"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

SAINTS WALK THEIR WAY TO COMEBACK WIN OVER SCRANTON: The St. Paul Saints matched a season-high by drawing 10 walks as they scored three unanswered to end the night and overcome a one-run deficit to top Scranton/Wilkes-Barre 7-5 on Wednesday night at CHS Field. After falling behind 1-0, the Saints leveled the game in the second. After Carson McCusker led off with a walk and Edouard Julien singled, DaShawn Keirse, Jr. smoked a short hop to second 112.1 mph off the bat that caromed off the glove and off the side of the head of second baseman Andrew Velazquez, scoring a run. In the third, the Saints scored three runs as the first five batters of the frame reached to tie it. Mickey Gasper plated Payton Eeles on a double to right before a bases-loaded walk and a fielder's choice groundout by Keirse forced in two more. Scranton would re-take a lead at 5-4 through 5 1/2 innings with the game flipping on it's head when Jose Rojas singled, Brennan Davis singled, and Braden Shewmake hit a three-run homer all in the span of four pitches from Jarret Whorff. St. Paul would rally back to tie it in the sixth; an Eeles single and stolen base scored on another Gasper double. In the sixth, the Saints used two more bases-loaded free passes and needed just one hit to take the lead in a two-run frame. Kyle Bischoff and Richard Lovelady combined for three scoreless innings to secure the Saints' 18th comeback win.

COMEBACK KIDS: Following Wednesday's win in which they trailed by a run in the middle of the sixth, 18 of St. Paul's 29 wins this year have been in come-from-behind fashion this season, the most in the International League and trailing only eight teams in all of baseball (majors or minors), the Los Angeles Dodgers and three other MiLB teams lead the pack with 20 this year). Since the start of May, the Minnesota Twins lead baseball with 13 come-from-behind victories, with the Saints ranking 1-5th in that span.

HOOKED ON AN EELING: In his second game since coming off the IL on Friday, Saints infielder Payton Eeles collected three hits and stole two bases, marking the third time in 126 career games in the Twins organization that he's picked up three hits and multiple steals in the same game. It was his first career game doing so at the Triple-A level. He's one of just 16 hitters in the International League with a 3-hit, 2-steal performance this year, with only Lehigh Valley's Justin Crawford having accomplished the feat multiple times so far this season (3x).

GOING, GOING, GONE: The Saints' streak of homering in consecutive games came to an end at 10 straight on Wednesday night, marking the longest stretch for the club since they homered in 11 in-a-row from April 27-May 10 last year. After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the 2nd-fewest in the Int'l League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 61 round-trippers in their last 44 games since April 14, which ranks 3rd in the minors in that stretch, trailing only Greensboro (66) and Charlotte (66). The Saints are 15-4 this season when they hit more homers than their opponents and 6-13 when being outhomered.

HEY MICKEY YOU'RE SO FINE: Since being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul on May 5, Saints utility man Mickey Gasper has hit .357 (35-98) with nine doubles, 7 HR, and 18 RBI in 25 games. Gasper leads the Int'l League in hits (35) and extra-base hits (16) since his option and his OPS of 1.120 ranks 2nd in the International League (min 50 AB) in that stretch. Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as the 2nd best hitter in the minors by wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average, a ballpark and league adjusted measure). With a homer in his next three games, he would reach 10 HR in a season with Saints in the 3rd-fewest # of games in franchise history (Spencer Steer holds the record with 10 HR in his first 25g w/ STP in 2021):

PITCHING PARTICULARS: Despite some recent strong pitching performances, the Saints have struggled on the mound recently as they've yielded 120 runs across their last 20 games going back to the start of their road trip at Iowa. Since the start of May, St. Paul pitching has produced a 6.05 ERA (165 ER, 245.1 IP), the 4th-worst mark in Minor League Baseball in that span. Despite the pitching struggles, the Saints' team OPS of .822 as an offense is tied for the 5th-highest in MiLB since the start of May, and the 2nd-best in the Int'l League, trailing Buffalo.

STRAIGHT GAS: The Saints pitching staff rank as the third-hardest throwing staff in Triple-A to start the season and 2nd in the International League with an average pitch velocity of 89.2 mph that ranks as a harder throwing staff than 13 Major League teams. Despite the extra few ticks, the Saints rank just 10th in Triple-A in K-rate (23.9%) and 8th in whiff-rate (28.7%). By average velo on fastballs only, St. Paul ranks 9th in Triple-A (92.7 mph). Ryan Jensen (96.6, 9th), Jacob Boskovic (96.5, 30th) and Alex Speas (96.4, 34th) are all top-40 in the Triple-A circuit in average fastball velo (min 100 pitches thrown).

THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY: The Saints currently tout three of Minnesota's top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list and St. Paul's roster overall features eight of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com and Baseball America: OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No. 2, MLB.com, No. 2 BA, currently on the 7-Day IL), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Eeles (23/17), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23, on 7-Day IL). Rodriguez checks in at the No. 19 on the MLB Pipeline's top-100 prospects and No. 37 by BA.

TWINS REPORT: The Twins (34-27) won their third straight in Sacramento with a 6-1 victory over the A's last night. Zebby Matthews fired his best start as a Twin this year, going 5.0 innings, allowing 1 run with 4 SO to garner the win. Ryan Jeffers and Harrison Bader each homered. Minnesota are 5-4 on the 11-day, 3-city road trip that ends this afternoon at Sutter Health Park before they return to host Toronto tomorrow night at Target Field, the start of a six-game homestand. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (27-26) were edged 6-5 in Northwest Arkansas (SEA) despite a 2-homer game from Twins No. 16 prospect Ricardo Olivar. OF Gabriel Gonzalez was recently named the Twins Minor League Player of the Month after hitting .364 (36-99), 3 HR, 7 2B, 9 BB in 24 games in May. High-A Cedar Rapids (32-20) swept the Timber Rattlers (MIL) in Appleton and have won seven in-a-row. Twins No. 4 prospect Kalen Cuipepper led off each game of the twin bill with a homer, the first player to do so at any level since Ronald Acuna, Jr with Atlanta in 2018. Low-A Fort Myers (24-29) had a three-game win streak snapped by Palm Beach (STL).

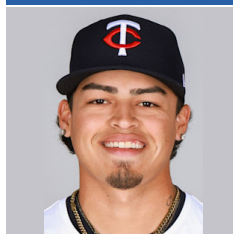

LAST APPEARANCE: Following his four perfect innings the week prior vs Norfolk, started on Friday at Werner Park vs the Stormchasers. After the leadoff batter he faced reached on an error and swiped second, Raya gave up a bloop single to Cavan Biggio and a two-run homer to Jac Caglianone. Settled in thereafter, retiring 11 in-a-row until plunking the last batter he faced and reaching his pitch limit before recording the last out of the fourth (Darren McCaughan gave up a two-run homer allowing the inherited runner to score). Threw 19 changeups (29%), 15 cutters (23%), 13 four-seamers (20%), 13 sweepers (20%), 4 curveballs (6%), and 2 sinkers (3%). Generated 11 swings-and-misses, his second straight start of double-digit whiffs, led by five on the changeup, while striking out seven for a second start in-a-row. Three of his seven K's came on the changeup, two on the cutter, and one apiece on the four-seamer and curveball.

CAN'T TOUCH THIS: Raya etched his name into Saints history in his start on May 24 vs Norfolk. After entering play with an ERA north of 12.00 on the season and more walks than strikeouts, he came out and struck out the first six batters he faced, becoming the third-ever Saints pitcher to go six up, six down all on the strikeout to start a game, joining Joe Ryan (Aug. 20, 2021 vs Iowa) and Bailey Ober (May 30, 2021 @Iowa). He came one shy of the franchise record of 7 K's in-a-row at any point in a game, a record held by David Festa (set on May 25, 2024 @BUF). Raya was also perfect through the first four innings of the game before reaching his pitch count, marking just the third time that the Saints took a perfect game bid through four innings (Mario Sanchez went 13 up-13 down to start on June 26, 2022 @Buffalo & Simeon Woods Richardson went 12 up-12 down on April 28, 2023 @Rochester). The Saints bullpen promptly followed his start with a leadoff walk in the fifth in a game the Saints would go on to lose 12-1 in 7 innings.

YOUNG GUNS: After making St. Paul's Opening Day roster following one appearance with the Saints to end last season, Raya is one of just six pitchers aged 22-years or younger to begin the 2025 season on a Triple-A roster. At 22 years, 7 months, and 21 days as of Opening Day, Raya is more than five years younger than the average pitcher at the Triple-A level this season. KLONG WAITING: Fourth-round pick in 2020, Raya had to wait a while to make his professional debut. After entering the 2020 Preseason All-American, his senior season at United South High School in Laredo, Texas was limited to just 18.0 innings in which he struck out 36 batters. His final high school outing was a complete game, one-hit shutout. However due to the COVID-19 shutdown, followed by a right rotator cuff strain, Raya threw his first professional pitch on April 12, 2022, 670 days after hearing the Twins call his name in the Draft.

THAT'S MARK, WITH A K: Raya, who's full legal name is Marco Antonio Raya, goes by Mark, despite not having a "K" in his legal name. He said you'd have to ask his dad as to why --- he's listed as "Marco" everywhere on Major League Baseball's websites.

GOOD GENES: Athletes run in the Raya family. Mark's mother played college tennis, his father played baseball at Nixon, while his sister made it to regionals as a junior and senior at United South HS in hurdles. Raya's brother also holds the Texas A&M International career strikeout record (127) despite only pitching two years for the Dustdevils in Division 2.
