### INDY BITS

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Ben Heller and Brent Honeywell fended off a comeback effort from the Louisville Bats to clinch the Indianapolis Indians' fourth consecutive win on Friday night at Victory Field, 7-6. The Indians leapt out to a 7-0 lead through the first two frames on key hitting by the top half of the batting order against Justus Sheffield. Liover Peguero plated the first two in the opening inning when, on the eighth pitch of his two-out, full-count at-bat, he lined a triple into the left-center alley. A five-run second inning followed, with five of the first six batters reaching base safely. Ji Hwan Bae plated one with a bases-loaded sacrifice fly and Alika Williams singled home another before Henry Davis highlighted the frame with a two-run two-bagger. After swiping third base, a throwing error by catcher Michael Troutwein allowed Davis to come home safely. The Bats didn't go quietly, scoring six unanswered runs to tighten Indy's lead to one run. Former Indian Erik González started the rally with an RBI double in the fourth inning and came around to score on a Jacob Hurtubise single. The two assisted the rally again in the sixth, with González scoring on a sacrifice bunt and subsequent throwing error by Connor Sadzeck. Hernán Pérez then launched a three-run homer in the seventh.

**GONE STREAKING:** Last night's 7-6 victory over the Bats marked Indianapolis' fourth-straight win, tying their season-high win streak set from April 4-6 (2) vs. Memphis. The Indians had a pair of season-long five-game winning streaks in 2023, from 4/6 (1)-9 at Louisville and 5/3 (2)-7 at Toledo. They now have a chance to record their second straight sweep of the Bats after taking both games of the rain-shortened series in Louisville on Monday and Tuesday of this week.

**WILLIAMS IS ROLLING:** Alika Williams led the Indians with his second consecutive three-hits game and has now reached base safely in 12 of his last 13 games since June 18 vs. Iowa. In that time, he is hitting .367 (18-for-49) with seven runs, three extra-base hits, seven RBI, seven walks and just six strikeouts. In that stretch, he has recorded all four of his season-high three-hit performances, including June 18 and June 23 vs. Iowa. Since June 18, he ranks eighth among International League leaders in batting average.

**PEGUERO POPS:** Liover Peguero began the game with a bang last night, roping at two-run triple in the first inning and a double in the second. He went 2-for-4 in the contest for his fifth two-hit performance in his past seven games since June 27 (2) at Rochester. He has hit safely in seven of his last eight games with a .375 batting average (12-for-32) with seven runs, six extra-base hits, and eight RBI.

**HENRY'S BACK:** Henry Davis had his rehab assignment transferred from Double-A Altoona to the Indianapolis Indians on Thursday and went 1-for-4 to extend his on-base streak with Indy to 17 games since May 17. In that time, he is hitting .339 (21-for-62) with 18 runs, seven doubles, six home runs and 15 RBI. After being recalled by Pittsburgh, the 24-year-old was placed on the 7-day injured list on June 15 with a concussion. Davis began his rehab assignment with Altoona on June 26 and went 0-for-6 with a run and two walks in a pair of games.

**BAE'S BACK:** Ji Hwan Bae logged his sixth multi-hit performance in his last 10 games since June 22 last night, going 2-for-4 with two runs and a triple last night. Thirteen of his 16 hits in that stretch have been singles, with his two doubles on Saturday and Tuesday driving in three total runs. Bae continues to own International League pitching not only this year, but in his career. In 38 games with the Indians this season, he is hitting .359 (52-for-145) with 30 runs, six doubles, two triples, four home runs and 18 RBI. In 155 games of his Triple-A career, he is hitting .309 (184-for-596) with 32 doubles, eight triples and 13 home runs.

**HELLERBALL:** Ben Heller stranded the game-tying runner on first base with one pitch in the seventh inning and put up another zero with two strikeouts in the eighth to shut down the Bats offense last night. The outing extended his impressive stretch of dominance in the International League out of the bullpen. He has not allowed a run across his last 11 outings (12.0ip) since May 21 at Iowa, recording a 0.67 WHIP and .077 batting average against (3-for-39). In addition, he hasn't allowed a hit across his last 7.1 innings (six appearances). His 11-game shutout streak is tied for the fifth-longest such streak in the IL and the second-longest active streak, trailing Charlotte's Sammy Peralta's 12 appearances starting on May 31.

**TONIGHT:** After taking the first two games of the rain-shortened five-game home-and-home series against Louisville, the Indians are looking to clinch a series victory in the three-game set at Victory Field in the series finale tonight at 7:05. Closing out the stretch for Indianapolis tonight is LHP Marco Gonzales (0-0, 3.00) in the second start of his rehab assignment, his first coming in his first career appearance vs. the Bats on Monday. Countering for Louisville will be RHP Julian Aguiar (0-0, 4.00) in his third career Triple-A start, all of which have come on the road.

**GONZO:** Southpaw Marco Gonzales is set to make his second start of his rehab assignment vs. Louisville this week. His stint with Indy began on Monday when he surrendered two runs (one earned) in 3.0 innings against the Bats. The 32-year-old was placed on the 15-day injured list on April 14 with a left forearm muscle strain and was later transferred to the 60-day IL. He began the season on Pittsburgh's Opening Day roster and recorded a 2.65 ERA (5er/17.0ip) and 11 strikeouts in three starts. Two of his first three outings were quality starts. Last night was Gonzales' first minor league start since 2017 with Triple-A Tacoma and Memphis. In 35 career Triple-A starts, he is 13-10 with a 3.99 ERA (88er/198.1ip) and 159 strikeouts.

**THIS DATE IN 2017:** The Indians recorded their largest margin of victory in the Victory Field era when they hammered Columbus at Huntington Park, 21-1. The Indians scored in seven of their nine trips to the plate and tied a Victory Field era record with seven home runs in the game, three coming during a nine-run ninth inning. Danny Ortiz had a game-high four hits and four RBI, and he smacked his sixth and seventh long balls of the season. Jacob Stallings reached base safely in all six of his plate appearances, going 3-for-3 with a home run, two doubles, four RBI and three walks.
