Asa Lacy struck out seven across 5.2 innings in his second start of the season, but the Northwest Arkansas Naturals could not offer the left-hander much run support, falling to the Wichita Wind Surge 5-1 Sunday afternoon, losing the series four games to two.

- Lacy's 5.2 innings and 84 pitches both represent single-game highs for Naturals pitchers this season, as Lacy made relatively quick work of the Wind Surge through the first four innings. Through two starts this season, the No. 4 Royals prospect has 13 strikeouts in just 9.2 innings.
- Seven of nine Naturals hitters recorded a hit, with Maikel Garcia singling three times to raise his season batting average to .406 ... Tucker Bradley drove in the team's only run, with an RBI single in the fourth inning to extend his team-best hit streak to six games.
- Wichita struck Lacy for a run in the second on a home run and tagged him for two more in the fifth on a trio of two-out hits and an error. Dante Biasi pitched the final 3.1 innings behind Lacy, striking out one while allowing two runs on two hits.
- The Naturals did not hit a home run the entire week, with the homerless streak extending on Sunday to six games and 224 at-bats ... the longest homerless team streak last year was 123 at-bats.

This Day in Naturals History

The Naturals are 2-9 all-time when playing on April 19

On April 19, 2010, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals edged out the Corpus Christi Hooks, 6-4 in 10 innings at Whataburger Field ... the Naturals led 2-0 after the second inning, but entered the ninth inning down a run 4-3 ... Manny Piña doubled home Johnny Giavotella to tie the score at four and force extra innings, then Derrick Robinson tripled home Paulo Orlando in the 10th and Giavotella brought Robinson home on a sac fly to put the Naturals up 6-4 ... Ben Swaggerty pitched the final 3.1 innings of the game to earn the win.

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, eight players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 10 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Andrés Sotillet, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was catcher Tyler Cropley and outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder **Gavin Stupienski** and pitcher **Alec Marsh** both played for the Naturals in 2021.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 20 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 10 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave and Ángel Zerpa.

STAR-STUDDED ROTATION

All five of the Naturals starting pitchers to open the season are consensus top prospects in the Royals' organization, with all five listed in MLB Pipeline's Top-30 rankings for Kansas City.

- RHP **Alec Marsh** starts today, April 19th, for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 12 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 11.
- LHP Drew Parrish starts tomorrow, April 20th, for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 29 in the system, while Baseball America had him at No. 38 in their preseason rankings.
- LHP **Anthony Veneziano** starts Thursday, April 21st for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 17 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 21.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** starts Friday, April 22nd, for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him at No. 13 in the system, while Baseball America has him at No. 20.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** starts Saturday, April 23rd for the Naturals ... MLB Pipeline lists him No. 72 overall in baseball, No. 4 in the system and the No. 5 lefthanded pitching prospect, while Baseball America has him at No. 4 in the Royals' minor league system, the No. 4 left-handed pitching prospect.

TOOLSY TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in Baseball America's 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the
- C **Sebastian Rivero** is rated as being the "Best Defensive Catcher" in the
- SS **Maikel Garcia** is rated as having the <u>"Best Infield Arm"</u> in the system.
- RF **Seuly Matias** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm" in the system.
- LHP **Asa Lacy** is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system.
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the <u>"Best Control"</u> in the system.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop Maikel Garcia drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and despite having not drawn a walk in his last four games and 15 plate appearances, is still tied for the most in the Texas League but and is tied for third in all of Double-A.

- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played, while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first threewalk game on Wednesday 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.
- In 42 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 23 times, for a cool .548 on-base percentage (13 hits + 10 walks) ... his OBP ranks third in the league, ninth in all of Double-A and is the best among qualified Naturals hitters ... he is the only Natural that has reached base in all nine games this season and one of just two players in the Texas League with a nine-game reached base streak this year, along with San Antonio's Esteury
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leader in many categories, including 6th in batting average (.406), 3rd in on-base percentage (.548), 4th in hits (13), tied 1st in walks (10) and tied 3rd in steals (4).

STREAKY STARTS

While Maikel Garcia is the only Naturals hitter that has reached base at least once in all nine games the team has played, five different players have reached base in every game they have played.

- SS Maikel Garcia has reached base in all nine games he's played started the season hitting .406 (13-for-32) with 2 doubles and 10 walks, giving him a .548 on-base percentage.
- INF/OF **Nate Eaton** has reached base in all eight games he's played started the season hitting .267 (8-for-30) with 1 triple and 4 walks, giving him a .343 on-base percentage.
- 2B Michael Massey has reached base in all eight games he's played started the season hitting .265 (9-for-34) with 3 doubles and 3 walks, giving him a .316 on-base percentage.
- INF **Robbie Glendinning** has reached base in all six games he's played started the season hitting .190 (4-for-21) with 1 double and 5 walks, giving him a .346 on-base percentage.
- OF Tucker Bradley has reached base in all six games he's played started the season hitting .318 (7-for-22) with 1 double, 1 triple and 1 walk, giving him a .348 on-base percentage ... also has a team-best six-game hitting streak, the only Natural with a hit in every game he's played this year.

SNIDER DEBUTS AND EARNS THE DUB!

On April 9, right-handed pitcher **Collin Snider** made his Major League debut for the Kansas City Royals, the 111th Naturals alum to reach the Majors.

- Snider is one of 16 former Naturals on the Royals' 28-man Opening Day roster, one of 15 that has made their MLB debut after playing in Northwest Arkansas.
- Snider's first MLB appearance was a high-leverage situation, as he came on to pitch the 10th inning of a game tied 0-0 at Kauffman Stadium against Cleveland. He kept the Guardians off the board, with some defensive help from fellow 2021 Natural and 2022 debutante Bobby Witt Jr. and after the Royals walked it off in the bottom of the 10th for a 1-0 win, Snider was awarded his first MLB win in his debut.
- The full list of former Naturals on the Royals' active roster is: **Scott Barlow**, Jake Brentz, Dylan Coleman, Hunter Dozier, Cam Gallagher, Jackson Kowar, Nicky Lopez, Whit Merrifield, Adalberto Mondesi, Ryan O'Hearn, Salvador Perez, Brady Singer, Collin Snider, Gabe Speier, Josh Staumont and Bobby Witt Jr. ... note that Barlow pitched in MLB before he played for the Naturals.



- Chris Widger will manage the Naturals after guiding the River Bandits to a High-A Central championship in their first season as a Kansas City affiliate in 2021. In doing so, he was named the Minor League Manager of the Year by Baseball America following the 2021 season.
