LAST NIGHT: The Skeeters opened their road trip Thursday night with an 8-1 loss to the Oklahoma City Dodgers. Jose Siri put the Skeeters out in front with an RBI double in the first inning but the Dodgers went on to score eight unanswered runs. Right-hander Chad Donato took the loss in his Skeeters debut.

MARTES: Prior to Friday's game, RHP Francis Martes was assigned to the Skeeters in preparation from being activated from suspension. He's eligible to be reinstated on June 19. Martes last pitched in the Astros system in 2019 with the GCL Astros and Quad Cities (A). Along with this year's Spring Training, Martes also appeared with Escogido of the Dominican Winter League this offseason. Martes went 5-2 with a 5.80 ERA (35 ER/54.1 IP) in 32 games (four starts) with the Astros in '17. Prior to the '17 season, Martes was rated as the No. 15 overall prospect in baseball by Baseball America.

ROSTER MOVE: Prior to Thursday's game, IF Colton Shaver was assigned to the Skeeters from Corpus Christi (AA). Shaver began the season with the Skeeters and went 0x4 through one game. He has hit .118 (4x34) with a home run and RBI in 11 games with the Hooks.

MiLB HONORS: RHP Brett Conine was named the Triple A West Pitcher of the Month for May by Minor League Baseball. Conine has gone 4-0 with a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19 IP) through four games (three starts). He's recorded the lowest ERA in Triple A West and leads the league in wins, opponent batting average (.167) and WHIP (0.95).

PLAYER OF THE MONTH: Jose Siri was named the Skeeters May Player of the Month prior to Tuesday's game. He finished the month hitting .354 (29x82) with five home runs and 31 RBIs. He leads all of Minor League Baseball with 31 RBIs. He's also tied for third in Triple A West with 13 extra-base hits and tied for second with eight doubles.

OH SO SWEET: The Skeeters lead MiLB with a .297 team average. The next closest team (Reno, AAA) is hitting .289. The Skeeters' 3.01 ERA is the sixth-lowest in MiLB and is the second-lowest of Triple A teams.

ARE YOU 'SIRI'OUS: OF Jose Siri leads Triple A and is second in MiLB with 32 RBIs this season. He's also hit two grand slams and is one of six players in MiLB to have already hit two grand slams this season.

STREAKING: The Skeeters had their four-game winning streak snapped Thursday but have still won 10 of their last 12 games. The Skeeters .708 winning percentage is tied for fifth-best in MiLB.

HEADED TO BRICKTOWN: The Skeeters are making their first-ever trip to Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark. The Oklahoma City Dodgers and Skeeters are set to play each other 24 times this season. Oklahoma City visits Constellation Field for the first time from June 24-29.

CRUZIN': Bryan De La Cruz is ninth in Triple A West in average (.348), tied for fourth in hits (32) and tied for fifth in runs (20). De La Cruz went on a 15-game hitting streak from May 7-28. It stands as the second-longest hitting streak from a Triple A player this season.

RONNIE SALAMI: Ronnie Dawson hit the Skeeters' third grand slam of the season on 5/30 vs. ABQ. The Skeeters are tied for second in Minor League Baseball with three grand slams.

GEAUX PAPPY: Michael Papierski ranks fourth in Triple A West with a .457 on-base percentage. The LSU alum had two RBI triples during the last homestand and is tied for second in Triple A West with two triples. He's reached safely in 15 of his 18 appearances this season.

WALK THIS WAY: Ronnie Dawson leads Triple A West with 23 walks this season. He ranks fifth in the league in on-base percentage (.455). He's tied for ninth in the league in runs (19).

CLOSE TO HOME: Based on approximate mileage, the Skeeters are located second-closest to the stadium of their parent club out of Triple A teams. The St. Paul Saints are located approximately 11 miles from Minnesota's Target Field.

MAJOR TALENT: The Skeeters roster features eight players with Major League service time: RHP **Brandon Bielak**, OF **Ronnie Dawson**, IF **Alex De Goti**, RHP **Ryan Eades**, RHP **Ralph Garza Jr.**, RHP **Tyler Ivey**, RHP Francis Martes, IF **Yadiel Rivera**, RHP **Nivaldo Rodriguez**, RHP **Andre Scrubb**, RHP **Peter Solomon**, IF **Abraham Toro**, RHP **Hector Velazquez**. All but Eades, Rivera and Velazquez have appeared at the Majors with the Astros.

PROSPECT POWER: The Skeeters have nine players ranked as Astros top-30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline): RHP **Tyler Ivey** (No. 9), RHP **Shawn Dubin** (No. 11), RHP **Peter Solomon** (No. 13), RHP **Jojanse Torres** (No. 18), RHP **Brett Conine** (No. 21), RHP **Austin Hansen** (No. 22), RHP **Nivaldo Rodriguez**, (No. 24), OF **Ronnie Dawson** (No. 27).

PUT IT ON THE MANTEL: **Ronnie Dawson**, **Alex De Goti** and **Peter Solomon** each made their Major League debuts with the Astros this season. Dawson went 1x5 with a run through 3 G, De Goti went 2x6 with a run and RBI through 6 G and Solomon tossed a scoreless 2 IP in relief, allowing just one hit and striking out two. **Ralph Garza Jr.** received his first promotion to the Major Leagues on May 26. He made his Major League debut on May 29 vs. San Diego and threw an inning of relief.

FRANCHISE RECORD: Jose Siri drove in seven runs on May 13 at Round Rock, setting the Skeeters franchise record, including their nine seasons as an independent franchise. Siri accomplished the feat with a grand slam and three-run double. Five players in Skeeters history had recorded six RBIs in a single game. The seven RBIs are tied for the second-most in a game this season of Triple A players.

HOMESTAND: The Skeeters played their first homestand at Constellation Field as a Triple A team from May 20-June 1 and went 10-1 while playing El Paso and Albuquerque. The Skeeters outscored El Paso and Albuquerque 56-20 throughout the homestand. The Skeeters' 10-1 home record is the best in Triple A West.

MLB REHAB ASSIGNMENTS: Astros starters **Framber Valdez** and **Jake Odorizzi** made MLB Rehab assignment starts for the Skeeters on May 22 and 23, respectively, against El Paso. It was the second rehab start for each pitcher. The duo combined for 8 2/3 scoreless innings, striking out a combined nine batters. Valdez and Odorizzi are both back on the Astros' 26-man active roster.

NOW HERE'S A STOREY: **Mickey Storey** is entering his third year as the manager of the Astros Triple A affiliate. He led Round Rock to the best record in Triple A in 2019 (84-56) and to the Pacific Coast League Finals. Storey got his first managerial job in the Astros system in 2018 with Class A Quad Cities, winning the Western Division of the Midwest League. Storey appeared at the MLB level with the Astros in 2012 and the Blue Jays in 2013 as a right-handed pitcher. He still holds numerous career pitching records for Florida Atlantic University. He finished his career second all-time in strikeouts, tied for second in wins and finished top 10 in strikeouts per nine innings, games started, fewest walks per nine innings and innings pitched. REST OF THE CREW: Joining Mickey Storey on his staff are pitching coach **Erick Abreu**, hitting coach **Ben Rosenthal** and development coach **Sean Connoles**. **John Gregorich** and **A.J. Smith** are the Skeeters' athletic trainers and **Hazael Wessin** is the team's strength and conditioning coach. Abreu is in his eighth season with the Astros organization and his first as the organization's Triple A pitching coach. Rosenthal is in his fifth season with the Astros and third as the hitting coach for their Triple A affiliate. Connoles is in his second season with the Astros and his first as the development coach for the team's Triple A affiliate.

A LITTLE ABOUT US: Through their first nine seasons, the Skeeters played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the post-season in five of nine seasons. The Skeeters still hold the Atlantic League single-season record for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from their '13 season. The Skeeters have been managed by former Major Leaguers **Gary Gaetti** (2012-17) and **Pete Incaviglia** (2018-20). As an independent team, the Skeeters went 601-502. Notable people to appear for the Skeeters include: LHP **Scott Kazmir**, RHP **Roger Clemens**, IF **Rafael Palmeiro**, **Tracy McGrady**, IF **James Loney**, C **Derek Norris**, OF **Willy Taveras** and RHP **Felipe Paulino**.

OPENING DAY NOD: Torres got the start for the Skeeters' first-ever home Triple A game on May 20 vs. El Paso. He took a no-decision, allowing one run over four innings and striking out five. It was Torres' first start of the season and first of his career at the Triple A level.

RING 'EM UP: Over his last 12 1/3 innings pitched, Torres has struck out 16 batters.

MR. VERSATILE: Has made 22 appearances as a reliever and 20 appearances as a starter in his professional career. He's gone 7-0 with a 1.28 ERA as a starter and 6-3 with a 3.20 ERA as a reliever.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE: Torres did not appear in a game in the pandemic-shortened 2020 season. He's making his first start since August 30, 2019, while with Fayetteville (A+).

SPRING TRAINING: Appeared in his first Major League Spring Training this season. Made two relief appearances (3 ER/1.1 IP)

PROSPECT CREDENTIALS: Rated as the Astros No. 18 overall prospect per MLB Pipeline.

WHAT A YEAR: Led Astros minor leaguers in 2019 with 12 wins and was the only Astros minor leaguer to record at least five wins without a losing decision. Posted the second-lowest ERA (1.71) of any Astros minor leaguer with at least 60 innings pitched.
