HOOKS DROP RIDERS WITH HOMER BARRAGE:

For the second time in as many nights, the Frisco RoughRiders took an early lead, but the Corpus Christi Hooks came from behind, using a barrage of homers to win 8-3 on Friday night from Whataburger Field. The Ridérs (24-30) fired away in the first inning right away when Luisangel Acuña doubled on the first pitch and came in on a **Dustin Harris** RBI double to make it 1-0 against Julio Robaina (5-3). Frisco made it 2-0 when **Kellen Strahm** scored on a double play in the second. Strahm went 2-for-3 with a walk and a double on the night and was the only Riders player with multiple hits. The Hooks (27-28) tied the game in the bottom of the second with a two-run J.C. Correa home run. They then took the lead in the fifth with Luis Avilas Jr.'s first of two home runs on the night, this one off of **Justin Slaten** (0-1). The 3-2 advantage held until the seventh when Avilas hit a three-run homer and Kenedy Corona added a solo shot to increase the lead to 7-2. **Trevor Hauver** came back with a solo shot of his own for the Riders in the top of the eighth, homering in his second-straight game, but Corpus added a run in the bottom of the eighth on a sacrifice fly to put the game well out of reach. Danny Duffy threw a scoreless inning in relief for the Riders.

BRING IN THE MAY AWARDS:

The Texas Rangers announced on Thursday that three RoughRiders players won May honors for the Rangers Minor League system. **Jack Leiter** captured Starting Pitcher of the Month honors while **Alex Speas** was named the Relief Pitcher of the Month and **Jax Biggers** the Defender of the Month. Leiter was brilliant in the month of May, going 2-1 with a 1.67 ERA over his five starts. The Summit, N.J. native struck out 33 over 27.0 innings while walking 13 and holding opponents to a .148 batting average against. The righty was fourth in the league in ERA in the month while ranking seventh in innings pitched, sixth in strikeouts, seventh in WHIP (0.96) and fourth in average against. Speas, who was a member of the 2021 RoughRiders, was dominant on the mound in May. The righty owned a 1.93 ERA in the month, allowing just two earned runs over his 9.1 innings while striking out 16 to four walks in his nine outings. The Georgia native has been one of the best relievers for Frisco all season, going 1-0 with a 0.89 ERA in 18 games, striking out 35 over 20.1 innings while holding opponents to a .151 average. Among those with at least 20 innings pitched, Speas' 40.2 percent strikeout rate is the second-best in the Texas League this season. Biggers dazzled defensively in the infield in May, Biggers split his time between third base and second base, not committing an error in the month while turning eight double plays.

THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

With his appearance on Tuesday, reliever Alex Speas now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.89 over 18 appearances. In 20.1 innings, he has struck out 35 to 10 walks. Opponents are hitting just .151 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last nine outings. During that span, he has struck out 20 to three walks over 10 innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .123 (7-for-57) against him on the season with a .383

PLEASE CONNECT TO POWER-

Over the last 19 games (8-11 record), Frisco has hit just five home runs while batting .223/.336/.311/.647. The six home runs (from Liam Hicks and Trevor Hauver (3) and Thomas Saggese (2)) are the fewest in the league over the last 19 by four. The Riders are averaging just 4.3 runs per game over the last 19 games, which is the second-fewest in the league (only in front of Northwest Arkansas, 2.9).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, second in the Texas League with a .579 average (11-for-19) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.442 OPS on the first pitch. Luisangel Acuña has also been great, hitting .486 (17-for-35) on the initial offering while his 17 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

DUSTIN' THEM AND LEAVING THEM BEHIND:

Dustin Harris has been running wild for the RoughRiders this season. After stealing 19 bases in 85 games in 2022, Harris has already swiped 23 bags in 52 games this season to lead the Texas League and the entire Rangers organization. If Harris plays 110 games this season, he is on pace for 49 steals, which would by far be a career high. Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 24. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League swipes with 82 bases in 96 attempts (85 percent)

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). Frisco also has a 1.189 OPS with the bags full, which is third in the minors (Low-A Myrtle Beach, 1.295 and Triple-A Saint Paul, 1.274)

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .299 (60-for-201)/.366/.418/.784 through the first 47 games. Over his last 43 games, he is batting .311/.383/.443/.826. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (112).

On the season, Frisco's 274 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .352 team OBP is fourth in the Texas League. **Dustin** Harris is first in the league with 40 walks.

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a $1.28\,\mathrm{ERA}$ over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house." $\,$

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
