## RHP Ryan Feltner (0-3, 9.87) vs. LHP Sammy Peralta (2-1, 4.50)

**TODAY'S GAME**: The Isotopes evened the series at a game apiece after an 8-3 win last night ... Ryan Feltner is expected to start for Albuquerque while Sammy Peralta is slated to take the hill for the Bees.

VS. SALT LAKE: The Isotopes have limited the Bees to three runs or fewer in six of 13 matchups this season, including three of the last four games.

ROAD WOES: Wednesday's victory was just the Isotopes' fifth in their last 22 road games, dating back to June 6 at El Paso ... Have not won series on the road since June 18-23, 2024, at Oklahoma City.

**HOMERS**: Braxton Fulford and Jose Torres went deep in the sixth Wednesday, Albuquerque's first inning with two home runs since July 4 vs. El Paso (Fulford/Bernabel).

**XBH**: Albuquerque has allowed two extra-base hits or fewer in four consecutive games, including exactly one in each of the last three contests.

**TOUGH STRETCH**: Since June 4, the Isotopes are 12-27 after the club won eight of 10 from May 23-June 3 ... The club has been outscored 278-223 during the time frame.

**LOB**: Over the club's last eight games, they have gone 14-for-77 with runners in scoring position and left 73 on-base.

MARGIN: The Isotopes claimed just their fourth win since May 30 with a three-plus run margin of victory (15 wins total in span; last: July 2 vs. El Paso, 18-5).

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson extended his modest hit streak to six games yesterday, going 9-for-24 during the stretch ... Is one of 13 players in the PCL with at least 20 doubles and 10 home runs this season ... Has a hit in 14 of his last 16 games ... T-1st in triples (7) in the PCL.

-Over his last 50 games, is slashing .330/.422/.597 with 15 doubles, six triples, eight homers and 32 RBI., increasing batting average from .178 to .276.

**KESTDADDY**: Keston Hiura went 0-for-5 Wednesday, failing to reach base for only the second time in his last 42 games with Albuquerque (other: July 3 vs. El Paso).

-During stretch, slashing .308/.402/.572 with 10 doubles, one triple, 10 homers and 30 RBI ... Has one homer in his last 16 gamss after hitting nine in previous 28 ... Has two XBH hits in July.

**SAM I AM**: Sam Hilliard went 1-for-2 yesterday with three walks and a homer and has reached base in 45 of 48 games played this year ... T-4th in triples (5)in the PCL.

-Connected on his 84th all-time home run in an Isotopes uniform, his first long ball in Utah since going deep in back-to-back games for Albuquerque on April 25-27, 2019 ... Drew three walks in a contest for the first time since Aug. 11, 2022 vs. St. Louis.

**BRAX**: Braxton Fulford has at least two hits in 12 of the last 32 Triple-A games in which he has started, dating back to April 4. Four of his 11 home runs have come against Salt Lake.

-Over last 10 Triple-A games (dating back to May 29), is 17-for-37 with two doubles, five homers and 12 RBI.

**THE KID:** Kyle Karros went 2-for-4 yesterday, his first multi-hit game at the Triple-A level and 19th of the season. Over his first five Triple-A games is 4-for-19 with four walks and five punchouts.

**REAL SLIM SCHUNKY**: Aaron Schunk doubled for his lone hit last night, and is slashing .339/.825 with three doubles, two triples, three homers and eight RBI in his last 15 contests ... Has at least one knock in 14 of the 15 games, with the only hitless night coming in one pinch-hit appearance.

VEEN, VEEN: Zac Veen went 1-for-4 Wednesday with an RBI double and walk ... Has a hit in 18 of his last 20 games and is slashing .405/.461/.633 with five doubles, two triples, three homers and 16 RBI.

-Over last 16 is slashing .431/.486/.646 with four doubles, two triples, two homers and 13 RBI

**NEW GUY:** Braiden Ward went 0-for-5 last night, ending his eight-game on-base streak to begin his first action at Triple-A ...

-Has 181 stolen bases since the beginning of the 2022 campaign, third-most in MiLB during the timeframe (Chandler Simpson, 225 and Jonatan Clase, 191).

IT'S DREW: Drew Romo is hitting .302 in July (13x43) after hitting .222 over first 22 contests ... Has 12 walks on the year (34 games) after drawing only 16 on 85 games last season.

JOSE, JOSE, JOSE: Jose Torres produced his third game with three or more hits in 2025 yesterday (also: June 5-6, when he was a combined 7-for-11 at Portland) ... Recorded multiple extrabase hits for the second time this season (other: June 6, three doubles).

## **NUCLEI NOTES**

**SKIPPER**: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

**AARON MUNOZ**: Takes over as Isotopes hitting coach after Jordan Pacheco was named one of two new hitting coaches for the Colorado Rockies on May 12 ... Began the 2025 season as the hitting coach for the ACL Rockies ... Spent nine seasons (2016-2024) as the Rockies bullpen catcher ... Was Isotopes bullpen catcher in 2015 ... Originally drafted by the Blue Jays in the 34th round of the MLB Draft ... Played parts of four seasons in the Minor Leagues (2011-14), making it to Double-A.

**SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT**: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

**BALLS AND STRIKES**: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.

## **QUICK HITS:**

- 7th professional season, all with the Rockies
- Finished the 2024 campaign with a 2.98 ERA (81.2 IP, 27 ER) through his last 15 starts ... since 2014, joined only Germán Márquez (2021, 2018), Kyle Freeland (2018) and Jon Gray (2017) as the only Rockies starters to have such a span.
- His 3.93 ERA (84.2 IP, 37 ER) in 15 road starts in 2024 was the lowest road ERA by a Rockies starter since Kyle Freeland (3.08) and Márquez (3.34) in 2022 (min. 15 GS).
- Logged 22 consecutive starts without a win in 2024, the longest single-season winless streak by a Major League starting pitcher (non-opener) since Shelby Miller had a 24-start streak in 2015 with Atlanta ... is the only Rockie starting pitcher in franchise history to go at least 18 starts without a win.
- Missed the majority of the 2023 season after suffering a fractured skull on May 13 after getting hit with a come-back line drive ... returned to a Major League mound 130 days later on Sept. 19.
- Through parts of four seasons with the Rockies (2021-24), has gone 9-24 with a 5.24 ERA (309.1 IP, 180 ER) through 62 games (61 starts).
- Named a MiLB Rockies Organizational All-Star in 2021.
- Made his Major League debut on Sept. 5, 2021 vs. Atlanta after his contract was selected from Double-A

Hartford ... became the first Rockies starter since Antonio Senzatela (2017) to skip Triple-A and go straight to the Majors.

 Tossed 1.2 frames and allowed six runs on four hits, one homer and four walks with two

 three-run dinger by Tristin English

- Finished campaign with 2.98 ERA (81.2 IP, 27 ER) through last 15 starts, the first Rockies starter with a sub-3.00 ERA through 15-start span since Márquez during his All-Star campaign in 2021
- Struck out a career-high 10 batters through six frames on April 6 vs. Tampa Bay, first Rockies pitcher to record at least nine strikeouts since Freeland (10) on Aug. 21, 2021 vs. Arizona
- On the 15-day injured list (strained right shoulder), Aug. 8-26.

#### 2023

- Exited his May 13 start vs. Philadelphia in the second inning following a come-backer off the bat
  of Nick Castellanos ... transferred to the 60-day injured list with a skull fracture, May 29.
- Made eight starts to begin the year before suffering the injury, going 2-3 (Rockies 5-3) with a 5.86 ERA (35.1 IP, 23 ER) across that span.
- Made his return to a Major League mound on Sept. 19 in San Diego ... spun five scoreless innings and allowed just two hits with two walks, one hit batter and five strikeouts.
- Made three rehab starts between High-A Spokane (one) and Triple-A Albuquerque (two), posting a combined 2.61 ERA (10.1 IP, 3 ER) with four walks and nine strikeouts.
- Saw his first live action since the injury on Sept. 1 vs. Everett, allowing one run on three hits over three innings with no walks and three strikeouts
