HOME SWEET HOME: After splitting last week's road series in Lynchburg and dropping the series opener last night, the FredNats will try to bounce back against the Fayetteville Woodpeckers in the first Education Day of the year. RHP Bryan Sanchez makes his second start of the year today in front of a crowd that is mostly local school kids. In a scheduling quirk, this is Fayetteville's first-ever trip to Fredericksburg since VACU Stadium opened in 2021. Fredericksburg has only traveled to Fayetteville the last two seasons, but this week marks the only meeting in the 2024 regular season for the two clubs that share the spring training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. The Woodpeckers are the final team to visit Fredericksburg, meaning all 11 of the other current Carolina League clubs have now played in this ballpark.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: It was a pitcher's duel the entire night, and Fayetteville took a no-hitter into the 5th inning. James Hicks and Raimy Rodriguez combined to pitch the first shutout of the year for the Woodpeckers and the first time the Freddie's have been shut out this season. Liam Sullivan pitched excellent, going five shutout innings with eight strikeouts. Moises Diaz and Bubba Hall also had scoreless outings, but Kenni Gomez's 8th inning leadoff home run was the difference in the ballgame last night.

STRONG STARTS: The FredNats have several hitters near the top of the Carolina League leaderboards through the first nine games of the season. Brandon Pimentel leads the league in RBI (14), XBH (6), and is second in slugging (.618), and total bases (21). Gavin Dugas leads the league in doubles (5), and is 2nd in batting average (.407), 4th in OBP (.500) and 5th in OPS (1.093). Phillip Glasser is 4th in average (.393), and tied for third in hits with 11. Elijah Green is the league leader runs scored with 11.

PROSPECTS IN THE 'BURG: Three of the Nationals' Top-30 prospects are beginning the season with Fredericksburg. All three spent time with the FredNats in 2023, and all three of those prospects are ranked in the Top-10 in the system. Elijah Green is ranked as the 6th-best prospect in the system according to MLB Pipeline, Cristhian Vaquero is the 9th-best, and Jarlin Susana is the 10th ranked prospect. All three are also in the Top-10 in the Baseball America prospect rankings.

ANOTHER TO THE SHOW: Monday night, 2021 FredNat Mitchell Parker became the sixth FredNat to make his Major League debut since the team moved to FXBG in 2020. Parker got the win for the Nats on the mound against the powerful Los Angeles Dodgers last night, pitching five innings of two-run ball with four strikeouts. He joins Amos Willingham ('21), Jackson Rutledge ('21 & '22), Jose A. Ferrer ('22), Jacob Young ('22) and Trey Lipscomb ('22) as former FredNats to debut in Major Leagues. All made their debuts with Washington.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 147-124 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with ZSP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Bryan Sanchez is making his second start of the 2024 season tonight for the Fredericksburg Nationals. Signed by Washington out of the Dominican Republic in 2018, Sanchez got his first taste of professional baseball in the Dominican Summer League in 2019.

After missing 2021, Sanchez came stateside for the first time in 2022, and impressed in the GCL with a 3.79 ERA across nine appearances (eight starts).

That earned him a spot on the Opening Day roster for the FredNats last season, where he split time evenly between starting and coming out of the bullpen. Bryan began the year as a reliever, with six appearances from April into early May. But after some reshuffling, Sanchez moved into the starting rotation. He excelled in that role, allowing one run or fewer in four of his six starts before ultimately being shelved for the year due to injury in mid-June.

LAST TIME OUT: Bryan made his first start of 2024 against the Lynchburg Hillcats last week, and battled through 2.1 innings. He gave up a pair of base hits and three walks, which turned into a pair of earned runs as he exited with one out in the third inning.

AGAINST FAYETTEVILLE: Sanchez made a pair of appearances against the Woodpeckers last season. The righty totaled 5.2 innings of work, giving up three earned runs and fanning six.
