#### LAST TIME OUT...

**TRENTON, N.J. (June 12, 2021)** – In their first extra-inning game of the season, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders defeated the Buffalo Bisons 6-4 in 10 innings on Saturday night at Trenton Thunder Ballpark.

The RailRiders fell behind early as the Bisons plated two runs in the bottom of the first against Nick Green on a pair of back-to-back RBI doubles. Buffalo tallied two more in the second to jump out to an early 4-0 lead.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre got on the board in the top of the fourth when a sacrifice fly from Socrates Brito scored Hoy Park to cut the deficit to 4-1. The RailRiders added two more in the fifth on a two-run single from Trey Amburgey.

Amburgey finished the game 2-for-5, extending his season-long hitting streak to 17 games, the longest hitting streak in Triple-A East this season. Dating back to the end of the 2019 season, Amburgey has hits in 19 consecutive contests, and has reached base safely in 25 straight.

In the top of the sixth, Armando Alvarez cracked a one-out double and scored on a base-hit by Kellin Deglan to tie the game at 4-4. The RailRiders catcher had a strong night at the plate, going 2-for-4 with a run scored and an RBI. Reggie McClain, Braden Bristo and Nick Goody combined to throw 6.0 innings of scoreless relief for the RailRiders after Green exited following 3.0 innings of work to force the game into extra innings.

Automatic runner Andrew Velazquez stole third base in the top of the tenth and came home to score on a wild pitch by Hobie Harris (0-1) with two outs in the frame. Brito followed with an RBI single to put the RailRiders on top 6-4.

Goody (3-1) set the Bisons down in order in the bottom of the tenth to close out the extra-inning victory.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**EXTRA, EXTRA!** Saturday night's 10-inning affair with the Buffalo Bisons was the first extra-inning game of the season for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders. It took until Game 33 of the season for the RailRiders to need extra frames to decide a game after 16 extra-inning contests in 2019. SWB went 10-6 in those contests.

**COMEBACK KIDS:** The RailRiders have erased multi-run deficits two times en route to victory during the current series with the Bisons. On Tuesday, they trailed 5-0 and eventually won 7-5, with a two-run single from **Derek Dietrich** in the top of the eighth putting SWB ahead for good. Then on Saturday, the RailRiders erased an early 4-0 advantage to win 6-4 in 10 innings. **Andrew Velazquez** put the RailRiders on top in the 10th inning when he scampered home on a wild pitch. Overall, the RailRiders have 10 come-from-behind wins this season.

**ON A SILVER TREY:** RailRiders outfielder **Trey Amburgey** has been among the best hitters in all of minor league baseball this season, and entering play Sunday afternoon, has at least one hit in all 17 games he has played. That stands as the longest active hitting streak in Triple-A East, and is the longest in the league this season. Dating back to the end of the 2019 season, Amburgey has hit in 19 consecutive games and has at least one hit in 24 of his last 25 contests, and has reached base safely in all of those games. He is hitting .398/.470/.727 (35-for-88) in that span. The SWB franchise record for longest hitting streak belongs to **Pablo Ozuna**, who hit in 27 straight games in 2004 for the Red Barons, while the longest on-base streak is **Brandon Drury's** 32-game streak in the 2018 season.

**OTHER STREAKS OF NOTE:** In addition to Trey Amburgey's impressive run, the RailRiders offense features two other players with double-digit on-base streaks. Outfielder **Greg Allen** is riding a season-long 13-game on-base streak into play on Sunday afternoon, and infielder **Hoy Park** has reached base safely in 12 consecutive games. Allen has also played in two other games this season in which he did not record an official plate appearance, therefore not jeopardizing his streak and spent time on the injured list in the middle of his streak.

**A NIGHT OF FIRSTS:** Thursday night's doubleheader with Buffalo will be the first true doubleheader of the season for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders. Previously they played a quasi-doubleheader on May 27 against Buffalo at PNC Field, resuming a suspended game from the night before then playing the regularly-scheduled contest. In 2019 the RailRiders played 11 doubleheaders, going 14-8 overall in those skirmishes. SWB played three twin-bills with Buffalo alone in 2019, splitting one at Sahlen Field on June 3 and one at PNC Field on June 27, and notching a sweep of one at Sahlen Field on June 5 as well. Because of the two doubleheaders in three days, the RailRiders and Bisons played each other six times from June 3-6. Game 2 of Thursday's twin bill also marked the first time that the RailRiders have been shut out this season, and the first time that a RailRider has been ejected from a game, with Manager **Doug Davis**, **Mike Ford**, and **Socrates Brito** all being run from the game in the top of the third.

**BLANKED:** When the RailRiders dropped Game 2 of Thursday's doubleheader to the Buffalo Bisons at Trenton Thunder Ballpark 10-0, it marked the first time this season that the RailRiders failed to score a run in a game. Not only was it the first time that the RailRiders have been shut out this season, but it was the first time that SWB had been shut out in a game since June 27, 2019, when ironically the Buffalo Bisons beat the RailRiders 1-0 in Game 2 of a doubleheader at PNC Field. In between, the RailRiders had gone 93 straight games without being shut out. This season SWB has only scored fewer than two runs in a game on one other occasion, a 3-1 loss at Rochester on May 23.

**THIS ROAD TRIP FEELS...FAMILIAR:** With the Buffalo Bisons having to play their entire home schedule this season at Trenton Thunder Ballpark, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders will play this series in a familiar setting for many players. From 2003 through 2020, the Trenton Thunder were the Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. Sixteen members of the RailRiders roster suited up for the Thunder under its Yankees affiliation. Adding an extra layer of complexity to the arrangement, Buffalo wears Trenton Thunder jerseys while playing at home, including the alternate "Trenton Pork Roll" identity on Fridays. The new Trenton Thunder Draft League team is playing its home games this season not at Trenton Thunder Ballpark, but at nearby Rider University in Lawrenceville, N.J.

**LAST TIME OUT:** RailRiders RHP Nick Nelson is making his first start of the 2021 season with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre in today's ballgame. He has made seven relief outings on the season for the RailRiders, most recently on Tuesday, June 8 against Buffalo, throwing 3.0 scoreless innings. The last time Nelson took the mound in a start for the RailRiders was in Game 3 of the Governor's Cup Semifinals against Durham on September 7, 2019. The Bulls used three walks and two hits to hammer the righty for 4 R/4 ER in 1.0 innings of work, and would go on to take the game by a 17-2 final, leaving Nelson to take the loss. He yielded 4 ER in two of his four regular season games started with the RailRiders as well, though he only did that one time previous to his Triple-A promotion (June 26 vs. Reading: 3.2 IP, 6 R/6 ER).

### 2021 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season on the Yankees Opening Day Roster.
- Optioned to the Yankees Alternate Training Site on 4/25.

### PERSONAL:

- Full name is Nicholas B. Nelson.
- Played two seasons (2015-16) at Gulf Coast State College (Fla.), where he went 13-5 with a 4.16 ERA (114.2 IP, 108 H, 64R/53ER, 49 BB, 121 K) in 22 games (21 starts).
- Had committed to play at the University of Florida to be a two-way player (1B and RHP) before signing with the Yankees, would have joined a staff that included RHP Alex Faedo (18th overall, 2017 DET) and RHP Brady Singer (18th overall, 2018 KC).
- Graduated from Rutherford H.S. (Fla.) in 2014.
- Was selected by the Giants in the 31st round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
- Is the oldest of four, two brothers and one sister, and the father of a baby girl with his girlfriend, who he met while playing for Tampa Tarpons in 2018, in late-August.
