**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and Durham Bulls play game three of a six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. The Sounds dropped a 9-4 decision despite another home run by slugging first baseman Jon Singleton. Nashville right-handed pitcher Dylan File will make his first start of the season against Durham right-handed pitcher Tommy Romero.

**Dylan File:** 25-year-old Dylan File is set for his first start of the season with the Sounds. The right-handed hurler returns to Nashville after going 2-4 with a 5.27 ERA in 9 games (all starts) to end the 2021 campaign. He is rated as the No. 25 prospect in the Brewers organization by MLB Pipeline and the No. 28 prospect by *Baseball America*. In his last full season of work, File combined to go 15-6 with a 3.24 ERA in 26 games (all starts) with Advanced-A Carolina (12) and Double-A Biloxi (14). He was selected by Milwaukee in the 21st Round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft.

**Tommy Romero:** 24-year-old Tommy Romero returns for his second season with Durham. He enters the season as the No. 18 prospect in the Rays organization according to MLB Pipeline. The right-handed pitcher went 7-2 with a 3.18 ERA in 12 games (12 starts) in 2021. He also added a 1-0 record with a 1.88 ERA in 11 games (9 starts) with Double-A Montgomery to start 2021. Romero was named the Triple-A East Pitcher of the Week from Sept. 4-11, 2021, after going 2-0 and pitching 12.2 scoreless innings over two starts. He was named the Florida State League Most Valuable Pitcher in 2019 for Advanced-A Charlotte. He was also a 2018 Midwest League Mid-Season All-Star with Single-A Bowling Green. Romero was traded by the Mariners (along with RHP Andrew Moore) to the Rays in exchange for RHP Alex Colome, LF Denard Span and cash. He drafted in the 15th Round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Mariners out of Eastern Florida State College.

**2022 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2022: First: 1 (T), Second: 0, Third: 0, Fourth: 1 (T), Fifth: 0, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**Two In, 148 Remaining:** After last night's loss to the Bulls, the Sounds begin their season at 1-1 for the first time since 2019. The Sounds have not won the first two games of the season since 2014, when Johnny Hellweg and Jimmy Nelson were the two winning pitchers.

**Singleton Smashing:** First baseman Jon Singleton hit his second home run in as many games to start the season. He is the first Sounds player since Prince Fielder to homer in the team's first two games of the year. Fielder accomplished the feat on April 7 and 8, 2005 vs. New Orleans. Singleton is tied for the International League-lead in homers with Jacksonville's Charles Leblanc, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's Estevan Florial and Toledo's Ryan Kreidler entering today's games. He also is fifth in slugging percentage (1.250) and tied for fifth in OPS (1.625) in the IL.

**Just Keep Hitting:** Jonathan Davis, Jon Singleton and Mark Mathias all logged multi-hit games in yesterday's contest. Both of Singleton's hits went for extra bases, with a double and homer. Davis finished 2-for-4 with a run, double, RBI, and walk. Mathias smashed a RBI triple and single in his first lineup appearance of the season.

**Hit City Everyday:** Singleton attempts to extend his hitting streak to three games after combining to go 3-for-8 in the first two games. Also attempting to extend their hitting streak in tonight's lineup are Jonathan Davis (1G), Corey Ray (1G), Jamie Westbrook (1G) and Weston Wilson (1G).

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 510-461 record during this span.

**Opening Day...Again:** The Milwaukee Brewers played the first game of the 2022 Major League Baseball season this afternoon at Wrigley Field against the Chicago Cubs. The Brewers' active roster entering the day includes 11 former Sounds, including Aaron Ashby, Lorenzo Cain, Jake Cousins, Jandel Gustave, Keston Hiura, Eric Lauer, Hoby Milner, Jace Peterson, Tyrone Taylor, Rowdy Tellez and Christian Yelich.

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville opens the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.

**Home Sweet Home:** Sounds hurlers Small and Brothers add some local flavor to this year's squad. Small grew up in Lexington, Tenn. and resides in Spring Hill. Brothers comes to Nashville for the first time in his professional career after attending Shelbyville High School and starring at Lipscomb University.

**LAST OUTING:** File took the loss on Septemeber 12, 2021 for the Sounds vs. Memphis. The right-hander allowed two runs (2 ER) and four hits over 2.1 innings of work. He threw just 57 pitches in the contest, with 35 being strikes.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** File is facing Durham for the first time in his career.

### 2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Tonight's start will be File's first start of the season with Nashville. He made one appearance for the Brewers in spring training, allowing four hits and two runs (2 ER) in 2.0 innings in relief on March 20.
- Enters the sesason as No. 25 prospect in the Brewers organization by MLB Pipeline and the No. 28 prospect in the same category by *Baseball America*.
