YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Sea Dogs, 9-8. Andy Thomas gave the Flying Squirrels a 3-0 lead in the first inning with a two-out, three-run double. After a Sea Dogs run in the bottom of the first, Jimmy Glowenke hit a two-run homer and Yoshi Tsutsugo added a solo home run in the top of the second to open a 6-1 lead. After a run in the bottom of the second, Blaze Jordan hit an RBI single and Alex Binelas added a two-run triple to close the score to 6-5. Brady Whalen hit an RBI single in the fourth and Glowenke brought in a run with a single in the fifth to extend the lead to 8-5. Binelas hit a solo homer in the fifth to pull the Sea Dogs within two. In the eighth, Corey Rosier and Chase Meidroth each hit RBI doubles to tie the score, 8-8. In the top of the ninth, Glowenke hit a two-out, RBI single to move Richmond back ahead, 9-8. He finished the game with four RBIs. Tyler Myrick threw a 1-2-3 ninth inning to end the game.

**TDDAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game road series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. This series marks the second time these two teams have faced off this season. They met at The Diamond from July 25-30, with Richmond winning five-of-six.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 33-21 in their last 54 games since June 18, the best record in the Eastern League in that span, including a 5.1 record since August 17. Over the last 59 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 3.04 ERA (75 ER/22.0 IP) with 258 strikeouts. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.81 ERA is second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 423.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 580.1 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.66 ERA, which is the third-lowest in Double-A and the 10th-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

**THE SEA DIGS** entered their series at The Diamond on July 25 with the best record in the Eastern League and led the Northeast Division in the second-half standings. Since then, they have gone 8-18, the worst record in the league in that span. The Sea Dogs split last week's six-game series in Binghamton but lost three-of-the-last-five. Portland's roster includes eight of Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including SS Marcelo Mayer (No. 1, No. 15 overall), 2B Nick Yorke (No. 5), RHP Wikelman Gonzalez (No. 8), C Nathan Hickey (No. 10), SS Brainer Bonaci (No. 11), 2B Chase Meidroth (No. 14), 1B Blaze Jordan (No. 15) and RHP Hunter Dobbins (No. 30). MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospect list includes seven Portland players, including Mayer (No. 1, No. 11 overall), Yorke (No. 6), Gonzalez (No. 9), Bonaci (No. 11), Jordan (No. 12), Hickey (No. 15) and Meidroth (No. 20).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Ryan Murphy makes his 23rd start of the season and his third against the Sea Dogs. On Friday, Murphy pitched four scoreless innings with five strikeouts against the Senators, working around six hits and two walks. Murphy first faced the Sea Dogs on July 25 and threw four scoreless innings, allowing one hit. In the finale of that series on July 30, Murphy allowed three runs in 31 innings with a season-high seven strikeouts. Over his last 14 starts since June 4, Murphy has gone 0-6 with a 3.60 ERA (20 IP/50.0 IP), lowering his season ERA from 6.15 to 4.63. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 28 Giants prospect. For more on Murphy, see page two.

FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Angel Bastardo makes his Double-A debut. He has made 21 starts this season, all with High-A Greenville in the South Atlantic League. He last pitched on August 12 against Greensboro and allowed a season-high seven runs over 4.1 innings. Across four starts from July 1-July 21, Bastardo went 2-0 with a 1.13 ERA (3 ER/24.0 IP)/36 SO/5 BB). Over his last three starts from July 26-August 12, he went 0-2 with a 10.91 ERA (12 ER/15.2 IP/20 SO/10 BB). He was named the South Atlantic League's Pitcher of the Month for July. Bastardo signed with the Red Sox as an international free agent in 2018.

**STARTING STRUNG:** Flying Squirrels starters have a 2.76 ERA (23 ER/75.0 IP) over the last 19 games since August 2. In that stretch, **Carson Seymour** is 1-0 with a 1.90 ERA (4 ER/19.0 IP), **Spencer Bivens** has a 1.46 ERA (2 ER/12.1 IP) and **John Michael Bertrand** has a 2.70 ERA (6 ER/20.0 IP). **Wil Jensen** also threw four scoreless innings in his start on August 10.

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 22 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are tied for first place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings with the Bowie Baysox. They are one game ahead of the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half. Harrisburg is four games back in fourth. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

**THOMAS TRENDING UP:** In this week's series, **Andy Thomas** has reached base seven times in eight plate appearances. On Tuesday, he hit a two-run homer and worked a walk in his three plate appearances. On Wednesday, Thomas walked three times and had two hits, including a three-run double in the first inning. He has also hit safely in four straight games since Saturday. On the year, Thomas is tied for the team lead with 11 home runs and leads Richmond with 57 RBIs.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 53 times in his last 26 games since July 25 (28 hits, 24 walks, 1 HBP), hitting .322 (28-for-87) with five homers, five doubles, two triples and 21 RBIs adding a .465 on-base percentage. In last week's series against the Senators, Matheny hit .412 (7-for-17) with three homers, one double, nine RBIs and three walks. Last Tuesday night against the Senators, Matheny homered twice, a three-run shot in and a solo home run, and added a double in a three-hit, four-RBI performance. It was the third two-homer game of his Richmond career, joining performances on May 1, 2022 against Bowie and May 12, 2022 at Harrisburg. On Thursday, he entered off the bench and collected a pinch-hit, RBI single in the seventh. On Saturday, he hit a three-run homer and added a sac fly, his second four-RBI game of the series. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 131 walks, ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last six games, **Victor Bericoto** is batting .300 (6-for-20) with a double and four RBIs. He went 2-for-4 last Thursday, including a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning to cap a four-run comeback in the last inning, which was tied for the largest ninth-inning comeback win in franchise history. On Friday, Bericoto had a single and a sacrifice fly. He drove in two runs in Sunday's 6-4 win. On the year, Bericoto leads the Giants system with 19 homers (16 with Eugene and three with Richmond) and also leads the organization with 67 RBIs.

**LONGBALL LOGAN:** Logan Wyatt hit a three-run homer on Sunday afternoon, his 13th home runs this year between Richmond and Eugene, which is tied for the sixth-most in the Giants organization this year. Over his last seven games since August 15, Wyatt is batting .320 (8-for-25) with a homer, three doubles, two walks and five RBIs. He has four multi-hit games in his last eight games played.

RDBUST: On Saturday, Sean Roby hit his first Double-A homer of the year. It was the 26th of his Richmond career, which is the fifth-most in franchise history. Last year, Roby set a single-season franchise record with 25 home runs in his 89 games. Roby also holds the franchise record for the most home runs at The Diamond with 22. This year, Roby missed the start of the season with an injury. He played 19 games on a rehab assignment in the Arizona Complex League before playing 22 games with the High-A Eugene Emeralds. On the year between the three levels, Roby has 13 home runs, which is tied for the sixth-most in the Giants system. In his last four games since August 19, Roby is batting .429 (6-for-14) with a homer, a double, two RBIs and two walks.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28). Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
