Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Trenton Denholm** to the mound tonight, coming off the only quality start thrown by a Clipper this season. Worcester will counter with LHP **T.J. Sikkema**. Columbus is 0-1 (.000) versus left handers this year. Sikkema has pitched against the Clippers once in his career, making his Triple-A debut with Louisville on 8/27/25 (W, 6.0IP, 2H, 1R, 1ER, 0BB, 4K).

vs. the Red Sox

Against the WooSox, Columbus is 11-6 all-time and, dating to August of 2014, Columbus has pounded Boston's Triple-A affiliate 36-19. This week marks the fourth trip to Massachusetts in as many seasons, as the Red Sox have still not been to Columbus since moving from Pawtucket. **Kody Huff** has gone 6x19 (.316) with 4RBI against Worcester in his career (5G).

Left Behind

Tonight will mark the second time this year that Columbus will face off against a southpaw starter (33G last year). Last season, 19.9% of Clipper plate appearances came against lefties (7th highest rate in the IL) and they hit .228/.307/.390 in such situations (worst average and OBP, 7th worst SLG). Columbus did hit 26HR off left handers (8th fewest), thanks to a power surge in September (6HR in 132AB).

Triple Rehab

Hunter Gaddis joined the Clippers on rehab opening weekend (strained right forearm) and has appeared in 3G (2.1IP, 4H, 4R, 4ER, 3BB, 3K). **George Valera** began rehab last Wednesday (strained left calf), hitting his 40th homer as a Clipper on 4/3 vs. Indy (hit 40th double on 4/4). **Andrew Walters** is joining on rehab today (right lat surgery), with his next game being the 46th of his Clipper career.

Interesting Strategy

Columbus enters tonight's matchup as the only undefeated team in the IL when allowing the opponents to homer (5-0), while being one of six teams with a losing record when keeping opponents in the yard (1-3). The pitching staff is tied for 6th fewest homers allowed (7), giving up just one bomb with multiple runners on (3-run on 3/29 at Iowa, overcame 5-1 deficit with six runs over final two innings).

Walk Before You Run

This week's matchup features the top two in the IL in walks, with Worcester (67) outpacing Columbus by a fair piece (58, Clippers are +3 on 3rd). Both offenses rank among the top five in the IL with the Sox scoring the 3rd most runs (58) and Clippers checking in at 5th (50). On the mound, Clipper pitchers have issued walks to 15% of batters faced (5th highest rate), while Worcester is at 11% (3rd lowest rate).

Starting Over

Travis Bazzana had his on base streak snapped at 7G Saturday (.353OBP) and the Clippers saw three more season-opening on base streaks of 7G snapped on Sunday (**Nolan Jones**, .516OBP; **Stuart Fairchild**, .581OBP and **Milan Tolentino**, .444OBP). **Kahlil Watson** was able to embiggen his streak to 8G on Sunday (.410OBP), and has reached in 31 straight since 8/19/25 (.417OBP).

East Coast Bias

Stuart Fairchild has 13HR in 69G of his International League career, against 13HR in 63G in the Pacific Coast League. His IL average is 21 points higher (.297 to .276) and while he is slugging worse in the IL, his .508SLG is 21% better than the average IL hitter since 2021 (.529SLG in the PCL was 17% better than average). He hit safely in each of 11G in the IL from 9/17/23 to Saturday (.475, 19x40).

Eye is for Ingle

Cooper Ingle has drawn 7BB in his first 24PA (29%) this season, following a Triple-A debut that saw 21BB in 107PA (20%) last season. Though Ingle has hit only .232 (23x99) in his Columbus career, he has a beefy .412OBP and a +8 differential in the walk to strikeout department (28 to 20). Ingle had a .388OBP in Double-A (79BB to 86K), but was at .439 in Advanced-A (68BB to 48K).

Filling In

Game 10 will find a catcher starting at 1B for the seventh time this year, with **Kody Huff** getting his fourth start (eighth of career; **Dom Nunez** has 3GS this year and 17GS in his career, all with Columbus). Both backstops have been flawless when playing in fair territory, as has almost all the rest of the defense (4E total; 1E from 3B on Sunday, 3E on throws from the catcher during steal attempts).

This Date in Clipper History

4/7/2023

The Clippers unhorsed the Knights by a combined score of 21-0 in a doubleheader vs. Charlotte, including a 17-0 drubbing in the nightcap. **David Fry** was 4x6 with a triple and 6RBI over both games, while **Bo Naylor** went 3x4 with a pair of doubles and 4RBI. **Tanner Bibee** (5.0IP, 4H, 1BB, 7K) led six pitchers in the collective 14-inning shutout, wherein Clipper pitchers allowed 15 baserunners against 17K.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,409 to 1,355).

Challenging Times

The Clippers were 132-174 (.431, 2nd worst in the IL) in pitch reviews last season, with batters going 79-117 (.403) and pitchers/catchers going 53-57 (.482). They ran out of challenges in 57G and did not challenge in 13G.

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus was 5-5 in extra innings last season, following a 9-loss campaign in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-33 when playing past regulation (.602, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-16 at home (.619, but 4-6 in last 10G). Of the 83G to require extra play, 66 have needed only one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Return of the Defense

The Clippers were 1st in the IL in defense (.985), a season after turning in their worst fielding percentage (.978) since 2009. They had only two series with more than 5E (8/26-8/31 at Louisville, 9/17-9/21 vs. Omaha), topping out at 3E in a game twice and playing flawlessly 86 times on the year (44-42, .512; 16G errorless streak from 6/20-7/8, longest in the IL over the last 20 years). Behind the plate, Clipper catchers did not have a passed ball from 9/22/24-5/28/25 (53G; 3,949 pitches with men on base between).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Stuart Fairchild moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 9/16/25 vs. Omaha and those men came around to score in a rare loss (bullpen blew 7-run lead). Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 83-22 (.790) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including an 0-1 (.000) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 392-409 (.489), 362-363 with Columbus (.499).
