### JUMBO SHRIMP EDGE SOUNDS 5-4 IN 10 INNINGS

Connor Norby registered three hits and three RBIs on Thursday as Jacksonville nipped Nashville 5-4 in 10 innings. The Jumbo Shrimp grabbed an early lead in the first on Deyvison De Los Santos' RBI single. Norby added two with a base knock in the second. The Sounds got on the board on a two-run shot from Luis Lara in the third. A Norby RBI single put Jacksonville up 4-2 in the fourth. In the sixth, however, Nashville scored twice to tie the game at four. The score remained that way until the 10th, when Jacob Berry's sacrifice fly turned out to be the game-winning run.

### ACE UP THE SLEEVE

Jacksonville starting pitching has been nothing short of dominant of late. Over the club's last 16 games, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have combined to yield only 20 runs, 17 earned, on 54 hits (6.0 H/9) in 81.2 innings, recording an extraordinary 1.87 ERA. During this run, Jacksonville starters have combined for 107 strikeouts (11.8 K/9) against just 22 walks (2.4 BB/9). Not coincidentally, this starting pitching success has helped the Jumbo Shrimp go 13-3 over this stretch. On the season, Jacksonville starters lead Triple-A with a 3.76 ERA. Their 389.2 innings pitched trail only Tacoma for the most of any staff at the level.

### THE SOUNDS OF MUSIC

Jacksonville and Nashville split their first series of the season, continuing a theme between the two clubs. Since Jacksonville rejoined Triple-A in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp have played 89 games against the Sounds, with Jacksonville going 45-44 (.506) against Nashville. The Sounds have outscored the Jumbo Shrimp by a miniscule 426-415 (+11) margin over these 89 contests.

### ETZEL DAY? WELL, I LIKE ETZEL DAY

Matthew Etzel got off to a very slow start to the season, hitting just .183/.256/.254/.510 over his first 20 games of the season. Over the last 44 contests, however, the Texas native is a scorching 48-for-164 at the plate, slashing a robust .293/.402/.500/.902 with six doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 28 RBIs, 29 walks and 40 runs scored. Since this stretch began on May 3, Etzel ranks tied for second in the IL in runs, tied for 14th in walks, 15th in OBP, 17th in OPS, tied for 20th in hits and 24th in average.

### ONE DIRECTION

Jacksonville has won 11 of their last 14 one-run games, including each of their last five such decisions. The Jumbo Shrimp are now 16-7 (.696) in one-run games, the second-most such victories in Triple-A. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp earned 29 one-run victories, tied for the most one-run victories in MiLB. The 29 one-run triumphs were the most for a Jacksonville club since 2014, when the Jacksonville Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs.

### WHEN YOU'RE HOT, YOU'RE HOT

Jacksonville has won 12 of their last 14 games dating back to June 17, mainly behind a dominant pitching staff. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp hold massive leads Triple-A in ERA (2.81; next-closest: Sugar Land, 3.72), runs allowed (47; next-closest: Sugar Land, 60), hits allowed (87; next-closest: Durham and Gwinnett, 100) and BAA (.193; next-closest: Durham, .231), while ranking third in strikeouts (144). Jacksonville's 82 runs scored over the last 14 games ranks tied for 13th in Triple-A.

### MEN OF STEAL

The 2025 Jumbo Shrimp swiped 305 bases, blowing past the previous club record of 192 set by the 1979 Jacksonville Suns. The 2026 Jumbo Shrimp got off to a slower start in the steals department, with their 29 stolen bases through the season's first 24 games placing in a tie for 13th place in Triple-A. Since that point has been a completely different story; Jacksonville's 114 steals in the last 59 games are the second-most in Triple-A, trailing only Gwinnett (121).

### ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Jacksonville has racked up an impressive 24-15 (.615) record on the road this season - the 24 away victories rank in a tie for fourth in all of Triple-A. The biggest difference for the Jumbo Shrimp in their away contests has been their offense. At VyStar Ballpark, the club is hitting just .219/.330/.360/.690 with 190 runs scored (4.3 per game). Jacksonville is batting .260/.336/.422/.758 with 234 runs scored (6.0 per game) on the road.

### SHRIMP BITES

Only four of the 22 runs scored between the two teams this series have come with fewer than two outs.

### ABOUT JANSON

-Junk was originally selected by the New York Yankees in the 22nd round of the 2017 draft out of Seattle University.

-Junk began his career at Seattle University as a walk-on. He worked with Redhawks pitching coach Elliott Cribby, and during his three years, had improved his fastball velocity by more than 10 miles per hour.

-The Yankees traded Junk and fellow right-handed pitcher Elvis Peguero to the Los Angeles Angels on July 30, 2021, in exchange for left-hander Andrew Heaney. Junk made his major league debut for the Angels on September 5, 2021 with a start against the Texas Rangers.

-Junk earned his first major league win on July 27, 2022, when he tossed 5.0 scoreless innings in a start against the Kansas City Royals.

-On November 22, 2022, the Angels traded Junk, Peguero and left-handed pitcher Adam Seminaris to the Milwaukee Brewers for outfielder Hunter Renfroe.

-Junk remained in the Brewers' organization until he was claimed off waivers on August 2, 2024 by the Houston Astros. Twenty-nine days later, on August 29, Junk was claimed again, this time by the Oakland Athletics.

### 2026 SEASON

-Junk was placed on the injured list on May 31 with right shin inflammation.

### ABOUT KARSON

-A third-round pick by Miami in the 2022 draft, Milbrandt passed up a commitment to pitch at Vanderbilt University to sign with the Marlins.

-At the high school level, Milbrandt was named the Gatorade Missouri Baseball Player of the Year in 2022. He led Liberty High School (Mo.) to a 2021 Class 6 state title and to the 2022 Class 6 District 8 finals, where they fell to eventual state champion Liberty North.

-Milbrandt was also an excellent basketball in high school, receiving all-district honors.

### ABOUT PATRICK

-Monteverde is the youngest child from a massive family. He is the youngest of 27 grandchildren on his dad's side and the youngest of 18 grandchildren on his mom's side. Both of Monteverde's parents are the youngest of twelve.
