LAST OUTING: File took the loss on September 12, 2021 for the Sounds vs. Memphis. The right-hander allowed two runs (2 ER) and four hits over 2.1 innings of work. He threw just 57 pitches in the contest, with 35 being strikes.

AGAINST OPPONENT: File is facing Durham for the first time in his career.
