YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 3-1. Altoona scored the game's first run in the third inning after a pair of errors set up an RBI single by Joe Perez. In the sixth, Carter Bins gave the Curve a 2-0 lead with an RBI single. **Carter Howell** brought in Richmond's lone run with a solo homer in the bottom of the sixth inning. Yoyner Fajardo worked a pinch-hit, bases-loaded walk in the top of the eighth to extend Altoona's lead to 3-1. **Dylan Cumming** made his first Double-A start and allowed one unearned run over four innings. **Mat Olsen** pitched a scoreless fifth. **Ben Madison** allowed two runs but also struck out seven straight batters from the sixth through eighth innings. **Evan Gates** pitched 1.1 scoreless innings, lowering his season ERA to 1.42. Altoona starter Po-Yu Chen threw a career-high eight innings and struck out nine. Tyler Samaniego worked around a single for a scoreless ninth inning and closed out his first save of the season.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates, in the fifth of a six-game series at The Diamond. This series marks the first meetings between the two teams this year. The Curve return to Richmond for a six-game series from Aug. 20-25. The Flying Squirrels play two six-game sets in Altoona this year, the first from July 30-Aug. 4 and the last to close the regular season from Sept. 10-15.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 14-8 in their last 22 games, the second-best record in the league over that span, after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They had won five-of-six in two straight series, including at home against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond last week. They are 2-2 in this week's series against the Curve.

THE CURVE are in last place in the Southwest Division. They snapped a five-game losing streak with Thursday night's win and added another victory on Friday night. Altoona's roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Pirates prospects, including RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 3), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 4), RHP Thomas Harringston (No. 5), RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 6), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 8), OF/IB Jase Bowen (No. 19) and OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 26). There are seven Altoona players on Baseball America's top-30 Pirates prospects list, including Chandler (No. 3), Solometo (No. 5), Harrington (No. 6), Cheng (No. 7), Ashcraft (No. 10), Bowen (No. 26) and Gonzalez (No. 27).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Hayden Birdsong makes his 11th start of the season and the second of his career against the Curve. He last pitched last Sunday against Erie and allowed a season-high four runs over two innings. In his first start of the homestand last Tuesday, he threw a career-high six scoreless innings and struck out six against the SeaWolves. Birdsong made his Double-A debut on August 5, 2023 in Altoona and was charged with a loss after allowing four runs over 3.1 innings, striking out five. In the Eastern League (min. 40 IP), Birdsong ranks third in BAA (186), third in LOB% (84.4%), fourth in ERA (2.28), fourth in K/9 (11.42), fourth in K% (30.7%), sixth in BABIP (250) and eighth in K.BB% (19.6%). Last year, he climbed three levels in the Giants' system en route to being named a 2023 MiLB.com Organization All-Star in his first full professional season. For the season, he posted the second-highest K/9 (13.32) and strikeout percentage (34.9) in the minors (min. 100 IP). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and posted a 2.16 ERA in 12 outings (10 starts). He was leading the California League in strikeouts (70) when he got promoted to High-A Eugene in June. After going 2-2 with a 3.25 ERA in eight games (seven starts) for the Emeralds, he was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 5 for the remainder of the season. Birdsong was selected by the Giants out of Eastern Illinois University in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com entering the 2024 season. For more on Birdsong, see page two.

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Sean Sullivan makes his 10th start of the year and his third career start against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, he allowed five runs (two earned) over 3.1 innings in a loss against the Sea Dogs on Sunday. Over his previous four outings (three starts), he went 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA (3 ER/19.0 IP), including back-to-back scoreless starts on May 16 at Akron (seven innings) and May 22 at Erie (six innings). He faced Richmond twice last year. On May 4, 2023 at The Diamond, he worked four innings and allowed three runs in a no-decision. At PNG Field on August 3, 2023, he picked up a win with five scoreless innings in a combined shutout. Sullivan was selected in the eighth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Cal. After spending his pro debut season with High-A Greensboro in 2022, he spent the entire season with Altoona last year, going 8-4 with a 3.88 ERA in 24 outings (21 starts).

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked fourth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (7,024).

TAKE IT FOR GRANTED: In his last 22 games since May 15, **Grant McCray** is batting .329 (24-for-73) with two homers, nine doubles, three triples, nine walks, 10 RBIs and 15 runs scored, raising his season batting average from .135 to .215. McCray is tied for third in the Eastern League in triples (3), tied for third in doubles (14) and fifth in extra-base hits (23). Last Monday, he was named Eastern League Player of the Week after he hit .550 (11-for-20) with a homer, three doubles, two triples, four walks, eight runs scored and five RBIs for the previous weeks' series in Bowie. Prior to going 0-for-1 on Friday night, McCray had reached base in 14 consecutive games dating back to May 12, which was tied for the third longest active streak in the Eastern League and is the longest by a Flying Squirrels player so far this season.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Andy Thomas is batting .339 (20-for-59) over his last 18 games since May 15 with two homers, five doubles, a triple and 15 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .252. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. On Wednesday night, Thomas came off the bench and hit an RBI triple in the eighth inning for an insurance run, the second triple of his professional career. On Thursday, he hit his second homer of the season. He added two hits on Friday.

OPEN THE GATES: This season, **Evan Gates** has posted a 1.42 ERA (5 ER/31.2 IP), which is the lowest in the Eastern League (min. 30 IP). Gates posted a 0.86 ERA (2 ER/21.0 IP) over his first 12 appearances of the season through May 18. After allowing four runs (three earned) in his two outings last week against the Baysox, he pitched 3.1 scoreless innings on Friday against the SeaWolves, the longest outing of his career, and struck out four batters. In that appearance, he issued a walk to the first batter he faced before retiring the next 10 batters in order to finish his night. Gates followed with a six-out save against the Curve in a combined shutout on Tuesday night. Since joining the Flying Squirrels in 2022, Gates has pitched 66 Double-A games, combining for a 3.28 ERA (35 ER/96.0 IP).

SETTING THE TABLE: Over his last seven games since May 31, **Carter Howell** is batting .379 (11-for-29) with a homer, two doubles, a triple, two walks, three RBIs and three runs scored. He has picked up two hits in four of those seven games. In his 22 games batting first in the Flying Squirrels' lineup this year, Howell is batting .303 (27-for-89). He is also batting .340 (16-for-35) when leading off an inning. This season, he is batting .440 (11-for-25) in the first inning.

BLANK SPACE: Three of the Flying Squirrels' last four wins have been shutouts. They shut out the SeaWolves twice last week. Last Tuesday, **Hayden Birdsong** covered six scoreless innings before **Nick Swiney** and **Tyler Myrick** worked the final three in a 5-0 win. On Friday night, **Matt Frisbee** started and pitched 4.2 innings before being replaced by **Evan Gates**, who worked a career-high 3.1 innings. **Myrick** threw a scoreless ninth to close his fourth save of the year. On Tuesday to begin this series, **John Michael Bertrand** pitched six innings, **Mat Olsen** worked a scoreless seventh and Gates retired the final six outs in a 1-0 win over the Curve. The Flying Squirrels' seven shutout wins this season are tied for second-most in the Eastern League with Harrisburg, trailing only Akron with eight.

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).
