YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Curve, 4-2. Altoona broke a 2-2 tie with a go-ahead single by Domingo Lebya in the top of the ninth inning. Matt Gorski added a run with a sacrifice fly. Tyler Samaniego closed out the game with a scoreless bottom of the ninth. The Curve opened the scoring in the first with a two-run single by Leyba. **Hayden Cantrelle** cut the lead in half with a solo homer, his first of the year, in the bottom of the second. Cantrelle tied the game with an RBI groundout in the sixth. Reliever **Wil Jensen** threw four scoreless innings and allowed two hits.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game series against the Altoona Curve, Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates. Today marks the sixth of 18 games between the Flying Squirrels and Curve this season. Altoona will return to The Diamond for a six-game series from June 6-11. The Flying Squirrels will head to Peoples Natural Gas Field in Altoona for a six-game series from August 1-6. The Flying Squirrels are 12-10 this year against opponents from the Southwest Division, 6-3 in games following a loss and 3-3 in day games, including a 2-1 mark in day games at The Diamond.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are in first place in the division, 2.5 games ahead of Altoona, and have dropped three-of-five this week after taking four-of-five in Bowie last week. After starting the season 4-0 for the first time in team history. The Flying Squirrels offense is tied for the Eastern League lead in runs scored (10) and tied for second in OBP (.339). The Richmond pitching staff is second in the league in ERA (3.17) and strikeouts (251).

THE CURVE are in second place in the division, 1.5 games behind the Flying Squirrels. Altoona has won 10-of-its-last-15 games and five-of-its-last-eight. The Curve roster includes five of Baseball America's Top-30 Pirates Prospects: C Henry Davis (No. 3), INF Liover Peguera (No. 7), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11), OF Matt Gorski (No. 16 + best power hitter + best outfield arm) and INF Andres Alvarez (No. 30). Nick Dombkowski is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Pirates organization and Lolo Sanchez is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. The Altoona roster also includes five of MLB.com's Top-30 Pirates Prospects, including Davis (No. 3), Peguero (No. 6), Gorski (No. 17), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 20) and Frazier (No. 23).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Carson Seymour** takes the mound for his sixth Double-A start. He started the series-opener on Tuesday night and allowed one run over 3.1 innings. A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 1.19 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 17 by MLB.com. **For more on Seymour, see page two.**

FOR ALTOONA: Right-hander Kyle Nicolas makes his sixth start of the season. Last time out, he allowed five runs, all earned, over five innings with a season-high 10 strikeouts in a loss to open the series on Tuesday night. Nicolas was selected with the 61st pick in the 2020 MLB Draft by the Miami Marlins out of Ball State. He first reached Double-A with Pensacola in his pro debut season in 2021. In November 2021, Nicolas was traded to the Pirates along with RHP Zach Thompson and OF Connor Scott for C Jacob Stallings. Last season, Nicolas made 24 appearances (22 starts) for the Curve, going 2-4 with a 3.97 ERA. He has made five starts against the Flying Squirrels, all no-decisions, combining for a 3.71 ERA (7 ER/17.0 IP) with 24 strikeouts. Nicolas is rated by MLB.com as the No. 20 Pirates prospect.

PACKING THE HOUSE: On the year, the Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (83,724) and average attendance (6,440). They're also ranked eighth overall of the 120 teams in the minors in average attendance. In 2022, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in average (6,160) and total (406,560) attendance for the first time in franchise history.

THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY: Richmond's relievers have combined for a 2.34 ERA (33 ER/126.1 IP), which is the lowest in the Eastern League. The Flying Squirrels bullpen also leads the Eastern League in strikeouts (147) and is second in innings pitched (126.2). Richmond relievers are 9-for-11 in save opportunities (81.8%), the highest save conversion rate in the league. **Raymond Burgos** and **Blake Rivera** have both pitched eight games without allowing an earned run, tied for the longest streak in the league.

RISPY BUSINESS: For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .284 (65-for-229) with runners in scoring position, which leads the Eastern League. Richmond also has the second-best batting average in the league with runners in scoring position and two outs at .274 (29-for-106). With runners on base, the Flying Squirrels are leading the EL with a .285 average (107-for-375). The Flying Squirrels have scored four-or-more runs in a single inning 10 times this year. In this week's series, Richmond has been held to 6-for-41 (.146) with runners in scoring position, including .087 (2-for-23) over the last three games since Thursday.

LUCY, I'M HOME: Shortstop **Marco Luciano** was activated with the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday and made his official Double-A debut on Wednesday night. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. On Thursday night, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit. He has worked a walk in each of his four games for the Flying Squirrels.

HEY HEY HADYEN: After going 0-for-10 to open the series, **Hayden Cantrelle** hit his first Richmond homer in the second inning on Saturday night. He added a double and an RBI groundout in the game. After going hitless in his first two games of the season, Cantrelle batted .319 (15-for-47, 4 2B, 3B, 8 RBI, 11 R) over a 14-game span from April 12-29 heading into this series. Cantrelle scored a run in eight straight games from April 12-20, the longest streak in the league this year.

FULL MUNGUIA: After going 0-for-15 over a three-game stretch from April 23-26, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .375 (12-for-32) with a homer, three doubles and five RBIs over his last eight games, including five two-hit games. He kicked off the stretch in last Thursday's game in Bowie with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. In the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, he tied his season high with three RBIs. Munguia is tied for sixth in the league in hits (27) and tied for fourth in runs scored (18). For the year, he is batting .391 (9-for-23) in the first inning.

MATOS MANIA: **Luis Matos** reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games, the longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. He has reached base in five-of-his-six games since then and in 22-of-24 games overall this season. For the year, Matos has struck out just 10 times in 101 plate appearances (0.99 percent), the third-lowest rate in the league.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Tyler Fitzgerald** is ranked fifth in batting average (.324), sixth in OBP (.410), fifth in SLG (.588), fifth in OPS (.998), tied for sixth in doubles (6), first in triples (3), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (11) and tied for 10th in runs scored (15). **Ismael Munguia** tied for sixth in hits (27) and tied for fourth in runs scored (18). **Riley Mahan** is tied for eighth in homers (4) and tied for seventh in RBIs (16). **Andy Thomas** is tied for sixth in walks (18). **Luis Matos** is tied for eighth in runs scored (16). **Kai-Wei Teng** is sixth in strikeouts (32). **Juan Sanchez** and **Nick Swiney** are tied for second in wins (3). **Evan Gates** is tied for sixth in saves (3).

WHERE THE CURVE RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Domingo Leyba is third in batting average (.325), tied for fifth in RBIs (17) and tied or ninth in hits (25). Henry Davis is third in homers (6), first in OBP (.446), fourth in SLG (.611), first in OPS (1.057) and seventh in total bases (44). Mason Martin is second in OBP (.443), tied for eighth in SLG (.500), sixth in OPS (.943) and tied for sixth in walks (18). Liover Peguera is tied for sixth in runs scored (17).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 1, No. 30 overall), **Luis Matos** (No. 5), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Landen Roupp** (No. 13), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Nick Swiney** (No. 24) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter and Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).

THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2011, the Flying Squirrels beat the Altoona Curve, 5-0. Eric Surkamp recorded double-figure strikeouts for the third straight start, a franchise record that still stands today. It was the fourth 10-strikeout start of the year. Surkamp finished the season with eight outings with 10-or-more strikeouts. No one else in franchise history has more than three in their career.
