CARDINALS RIDE TWO-DUT MAGIC TO 7-3 WIN: The Cardinals scored all 7 runs and collected 9 of 11 hits with 2 outs as Springfield defeated the NW Arkansas Naturals 7-3 on Tuesday night at Arvest Ballpark for their third straight win. Jeremy Rivas went 2-for-4 with a two-run homer, while Bryan Torres, Lars Nootbaar and Chandler Redmond each tallied two-hit games. Wilfredo Pereira was stellar in relief of starter Cooper Hjerpe, firing 3.0 scoreless innings for his 4th win of the season. Springfield came out on top despite being outhit 12-11.



**DPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **William Fleming** makes his 7th start (10th appearance) of the season with the Naturals...Last pitched on Friday, June 28 at Wichita and allowed 4 ER on 5 H over 4.0 IP...Made 2 appearances against the Cardinals at Hammons Field last month and went 2-0 allowing 7 ER on 10 H with 6 K and 3 BB over 10.0 IP...Began the season with Triple-A Omaha and went 0-0 with a 5.14 ERA over 5 starts (21.0 IP)...Spent the 2023 season split between High-A Quad Cities and the Naturals going a combined 5-2 with a 4.11 ERA...In 10 starts with NW Arkansas went 2-0 with a 4.34 ERA.. Acquired by the Royals in June 2022 from the Mariners along with RIP Wyatt Mills in exchange for 1B Carlos Santana...Was pitching with Low-A Modesto at the time...After the trade was assigned to High-A Quad Cities and went 2-0 with a 5.14 ERA...Selected by the Mariners in the 11th round of the 2021 draft out of Wake Forest...Made 13 starts for the Deamon Deacons as a junior in 2021 and went 4-6 with a 6.03 ERA...Served as Wake Forest's closer in 2019 as a sophomore...Mother Amy was a world record holder and NCAA national champion swimmer at North Carolina...25 years old

**CARDINALS LOOK TO FLIP SCRIPT ON NATURLAS:** The Cardinals head to Springdale to start a split six-game series against the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (Double-A, Kansas City Royals). The Naturals have had the Cardinals' number in 2024, winning 10 of the 12 matchups between the two this season including each of the last eight.



#### **CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD**

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

#### **CARDS' RADIO HOME**



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

**NDDDDDDDT:** For the 2nd time during the 2024 season, Cardinals OF **Lars Nootbaar** is rehabbing with Springfield. He has been on the IL with St. Louis since May 31 with an oblique strain. **Nootbaar** appeared in one game for Springfield on April 9 rehabbing from fractured ribs, going 1-for-4 with an RBI and 2 runs scored before being activated by St. Louis on April 11. In 5 games with Triple-A Memphis at the start of the season, he went 3-for-17 with a 2B. **Nootbaar** is batting .234 with 5 HR and 19 RBI to go along with 7 2B and a .741 OPS in 39 big league games this season.

Four games into his current rehab stint with Springfield, **Nootbaar** is 4-for-14 with a double and a home run.

**RDAD WARRIDRS:** So far in 2024, the Cardinals have been the best team in the Texas League away from home. Springfield has a league-best 26-14 record on the road this season and have the 2nd-best road ERA at 3.56, just 0.07 behind Frisco and tops in the North Division. Remarkably, the 10 teams of the Texas League have combined to put together a winning road record at 195-189.

Home games for the Cards, however, have been a different story. Depite an 8-2 win over Arkansas in the series finale on Sunday, the Cardinals have dropped 11 of their last 13 and 22 of their last 29 games at Hammons Field. The Cards began the season winning their first 8 home games. Springfield's last consecutive wins at home came May 24-25 against the Tulsa Drillers. Overall the Cardinals have the 2nd-worst home record in the league at 15-22 and the highest home ERA at 5.90.

**GRINDIN':** Simply put, the Cardinals don't strike out very much. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 545 whiffs in 77 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (521 K in 77 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.08 K's per game. The Cardinals this week are up against the top strikeout staff in the Texas League; the Naturals average 10.1 K's per game.

**WALK THIS WAY:** In the month of June, the Cardinals drew 116 walks, tied with San Antonio most in the Texas League during the month. Springfield's OBP for June was a league-high .345, and also tops in the league for the season at .349. **Jacob Buchberger** led the Texas League with 21 BB in June (21 games).

**RUNNING WILD:** The Cardinals are 25-for their last-29 (86%) in stolen base attempts over their last 14 games. **Jeremy Rivas**, leads the Cards with 5 SB during that time, while **Mike Antico** and **RJ Yeager** each have swiped 4 bags. The Cardinals are 4th in the Texas League with 102 SB as a team, and **Rivas** leads the club with 20 SB. In the month of June, **Antico** finished 4th in the Texas League in steals, going a perfect 10-for-10, and has not been caught since May 15 (41 games). As a team, the Cardinals finished 3rd in the circuit with 37 bags, trailing only NW Arkansas (43 SB) and the Travelers (40 SB).

**RED-HOT RIVAS:** Cardinals shortstop **Jeremy Rivas** is enjoying a breakout campaign at the plate. Over his last 10 games, **Rivas** is batting .389 (14-for-36) with 3 2B, a home run, 5 RBIs and a .992 OPS. For the season, the Veneuzuelan product has produced career-best numbers with a . 304 batting average and a .749 OPS over his first 70 games, a drastic improvement over his 2023 with High-A Peoria during which he slashed .209/.293/.277. His triple-slash in 2024 at Double-A is .304/.383/.366.

**SEE YOU IN ARLINGTON:** Major League Baseball announced the AL and NL rosters for the 25th annual All-Star Futures Game, and two Cardinals pitchers were honored with a nod. **RHP Tink Hence** will be taking part in the event for the 2nd straight season, and **LHP Quinn Mathews** also received the honor in his first full season of professional baseball. The game will take place Saturday, July 13 at Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX.

## **REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY:** With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career

RBIs with 219.
Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 40 straight games without

a home run.
