SOUND BITE

The Sounds have played in front of sellout crowds in back-to-back home games, with 10,991 fans packing First Horizon Park last night. Over July 4 and 5, Nashville has seen 21,988 fans enter the park. It's the first time Nashville has had back-to-back sellouts since June 23 and 24, 2023 vs. Norfolk. The Sounds are averaging the third-most fans per night at 7,276 in the International League. India-napolis currently leads the IL in attendance with 326,290 total fans entering Victory Field across 41 games this season (7,958 average).

Challenge system (3x): 18-19 Back at .500: For the 16th time this season, the Sounds are at .500. The Sounds have been five games over .500 twice in 2024, the last time being 35-30 on June 12. Nashville's worst record was also five games under .500 at 13-18 back on May 3 vs. Norfolk (the night they were no-hit by the

> **Roster Move:** After being designated for assignment on July 1, Owen Miller cleared waivers and was outrighted from Milwaukee yesterday. The infielder is batting .259 (44-for-170) with 13 extra-base hits and 20 RBI in 28 games with the Sounds. He has played in 14 games with the Brewers this season. Miller is the seventh player to clear waivers and be outrighted to Nashville this season from Milwaukee, and the second in as many days.

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 726-626 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,318-2,146 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more) All-Time Record: 3,369-3,145 among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more).
