DES MOINES, IOWA – The Storm Chasers used a six-run sixth inning to pull ahead of the Cubs Friday night for a 7-4 victory and the team's third straight win at Principal Park.

The first half of the game was as good of a pitcher's duel as Omaha has been involved in this season ... Storm Chasers starter **Luis Cessa** held Iowa to a first inning run on four hits with five strikeouts over a season-long 5.0 innings ... for the third straight start, Cessa did not walk a batter, facing one over the minimum after his second batter of the game.

Omaha could only muster a run in the second inning off Iowa starter **Thomas Pannone**, as **Tyler Gentry** singled, moved to third on an errant pickoff throw and scored on a sacrifice fly off the bat of **Cam Devanney**.

Facing Pannone a third time through, the Storm Chasers lineup came alive in the top of the 6th inning, knocking the left-hander out with a **Logan Porter** double and **Nick Pratto** single ... Iowa needed three pitchers to get through the 6th inning, as **Devin Mann** singled in Porter for the lead, **Cam Devanney** singled in Pratto and Mann, then **Drew Waters** connected on a three-run homer off former Chaser **Jose Cuevas** to cap the six-run inning for a 7-1 Omaha lead.

Behind Cessa, it took six pitchers to piece the final 4.0 innings together in the win over Iowa ... **Carlos Hernández** got the first two outs of the bottom of the sixth inning and was charged with a run, a runner inherited by **Dan Altavilla**, who finished the sixth with a strikeout.

John McMillon walked a pair in the bottom of the 7th inning and allowed another Cubs run to score on a balk with a runner on third, at the time moving the score to 7-3 in favor of Omaha.

Jonah Dipoto worked around a walk and error for a scoreless bottom of the 8th inning, then **Jake Brentz** was tasked with recording the last three outs in the bottom of the 9th inning but walked three batters to load the bases and bring the winning run to the plate, prompting **Will Klein** to enter.

Klein allowed one of the three runners he inherited from Brentz to score, but the right-hander worked out of trouble otherwise to earn his 4th save of the season.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 166 to 131 this season, a +35 run differential.

- +35 run differential ranks as the 2nd-best in the International League and is 5th in Triple-A ... Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (NYY) leads Triple-A at a +49 run differential.

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.

- The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a .204 average (98-for-481), which is the 2nd-best mark among Triple-A teams.
- Will Klein** was called up last Thursday by the Royals and made his MLB debut Sunday ... he has opened the year with 13.0 innings without allowing an earned run ... he's thrown the most innings of any IL pitcher to not allow an ER this year.
- Walter Pennington** leads the bullpen with a 8.1-inning scoreless streak currently over his last 6 games since April 16 ... with 27 strikeouts to 3 walks, his 9.00 K/BB ranks 3rd among Triple-A pitchers (min. 15.0 IP) ... a 37.0% strikeout rate (27 K in 73 TBF) is 5th in Triple-A (min. 15.0 IP).
- Dan Altavilla** and **Will Klein** have both recorded four consecutive scoreless games ... **Evan Sisk** has three straight with 8 strikeouts in his last 3.2 innings (11 outs).
- John McMillon**'s slider has a 47.8 whiff % (11 whiffs on 23 swings), the best whiff% of any individual pitch on Omaha's staff (min. 50 pitches thrown with a pitch).

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

Infielder **CJ Alexander** has been one of Omaha's top hitters early in the season, leading the team in many categories.

- Alexander has 7 of Omaha's 10 hardest-hit balls this season, including the 2 hardest ... he had a 110.4MPH double in Game 1 of Wednesday's doubleheader, Omaha's hardest-hit ball this year ... he ranks 2nd in Triple-A with 32 batted balls at or over 100MPH.
- CJ leads Omaha in hits (30), doubles (9), triples (2), homers (6), extra-base hits (17), total bases (61), runs batted in (19) and runs scored (23) ... he is 7th in the International League in slugging (.616), 4th in extra-base hits and tied 7th in total bases.

THE MANN OF THE HOUR

Devin Mann sneakily might be the hottest hitter on the Storm Chasers right now.

- Mann has reached in 16 consecutive games, the longest on-base streak for an Omaha hitter this year, the 2nd-longest active streak in the league ... since April 4, he is hitting .333 (19-for-57) with a .994 OPS ... he has hits in 12 of 16 games in this stretch.
- Mann has reached base in 17 of 19 games with Omaha (89%), after reaching base in 31 of 37 games last year with Omaha (84%).

KICKSTART MY GAME

Luis Cessa finished 5.0 innings for the first time last season, something that is key to Omaha's success.

- The Storm Chasers are 9-2 in games where the Starting pitcher goes at least 5.0 innings this season, 8-9 in games where the starter goes less than 5.0
- When Omaha's starter gets 3+ runs of support, the team is 10-3, compared to 7-8 with less than 3 runs of support.

- ✦ **Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 19 Royals prospect.**

Recalled by Kansas City on Monday April 29th to make a start for the Royals against the Blue Jays in Toronto, his first Major League stint in 2024 ... all four runs he allowed over 2.2 innings came on home runs, including two to **Justin Turner**: a two-run shot in the top of the 1st and a solo home from Turner to open the 3rd ... worked around a single in the 2nd, but after allowing a homer to Turner, surrendered a solo home run to **Danny Jansen** two batters later ... got the 2nd out of the 3rd inning but put two more runners on and was relieved.

2024 HIGHLIGHT

- ✦ Appeared in 2 Cactus League games (0 starts) and went 2-0 with a 5.40 ERA (2 ER in 3.1 IP), with 2 strikeouts.
- ✦ Threw 2 quality starts vs. Gwinnett, on April 9 and 14 ... combined to allow 3 ER on 10 H and 0 BB over 12.0 IP with 13 K.

- ✦ After opening the year at NW Arkansas (AA), Bowlan earned a promotion to Omaha on June 20 and made 14 appearances (12 starts) for the Storm Chasers, before earning his first big league call-up on September 19.
 - ✦ Having not pitched into the 6th inning in over two years, did so in five of his final seven outings with Omaha ... three of his last four starts with the Chasers were quality starts - 8/30 vs. LOU (6.0 IP, 1 ER), 9/5 @ IOW (6.0 IP, 2 ER) & 9/16 vs. IND (6.0 IP, 2 ER).
