Back At Home

The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the second-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and second-of-12 at FirstEnergy Stadium. Following this week, Reading heads to New Hampshire from May 12-17 and the Fisher Cats return to America's Classic Ballpark from June 30-July 5. Reading won last year's season-series 12-6 over New Hampshire, which included a 7-5 record at home. The Fightin Phils lead the season-series 1-0 following Tuesday night's win.

Call it a Winning Streak

The Reading Fightin Phils used a nine-run fourth inning to power past the New Hampshire Fisher Cats 9-3, earning their third straight win. After falling behind 1-0 on a solo home run in the fourth, Reading responded with a two-out rally that saw them bat around and score nine runs. Bryan Rincon started the surge with a two-run homer, followed by an RBI double from Dylan Campbell and a two-run shot from Austin Murr. Alex Binelas capped the inning with a grand slam to give Reading full control. New Hampshire added a run in the fifth and another on a solo homer in the eighth, but it wasn't enough to threaten the lead. Adam Seminaris earned the win with five innings of one-run ball, while Jackson Wentworth took the loss. Binelas, Rincon and Murr led the offensive outburst, and Reading's lineup continued its hot stretch with another high-scoring performance.

Winning Baseball

With Tuesday night's win the Fightin Phils moved to .500 for the first time since starting 2-2 in 2024. A win on Wednesday would mark the first time that Reading is above .500 since sitting at 3-2 on Apr. 10, 2024. If the Fightin Phils win on Wednesday and improve to 9-8, it would be the latest mark in the season they are over .500 since the conclusion of the 2019 season, when the Fightin Phils were 80-59.

Beware of Ware

Bryson Ware remains red-hot at the plate as he extended his hit streak to 10 games on Sunday afternoon. Over his 10-game hit streak, Ware is slashing .342/.342/.763 (1.105 OPS), along with one double, five home runs and 10 RBI. Ware is currently tied for second in the Eastern League with five home runs.

Heredia Keeps Hitting

Raylin Heredia capped off an excellent week at Somerset on Sunday with a career-high three doubles, while also scoring two runs and driving in a pair. He tacked on two more hits, including another double, in Tuesday night's win over New Hampshire. Over six games against the Patriots last week, Heredia slashed .417/.481/.833 (1.314 OPS), along with eight runs, five doubles, one triple, one home run and three RBI. Heredia currently ranks tied for first in the Eastern League with eight doubles, tied for eighth with 18 hits, first with 11 extra-base hits and tied for sixth with 13 runs.

Runnin' Rincon

Bryan Rincon continues to swipe bases at an impressive clip to begin the season, ranking tied for second in the Eastern League with 10 stolen bases thus far. His 10 stolen bases leads all Phillies Minor Leaguers, with second place coming in with eight. If Rincon continues to steal bases at the same clip, he would be on track for nearly 100 stolen bags this season. Rincon stole 40 bases over 84 games last season and has 89 across 243 career games, since 2022.

Hammering Homers

The Fightin Phils offense continues to produce home runs at a high clip through the season's first three weeks after tacking on three more in Tuesday night's victory. Reading has clubbed 27 home runs through the season's first 16 games, which leads second place Somerset by six, who has 21. Last week at Somerset, the Fightin Phils hit 14 home runs, which also was most in the league for the week. Offensively, Reading's .262 average is fourth in the league and their .820 OPS is third. Alex Binelas' grand slam home run was Reading's second in six days, as Dylan Campbell launched one at Somerset last Wednesday.

This Day in Baseballtown History

April 22, 1967: At Reading, the Reading Phillies make their debut in Baseballtown, beating York, 9-3, before 6,046 fans. Jeff Harrell goes the distance on a 6-hitter for the win and helps his own cause with a three-run single. All three runs Harrell surrenders are unearned as the Phils commit four errors. Left fielder Jim Perkins becomes the first Reading Phillie to homer, smashing a 400-foot solo shot to right-center that ties the game at 3-3 in the 5th.

Here Come the Cats

New Hampshire enters play today with an 8-6 record, which leads the Eastern League Northeast Division. This comes after the Fisher Cats finished 2025 with a 56-81 record, second-lowest in the Eastern League. Last week, New Hampshire took four-of-five from Chesapeake at home and after this week, they return home to welcome Binghamton for a seven-game series. The Fisher Cats' roster has six of the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects (MLB Pipeline): Gage Stanifer (6), Victor Arias (12), Fernando Perez (16), Sean Keys (17), Javen Coleman (23) and Cutter Coffey (25).

Need Cash Now?

Righty Chris McElvain makes his third start of the season tonight for New Hampshire. Over his first two outings, McElvain does not have a decision, with a 5.63 ERA (5 ER, 8.0 IP), along with six strikeouts. He last pitched against Chesapeake last Wednesday and allowed two runs on four hits over four innings, with three walks and three strikeouts. McElvain spent most of last season with Vancouver (A+), but also made appearances for the FCL-Blue Jays (ROK) and Dunedin (A), combining to go 0-6, with a 4.42 ERA (39 ER, 79.1 IP) over 21 starts. The 25-year old was originally drafted by Cincinnati in the eighth round in 2022 out of Vanderbilt and was traded to Toronto before the 2024 season in a deal that sent Santiago Espinal to the Red from the Blue Jays.
