BB, 16 SO). Van Scoyoc last pitched on Tuesday at Reading, getting the loss, allowing six runs over four innings, with four walks and three strikeouts. He split last season between the Angels and Rockies systems, pitching for High-A Tri-City, High-A Spokane and Double-A Hartford. He combined to go 7-6, with a 3.80 ERA over 23 starts. Van Scoyoc was traded from the Angels to Rockies on June 25, 2023, in exchance for Mike Moustakas. The 24-year old was drafted in the 11th round of the 2018 draft out of Jefferson High School in Cedar Rapids, Iowa.
