### RIDERS LATE PUSH NOT ENOUGH IN LOSS:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Midland RockHounds 8-5 from Momentum Bank Ballpark on Thursday night. Midland (23-13, 63-42) scored first on the night against Frisco (21-14, 65-39) starter **Mitch Bratt** (1-1) in the bottom of the first, putting up three runs. Jeisson Rosario delivered an RBI single before Eurielbe Angeles double home two runs to make it 3-0. In the third, the RockHounds extended the lead to 5-0 with two runs scoring on an error and a sacrifice fly. Bratt allowed five runs, four earned, on eight hits while striking out seven and not walking a batter over his six innings. The Riders found the scoreboard in the top of the eighth inning when **Cody Freeman** and **Max Acosta** hit back-to-back RBI doubles to pull within 5-2, but Midland answered with three runs in the bottom of the eighth inning to increase their lead to 8-2. Frisco then volleyed back with three runs in the top of the ninth on a two-run home run from **Daniel Mateo** and a **Josh Hatcher** RBI single, but fell short. Chen Zhuang (1-0) earned his first Double-A win, throwing five shutout innings for the RockHounds. Offensively, Osuna, Freeman, Hatcher and **Cooper Johnson** all had two-hit games, with Johnson collecting two doubles.

### START ME UP:

RoughRiders starting pitchers have been dominant over their last nine games, owning a 1.99 ERA (10ER/45.1IP). Overall, Frisco has allowed just 25 earned runs in their last nine games for a 2.88 ERA (78.0IP).

### CHICKS DIG THE LONG BALL:

The RoughRiders have hit 15 home runs over their last 15 games, tied for the fifth-most in the Texas League over the last two weeks. During that span, the Riders are third in the Texas League with a .741 OPS, second with a .260 batting average and are sixth with 4.1 runs per game. Holding them back, Frisco is just batting just .180 (23-for-128) with runners in scoring position over their last 15 games.

### READY TO ROCK(ER):

RoughRiders starting pitcher **Kumar Rocker** has been fantastic in his two starts with the RoughRiders since returning from his "Tommy John" surgery rehab this season. In the two starts, he has pitched seven shutout innings, allowing just two hits and one walk with eight strikeouts. Additionally, he has been incredibly efficient, averaging just 11.4 pitches per inning with the Riders. Rocker, who was selected by the Rangers as the No. 3 overall pick in the 2022 draft, is the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers organization and the No. 1 pitching prospect.

### HOME COOKING:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic at home this year, going 35-15 at Riders Field this season. Their 35 wins and .700 winning percentage at home are both first in Double-A and first among non-Triple-A teams in Minor League Baseball. At home this season, Frisco has a +74 run differential, a 3.73 ERA and is averaging 5.6 runs per game with a .761 OPS. On the road, Frisco is 30-25 with a 3.32 ERA, but a +18 run differential while averaging 3.9 runs per game and owning a .640 OPS (10th in the league). **Cody Freeman** is slashing .339/.398/.594/.992 at home this season with nine of his 13 home runs. His .339 batting average is the best in the Texas League by a player at their home stadium.

### OSUNA FROM THE RIDERS:

**Alejandro Osuna** has been incredible for Frisco since joining them from High-A Hickory. In 29 games, he is hitting .295 (33-for-112)/.389/.518/.907 with 12 doubles, two triples, three home runs and 17 RBIs. Over his last 26 games, he is batting .302 (30-for-99)/.407/.535/.942 with 10 doubles, two triples, three home runs and 17 RBIs. He has reached in 26 of his 29 games with the Riders. He set that career high in his final game in High-A this year, also hitting for the cycle in a 5-for-5 game.

### THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen is the second-best in the Texas League this season, owning a 3.15 ERA, which is also the fourth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. Overall, the Riders are on pace to have the second-best team ERA in franchise history (3.52), just behind 2014 (3.39). Additionally, their .229 BAA is on pace to tie the best in the franchise's history (.228 in 2021).

### WE'RE GOING DANCING:

The RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

### ABOUT KUMAR

-Pronounced "KA-mar", not "KOO-mar".

-Son of Tracy and Lalitha Rocker. Tracy played defensive tackle for Auburn in the 1980s. He was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame in 2004 and is the current defensive line coach for the Tennessee Titans. Uncle, David, was a DT for the Rams in the early 1990s as well.

-His name "Kumar" translates to "prince" or "young child" in Hindi as a nod to his mother's Indian heritage. Mother's parents emigrated from India to Maryland in 1965.

-Drafted originally by the Colorado Rockies in the 38th round of the 2018 draft after being named the Gatorade Georgia Baseball Player of the Year at North Oconee High School in Bogart, Georgia, but did not sign. Parents valued education and he chose to go to college.

-Played football for two years at North Oconee as well, but chose baseball.

-Broke out as a star at Vanderbilt University as a freshman in 2019, winning College World Series Most Outstanding Player for the Commodores' championship team, going 2-0 with a 1.46 ERA in the College World Series. Additionally named D1Baseball.com and Baseball America Freshman of the Year and The Tennessean 2019 Sportsperson of the Year after a 12-5 season with a 3.25 ERA over 22 games with 16 starts. In 99.2 innings, he struck out 114 with 21 walks.

-His freshman season was highlighted by a no-hitter against Duke in the Super Regional round. He walked just two while striking out 19 batters in the 131-pitch no-no.

-After a COVID-shortened 2020 season, he teamed up with former RoughRider and Ranger pitcher **Jack Leiter** once again to create one of the best 1-2 punches in college baseball history. In 2021, Rocker was a unanimous First Team All-American, leading the nation with 14 wins and 179 strikeouts over his 20 starts (122.0 innings) with a 2.73 ERA.

-Drafted by the Rangers in 2022 after year in Indy Ball. \*see 2022 season below\*

### 2024 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com. Ranked as the No. 3 prospect when he joined the RoughRiders on July 26th.

-Made Double-A debut on July 26th in front of 9,151 fans at Riders Field, striking out four in his first two innings and finishing with four strikeouts over his three innings, allowing just a two-out single in the first inning to Dodgers No. 1 prospect Dalton Rushing.

### 2023 SEASON

-Made Rangers MiLB debut with High-A Hickory, going 2-2 with a 3.86 ERA, striking out 42 over 28.0 innings to just seven walks. His 37.8 percent strikeout rate was tied for eighth among all MiLB players with at least six starts.

-Was removed from start on 5/17 with elbow discomfort and underwent "Tommy John" surgery (performed by Rangers team physician Dr. Keith Meister) on 5/22. He missed the remainder of the season.

### 2022 SEASON

-Drafted by the New York Mets in the 1st round of the 2021 draft (10th overall), but did not sign.

-Prior to being drafted by Rangers, played for Independent Tri-City Valley Cats, making five starts, going 1-0 with a 1.35 ERA with 35 strikeouts to four walks over 20 innings. Valley Cats (in Troy, NY) was managed by former Ranger Pete Incaviglia.

-Did not see action in Rangers system after 2022 draft.
