Game 40 Recap It was another back-and-forth affair on Thursday morning as the Fightin Phils fell to Portland 6-3. Chuck King started and settled into throwing a career-high six innings pitched. He allowed two runs (one earned) on six hits, with three strikeouts. The Fightin Phils scored two runs in the fourth and one in the sixth to grab a 3-2 lead. Andrick Nava had his best game of the season as he had three hits and two RBI, along with a walk. Wil Crowe followed King and took the loss as he allowed four runs (two earned), while walking four batters, in his Fightin Phils debut. Keaton Anthony and Felix Reyes both stayed hot with two hits each,

The Fightin Phils hit the road and continue a series at the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. It is the 12th-of-17 matchups between the teams this season and ninth-of-11 at Delta Dental Park in Portland. Following this week's seven-game series, the Sea Dogs come to Reading from July 18-20 to finish the season series. After winning the 2024 season-series 13-8, Portland holds a 9-2 edge in this year's season-series.

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller is currently riding a season-high eight-game hitting streak, and is slashing .357/.419/.536 (.955 OPS) over that stretch. Miller has now reached base in 27 of his last 30 games played in, dating back to April 12. Miller has also proven to be a threat on the base paths as his 14 steals rank tied for fourth in the Eastern League.

Keaton Anthony stayed red-hot with two more hits on Thursday. He had doubles in five-straight games from May 15-20, which marked the first time a Fightin Phil had doubled in five-straight games since Carlos Rivero did it from May 17-22, 2011. Since May 7 (11 games), Anthony is slashing. 415/467/.683 (1.150 OPS), with seven runs, eight doubles, one home run and eight RBI. Entering play today, Anthony holds the following Eastern League ranks: 3rd AVG (.325), 7th OBP (.385), 7th SLG (.525), 4th OPS (.910), 1st 2B (16), 2nd XBH (19).

Hendry Mendez stayed hot with a home run and five-combined RBI between the two games Wednesday. He had two hits in three-straight games from May 18-21. Since May 14 (10 games), Mendez is slashing .382/.436/.706 (1.142 OPS), with seven runs, two doubles, three home runs and 10 RBI. Entering play today, Mendez is sixth in the Eastern League in average (.313), 6th in OBP (.388), T-6th in htis (41) and T-10th in runs (23).

Leandro Pineda stayed red-hot with a hit in both games on Wednesday. He is on an eight-game hitting streak, dating back to May 15, and over the streak, he is slashing .444/.500/.630 (1.130 OPS), along with seven runs, five doubles and three RBI. After hitting just .104 in April, Pineda has posted a .321 average in May.

Chuck King turned in one of the best starts of the season and his professinal career on Thursday morning, King went a career-high six innings and 88 pitches, along with six hits, two runs (one earned), no walks and three strikeouts. It has been an up and down season so far for King, who is starting for the first time in his career, after pitching as a reliever last season, and not throwing more than two innings. King signed with the Phillies in February of 2024 after not playing baseball for nearly three years. He finished his career at TCU in 2021 and worked for the Padres in their scouting and analytics department from 2021-24 prior to signing with the Phillies and getting back into pro baseball.

Gabe Mosser turned in his second-straight excellent start on Wednesday, allowing one run on three hits over six innings of work. Over his last two starts, Mosser is 2-0, with a 1.42 ERA (2 ER, 12.2 IP), along with six hits allowed, two walks and eight strikeouts.

Portland enters today with a 22-17 record, sitting in second place in the Northeast Division. Last week, Portland took two-of-five games at Somerset, with one game being postponned to June. Following this week, the Sea Dogs hit the road and head to Altoona for a six-game series with the Curve. Portland's roster features seven of Boston's top-30 prospects: Luis Perales (4), David Sandlin (8), Connelly Early (9), Mikey Romero (11), Allan Castro (22), Yordanny Monegro (23) and Blake Wehunt (27)

Righty, and Red Sox No. 8 prospect, David Sandlin makes the start tonight for Portland. This season, Sandlin is 1-1, with a 5.23 ERA over seven starts (31.0 IP, 31 H, 11 BB, 31 SO). Sandlin last pitched last Saturday at Somerset and allowed four runs on four hits over 4.2 IP, with three strikeouts in a no-decision. In two starts vs Reading this season, Sandlin is 1-0, allowing seven hits and three runs over 9.1 IP, with six strikeouts. The 24-year old was drafted by Kansas City in the 11th round of the 2022 draft out of Oklahoma. Sandlin was traded to Boston on Feb. 17, 2024, in exchange for John Schreiber.
