SNELLING'S GEM LEADS SHRIMP TO 4-1 WIN

Robby Snelling struck out nine against two hits and one walk allowed in 6.0 shutout innings on Friday as Jacksonville beat Charlotte 4-1. The Jumbo Shrimp broke open a scoreless tie during a three-run fourth inning. Joe Mack notched an RBI single, Jacob Berry lifted a sacrifice fly and Jared Serna added a ground-rule double for the scoring in the frame. Mack launched a solo shot in the eighth to make it 4-0. Jacksonville's shutout bid was spoiled in the ninth when Rikuu Nishida hit a solo home run. After Snelling exited the game, Josh Ekness tossed 2.0 scoreless innings. The Jumbo Shrimp earned their fifth straight win.

HUNDRED WINS WAR

Led by manager John Shoemaker, the 2001 Jacksonville Suns went 83-56 on their way to a Southern League championship. When Shoemaker returned in 2005, he earned his 100th win on May 15, 2005, 176 games into his Jacksonville managerial career. That record stood as the longest in the club's recorded history until last night. David Carpenter, who led the Jumbo Shrimp to an 89-61 record last season, earned his 100th managerial win with Jacksonville in his 169th contest with the club.

SHUT DOWN CYCLE

Jacksonville has yielded four runs or fewer in 12 straight games, including 11 contests of no more than three runs allowed and seven of two or fewer tallies. In total during this 12-game stretch, which has seen the Jumbo Shrimp earn 10 wins, the club has ceded only 19 runs, 16 earned on 47 hits in 109.0 innings (1.32 ERA, 3.9 H/9). Jacksonville pitchers have compiled 143 strikeouts (33.6 percent of their 425 batters faced) against 49 walks.

'PEN PALS

Jacksonville's bullpen led Triple-A in ERA (3.64) and BAA (.214) in 2025 while also throwing the fifth-most innings (700.2) of any bullpen at the level. However, over the first five games of 2026, Shrimp relievers combined to surrender 22 runs, 21 earned, on 27 hits (9.6 H/9) in 25.1 innings for a 7.46 ERA (21 BB, 7.5 BB/9, 38 K, 13.5 K/9). The club has turned that around over the last 14 contests, yielding only 11 runs, 10 earned, on 27 hits (4.0 H/9) in 61.0 innings for a 1.48 ERA (32 BB, 4.7 BB/9, 89 K, 13.1 K/9).

STARTER FLUID

Heading into play on Saturday, Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded two runs or fewer in 12 consecutive starts. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have ceded only 10 runs, nine earned, on 29 hits (4.4 H/9) in 59.0 innings for a 1.37 ERA, totaling 24 walks (3.7 BB/9) against 70 strikeouts (10.7 K/9). On the season, Jacksonville starters collectively lead Triple-A in batting average against (.168), strikeouts (102) and WHIP (1.04) while ranking second in fewest runs allowed (26) and fewest hits allowed (50), third in ERA (2.63) and innings pitched (85.2) and sixth in GO/AO (1.21). Of the club's 19 games this season, Jumbo Shrimp starters have surrendered more than three runs just once.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Each of Jacksonville's last eight games, and 15 of their 19 on the season, have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp are now 9-6 (.600) thus far in 2026 in these narrowly-decided matchups. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp went 58-34 (.630) in games decided by three runs or fewer, meaning 65.2 percent of their 89 victories came by those slim margins. The 2025 Jumbo Shrimp tied Indianapolis for the most one-run victories (29) in MLB. Those 29 one-run wins were the most for a Jacksonville club since 2014 Suns won 35 such games.

GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT

Jacksonville has recorded double-digit strikeouts in all but four games thus far in 2026, with two of the exceptions being a pair of nine-punchout performances. Jumbo Shrimp hurlers have tallied at least 12 strikeouts in 11 of the last 16 games, totaling 200 against 70 walks during that span. As a result, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A with 229 strikeouts on the season. The club's pitchers have combined to fan 32.3 percent of opposing hitters (MLB average: ~24.1%).

POPCORN SHRIMP

The Jumbo Shrimp have ceded seven hits or fewer in 12 straight games... Jacksonville is hitting just .166/.267/.272/.539 with runners in scoring position. They have the 19th-most plate appearances in Triple-A in these situations, but tied for the eighth-most strikeouts... The Shrimp are vying for their first six-game winning streak since taking seven straight games from August 3-10, 2025.

-After not playing in a game in 2020 because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Blalock wound up missing all of the 2022 season due to Tommy John surgery.

-The Red Sox traded Blalock on August 1, 2023 to Milwaukee for infielder Luis Urias.

-On May 20, 2024, Blalock was promoted to the major leagues for the first time. However, he was optioned back to Biloxi on May 24, briefly becoming a phantom ballplayer (a player who spent time on an MLB active roster without ever appearing in a game). That designation changed on June 20, 2024, when Blalock made his major league debut for the Brewers with a scoreless inning against the Padres in San Diego.

-Blalock was traded for the second time in his career on July 27, 2024. He was sent along with right-handed pitcher Yujanyer Herrera to the Colorado Rockies for right-hander Nick Mears.

-The Rockies designated Blalock for assignment following the signing of right-hander Michael Lorenzen on January 18, 2026. He was traded to the Miami Marlins five days later for right-hander Jake Brooks.

-Blalock found Kevin Gausman's split change on the internet and used the grip as a model for himself. He liked the pitch's versatility as an option to both righties and lefties and the fact that it is both a "velocity and movement separator."

-Blalock struggled at Coors Field in Denver; he had a 2-4 record and 12.27 ERA in seven appearances, including six starts, at home (29.1 IP, 50 H, 40 R, 40 ER, 9 HR, 14 BB, 9 K, .388 BAA). He was slightly better in seven appearances, including six starts, on the road for Colorado, going 0-2 with a 6.44 ERA (29.1 IP, 35 H, 21 R, 21 ER, 8 HR, 9 BB, 18 K, .307 BAA).
